RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	THE 2014 JB ORGANICS SPRING CARNIVAL SPRINT
<p>ZED LEPELIN (B Lammas) and WERTHER (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly losing lost ground.</p> <p>RED ROBYN (D Johnson) began awkwardly.</p> <p>ZED LEPELIN and WERTHER were both hampered a short distance after the start when FEELIN THE LOVE (R Hutching) lay in.</p> <p>TAKEN THE LIBERTY (C Johnson) was placed in restricted room near the 1000 metres when inside REVOLUTION (J RIDDELL) which when being steadied to trail lay in and in consequence, ALL GOOD THINGS (K Myers) which was racing immediately to the inside of TAKEN THE LIBERTY had to be steadied.</p> <p>TAKEN THE LIBERTY then commenced to over-race.</p> <p>HONEY QUEEN (K Chiong) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>STILL WATERS (M Coleman) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ZED LEPELIN had difficulty obtaining clear running passing the 400 metres until near the 100 metres.</p> <p>ALL GOOD THINGS shifted out near the 350 metres and bumped RED ROBYN (D Johnson)</p> <p>WERTHER had to shift ground outwards near the 150 metres to continue to improve.</p>	

FEELIN THE LOVE was inclined to race greenly rounding the turn and passing the 200 metres lay in and had to be straightened, FEELIN THE LOVE then lay out over the final stages crowding TAKEN THE LIBERTY and WERTHER wider.	
Race 2	DHL HAWKE'S BAY GUINEAS PRELUDE
<p>SHERPA (M Coleman) shifted out abruptly on jumping bumping with LONGCHAMP (M Du Plessis) which in turn shifted out and bumped with GREEN JUNGLE (K Myers).</p> <p>AMUN RA (M Cameron) and XCUSES XCUSES (S Doyle) both began awkwardly with AMUN RA losing ground PAUA EYES (C Grylls) hung out and made the final turn awkwardly.</p> <p>M Cameron (AMUN RA) dropped his whip at the 250 metres.</p> <p>STRATOCASTER (M Chui) was obliged to make his finishing run wide rounding the final turn.</p>	
Race 3	BAY FORD PUNTER OF THE YEAR OCTOBER 4th MILE
<p>MAE WEST was a late scratching after twisting a plate and sustaining a pricked hoof upon arrival at the barriers.</p> <p>ROCKY (J Riddell) shifted in abruptly on jumping hampering NIGELISSIMA (M Chui) and PONDAROSA MISS (D Hain) which lost ground.</p> <p>CENTRE ATTENTION (K Chiong) was slow away.</p> <p>ROCKY (J Riddell) and FLINT (M Du Plessis) buffered for a short distance passing the 1300 metres.</p> <p>CENTRE ATTENTION raced wide approaching the first turn when over-racing</p> <p>WOLFWHISTLE (M Cameron) was held up early in the home straight.</p> <p>NIGELISSIMA (M Chui) shifted ground outwards to improve near the 300 metres forcing PONDAROSA MISS out onto the heels of CENTRE ATTENTION resulting in PONDAROSA MISS clipping CENTRE ATTENTION heels and blundering dislodging rider D Hain. M Chui admitted an associated breach of [Rule 638 (1)(d)] in that he shifted ground out when not clear. After deliberations the JCA suspended M Chui his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 31st August up to and including 28th September (4 weeks).</p> <p>Also hampered in consequence were WOLFWHISTLE and LADY PLATINUM (M Dee) which both had to take evasive action. A post-race examination of PONDAROSA MISS revealed a significant injury below the left eye including a collapsed nasal passage.</p>	
Race 4	THE WESTBURY CLUB HANDICAP
<p>WHOOPIE GEE (A Taylor) began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>MISS APPLETON (M Du Plessis) was crowded leaving the barriers and lost ground</p> <p>BLAME DE ANGELS (N Harris) was slow away.</p> <p>WHOOPIE GEE raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p>CASINO JACK (D Bradley) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>HESTOLEMYROSES (M Coleman) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>WHOOPIE GEE was held up briefly near the 500 metres.</p> <p>ACHOO (M Cameron) made the turn awkwardly with rider M Cameron advising the mare raced greenly throughout. A subsequent veterinary examination of ACHOO did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>PINK DIAMOND (R Hutching) was unable to find clear racing room for the majority of the final straight.</p> <p>SIR LANCELOT (M Chui) was held up rounding the turn and only obtained clear running near the 100 metres.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary inspection of WHOOPIE GEE which finished well back failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 5	LIVAMOL BLU SPRINT
