RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 A'Fare Caterers 1400

COUNTING HOUSE (B Hutton) and **METTLESOME** (C Lammas) were both slow to begin.

UP ON THE ROOF (M McNab) jumped away awkwardly, shifting out abruptly into the line of **LACUSTRE** (D Johnson) with that runner being hampered, losing ground.

PROCRASTINATE (S Collett) and **SAUCY MARY** (P Holmes) were crowded between **TWO GEE'S** (T Thornton) and **OPULENT** (M Cameron) both of which had begun awkwardly, shifting ground. **SAUCY MARY** then made heavy contact with **OPULENT** which was forced out across the heels of **TOP DRIVE** (L Magorrian) which was shifting in, with **OPULENT** clipping a heel and blundering. The rider of **OPULENT** then lost his stirrup iron and the rein taking several strides to recover.

TWO GEE'S shifted in approaching the 1300 metres, crowding **SERENGETTI SUN** (O Bosson) which raced ungenerously for a distance. Rider T Thornton was advised she must exercise greater care.

HE'S CAVALIER (J Whiteside) raced keenly when being steadied passing the 1000 metres.

Passing the 400 metres **HE'S CAVALIER** shifted out to obtain clear running inconveniencing **SAUCY MARY** which then made slight contact with **ZASTELLA** (L Innes).

YEAH BRO (S Spratt) was inclined to lay out approaching the 300 metres further dictating **HE'S CAVALIER** outwards into the line of **UP ON THE ROOF** which was inconvenienced and then held up for a distance.

SERENGETTI SUN shifted out passing the 100 metres to obtain clear running inconveniencing TWO GEE'S.

TOP DRIVE was not persevered with from near the 400 metres giving ground appreciably and being pulled up. Rider L Magorrian advised that he felt there was something amiss with the gelding. **TOP DRIVE** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality. Co-trainer Mr D Bussey was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to **TOP DRIVE** racing again.

Race 2 Cowley's Hire Centre 1400

AMBITIOUS DANCER (D Johnson) and HASSELHOOF (M Cameron) were both slow to begin.

STOKED ME (R Norvall) was placed in restricted room shortly after the start when runners on either side shifted ground.

BE YOURSELF (L Magorrian) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

AMBITIOUS DANCER (D Johnson) shifted out passing the 500 metres to obtain clear running, forcing **EDWARD** (M Coleman) wide rounding the final turn.

Passing the 400 metres **HASSELHOOF** lay in making contact with **HAPI GIRL** (R Smyth) which was inconvenienced. Approaching the 350 metres **SONOBELLA** (L Innes) lay out and away from **FLAVOURING** (A Schwerin) further inconveniencing **HAPI GIRL** which was forced a little wider on the track.

BLOODSTREAM (T Thornton) had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

Race 3 Fell Engineering 1600

KIDNAPPED (S Spratt) was slow to begin and then was further hampered, losing ground.

AIRMAN (L Magorrian) jumped away very awkwardly with its rider becoming unbalanced making contact with **GWYNEDD** (S Collett) which was hampered.

LUCKY COUNTRY (D Johnson) raced ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 1200 metres.

FLICKA OF GOLD (A Schwerin) was held up when awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring **AIRMAN** passing the 350 metres.

Rider **P Holmes** (THE RICH LISTER) was issued with a warning after weighing in, in excess of 0.5 kg above his weigh out weight.

Race 4 Adams Trimmer Insurance 1400

NORTH OF SUNSET (D Johnson) was slow to begin.

HYDROGEN (L Magorrian) began awkwardly, shifting out and crowding MAKARSKA (M Coleman).

MAKARSKA shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres with **BIOLOGIST** (U Holmquist) shifting away from that runner inconveniencing **NORTH OF SUNSET**.

NORTH OF SUNSET shifted in near the 100 metres inconveniencing **BIOLOGIST**.

Apprentice Rider B Hutton could offer no tangible excuse for the poor performance of **BRITT EKLAND** with the mare undergoing a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 5 United Security Northland 1200

ANNABELINDA (M McNab) was slow to begin and then was further hampered when **CANDID MAN** (V Gatu) jumped away awkwardly, shifting in forcing **ELUCIDATE** (D Johnson) into that runner's line.

CANDID MAN raced wide without cover throughout.

Approaching the 700 metres **IN FLIGHT** (M Cameron) was steadied and race ungenerously, shifting back on to **ROCKWELL** (O Bosson) and **ELUCIDATE** which were both hampered. **PRIORITY** (T Thornton) and **SHESELUSIVE** (C Lammas) which were following both had to take evasive action with **SHESELUSIVE** shifting out off heels, becoming awkwardly placed and shifting in, crowding **GARLAND** (S Collett) on to **REPULSE BAY** (B Hutton) with **GARLAND** being hampered for a distance.

TWIN FIGHTER (R Norvall) lay out making the final bend and was inclined to shift out under pressure in the final straight.

Rider M Cameron reported that the winner **IN FLIGHT** had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed abrasions to the left hind bumper consistent with having been galloped on during the running.

Race 6 Whangarei ITM 1200

Approaching the 1100 metres **BECHTOLSHEIMER** (U Holmquist) and **VINCENT STREET** (C Lammas) both raced in restricted room to the inside of **FARAWAY EYES** (S Spratt) which had shifted in. S Spratt was advised to exercise greater care.

GUEVARA (L Magorrian) raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 900 metres.