<p>RED MAFIA was a late scratching after sustaining an injury en-route to the meeting.</p> <p>NEWTON PRINCE (N Harris) was slow away.</p> <p>KELLY O'REILLY (S McKay) raced three wide throughout.</p> <p>FANCY DRESS (M Coleman) over reacted when being steadied near the 1200 metres and shifted out hampering THE DARLING ONE (M Dee). FANCY DRESS then over-raced for some distance.</p> <p>DRAGON BEAUTY (J Parkes) was held up rounding the final turn until near the 250 metres.</p> <p>Both runners HEY MR (K Myers) and THE BOUNCER (M Du Plessis) were held up and unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight and went to the line untested.</p> <p>GWYNETHANNE (K Chiong) was crowded near the 200 metres when NEWTON PRINCE (N Harris) shifted in.</p> <p>NEWTON PRINCE returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A subsequent veterinary examination confirmed the gelding to be a bleeder and so is subject to the three month stand down from racing.</p>	
Race 6	REDWOOD SPRING STAYERS HANDICAP
<p>MAC AN ATHAIR (B Lammas) was slow away.</p> <p>ROYAL COMMAND (K Myers) began awkwardly and was slow away.</p> <p>PRINCE FEDERICO (L Innes) had to steady into the first bend when CALL ME MAYBE (P Holmes) shifted in when not fully clear. P Holmes was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.</p> <p>JIMMY MAC (D Bradley) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LASSWADE (M Dravitzki) was awkwardly placed and unable to improve near the 500 metres.</p> <p>CARBIDE (O Bosson) and RULE THE COURT (M Cameron) bumped briefly near the 300 metres.</p>	

Race 7	SWISS ACE SPRINT
<p>AGENT ZIVA (M Coleman) began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>BEST COMMAND (S McKay) jumped inwards at the start tightening RYAN MARK (D Johnson) , SMARTLY (K Chiong) and WEISSMULLER (C Johnson) which lost ground.</p> <p>AGENT ZIVA hung out rounding the turn and then was held up briefly entering the final straight.</p> <p>LIVING THE DREAM (M Du Plessis) was held up passing the 600 metres until near the 250 metres.</p> <p>GOSSIPING (B Lammas) was held up passing the 500 metres until the 250 metres.</p> <p>SMARTLY had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight</p> <p>Following this event the track was upgraded to a Dead 5.</p>	
Race 8	MAFKI CHALLENGE STAKES
<p>XANADU (M Coleman) jumped inwards abruptly at the start hampering NASHVILLE (J Riddell) and IAMISHWARA (C Johnson)</p> <p>VEYRON (R Norvall) bounded at the start and lost some ground.</p> <p>O'FILLE (N Harris) was tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>NASHVILLE raced in restricted room for several strides approaching the junction on to the course proper near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>SURVIVED (J Parkes) got its head up when being restrained near the 1000 metres, then raced ungenerously for a distance.</p> <p>PUSSY O'REILLY (K Myers) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>I DO (O Bosson) improved onto the heels of PURE CHAMPION (C Grylls) passing the 800 metres and had to be steadied.</p> <p>VEYRON raced keenly in the middle stages and near the 600 metres improved onto heels so was taken wider into clear running.</p> <p>ZENNISTA (H Tinsley) was held up early in the home straight until near the 200 metres.</p> <p>NASHVILLE was held up passing the 200 metres and near the 150 metres, when attempting a marginal run to the inside of SACRED STAR (L Innes), shifted in and bumped with ABIDEWITHME (M Cameron) which became unbalanced.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing run of RECITE (D Johnson), which after leading gave ground in the final straight, rider D Johnson could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination of RECITE including an endoscopic examination did not reveal any abnormalities. Trainer J Bary advised that RECITE would undergo further veterinary assessment early next week with the results being forwarded to the stewards.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of XANADU rider M Coleman could offer no excuse.</p>	
Race 9	STELLA ARTOIS PREMIER MILE
<p>R Myers replaced C Anderson on SHARE THE BLAME</p> <p>INTRANSIGENT (K Chiong) was slow away (4 Lengths)</p> <p>MAROTIRI MISS (M Dee) was tightened shortly after the start.</p> <p>FRANKLY (M Dravitzki) had to be eased approaching the first turn when awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>SHARE THE BLAME (R Myers) raced wide rounding the first turn.</p> <p>DANZA LAD (N Harris) over-raced when in restricted room near the 800 metres and was then angled wide to avoid the heels of INTRANSIGENT and in doing so bumped MAROTIRI MISS (M Dee)</p> <p>KARLA BRUNI (D Johnson) and LION RED (M Du Plessis) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early part of the final straight.</p> <p>DANZA LAD lay in under pressure throughout the final straight.</p>