TO BE SURE (M Cameron) was steadied off the heels of **ANTONIO LOMBARDO** (S Collett) which shifted in approaching the 800 metres.

SPIN DOCTOR (A Schwerin) raced three wide without cover throughout.

GUEVARA raced ungenerously passing the 600 metres when awkwardly placed.

BECHTOLSHEIMER was hampered near the 150 metres when attempting to improve into a marginal run to the inside of **FARAWAY EYES**.

Race 7 Fell Engineering 2100

Trainer **B Wallace** was fined \$50 for presenting **ENDORSEMENT** to race without the notified gear (blinkers).

ENDORSEMENT (G Cooksley) was slow to begin.

COOLIBAH (B Hutton) jumped away awkwardly.

Approaching the 1800 metres **SMEDLEY** (L Magorrian) shifted in, placing **SECRET'S ONLY** (U Holmquist) in restricted room with **SECRET'S ONLY** then commenced to over-race and shift in, hampering **UNCLE SHAYNE** (M Cameron) which lost ground. **L Magorrian** was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on his record. **BANBURY LAD** (R Smyth) raced wide for the majority of the event.

ENDORSEMENT was held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight.

SMEDLEY shifted in approaching the 150 metres inconveniencing **ENDORSEMENT**.

Z Moki (COACHLINE) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.00.

Race 8 91.6 More FM 1200

THE CANON (C Lammas) was slow to begin.

GRANT'S GIRL (S Spratt) raced ungenerously in the early stages.

FIRST CLASS (U Holmquist) was inclined to shift ground under pressure in the final straight, shifting out approaching the 200 metres inconveniencing **BIGGIN HILL** (Z Moki) for a distance. Rider U Holmquist was advised to exercise greater care.

THE CANON improved on to the heels of **WILLING SPIRIT** (D Johnson) approaching the 100 metres which shifted in slightly under pressure.

Rider **U Holmquist** (FIRST CLASS) was issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 200 metres.

Race 9 Whangarei Love It Here 1200

OVERNIGHTSENSATION (S Collett) shifted out when leaving the barriers, crowding **PLAYBOY PRINCE** (R Norvall) and **HUCKLEBERRY FLYER** (C Lammas).

TORNADO ALLEY (D Johnson) shifted in abruptly when leaving the barriers, hampering **KEENTORULE** (G Cooksley) which had begun awkwardly.

Passing the 1100 metres **PLAYBOY PRINCE** commenced to over-race when being restrained. **PLAYBOY PRINCE** was then further steadied off the heels of **FLYING FANTASY** (L Magorrian) which was dictated inwards by **APACHEE TAAT** (U Holmquist). **FLYING FANTASY** and **PLAYBOY PRINCE** both then commenced to race fiercely with **PLAYBOY PRINCE** then shifting out and hampering **BILL BREAKER** (M Cameron). U Holmquist was reprimanded advised that a warning would be placed on her record.

TORNADO ALLEY raced three wide without cover throughout.

M Hills reported that **SOUTHERN ICON** had hung out throughout the race and proved difficult to ride once placed under pressure in the final straight.

BILL BREAKER was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 10 Croft Poles 1600

VISIBLE (M Coleman) was slow to begin.

MISTER TOM (L Innes) was slow to begin and then was crowded to the inside of **BUDWISER** (V Gatu) which had shifted in and away from **SECRET LILY** (M Cameron). **MISTER TOM** then shifted in, further hampering **THE MIG** (T Thornton) which had been slow to begin.

ROYAL SCEPTRE (L Magorrian) was slow to begin.

THE MIG over-raced through the middle stages.

VETTEL (R Smyth) commenced to race keenly approaching the 800 metres shifting off heels and then racing wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

BUDWISER raced wide for the majority of the event.

VISIBLE was held up early in the final straight. **VISIBLE** then shifted out off the heels approaching the 350 metres to obtain clear running, crowding **VETTEL**, **WELL RELATED** (C Lammas) and **MISTER TOM** which were all hampered losing ground. Rider **M Coleman** admitted a subsequent breach of careless riding with his license to ride in races suspended 21 June – 1 July, inclusive, 5 riding days.

FEROZ (M Hills) lay out in the final straight placing rider M Hills at a disadvantage.

Race 11 A'Fare Caterers and Group Functions 1600

RIVER RAIDER (L Magorrian) proved difficult when parading to the start with **RIVER RAIDER** then being a late scratching due to gear breakage. Trainer D Logan was advised that a warning would be placed against the manners of **RIVER RAIDER**.

ZAFRENZY (M Hills), **CELTIC BOY** (C Lammas), **DEEBEE DON** (M McNab) and **CADUCEUS** (M Coleman) were all slow to begin.

Passing the 1200 metres **SAKOLOGY** (D Johnson), **HOLLYWOOD LAD** (B Hutton) and **CRIMSON PRINCE** (U Holmquist) all raced in restricted room to the inside of **VALANTE** (S Collett) which was shifting in. **VALANTE** then continued to shift in crowding **CRIMSON PRINCE** which became awkwardly placed on that runner's heels for a distance having to be restrained. Rider **S Collett** was issued with a warning.

Passing the 900 metres **HOLLYWOOD LAD** lay in despite the efforts of its rider, crowding **CRIMSON PRINCE** which was hampered. **CRIMSON PRINCE** then raced ungenerously for a distance.

BOB VALDEZ (V Gatu) raced wide for the majority of the race.

L Innes reported that CAGLIARI lay in throughout the race proving difficult to ride in the home straight.
