## RACE COMMENTS:

 Race 1
 PHAR LAP RACEWAY RST OPEN HURDLES (3000m)

**PUDDLE ALLEY** made a slow leap at the first fence.

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{MAN O'}}\xspace$  MANN raced wide through the early stages.

Passing the 1800 metres **MR NOBODY** became awkwardly placed on the heels of **NEEDASTAR** which had steadied for some distance. **MR NOBODY** clipped a heel and fell, dislodging rider S Karnicnik. As a result the trailing **SUPERCHARGED** which was unable to avoid the fallen runner was brought down, dislodging rider M Mitchell, and **GAGARIN** was badly unbalanced and dislodged rider S Fannin. **GARGAMEL** and **CECIL** which was badly inconvenienced lost ground in this incident. All fallen riders were attended to by St John Paramedics and cleared to fulfil their remaining riding engagements. Stewards opened

and adjourned an inquiry into this incident.

 $\ensuremath{\textbf{CECIL}}$  made a poor leap at the fence by the 1400 metres.

**NEEDASTAR** ran the fence down by the 1200 metres.

**CECIL** made a poor leap at the fence by the 1200 metres.

**PUDDLE ALLEY** made firm contact with the fences at the 1000 and 600 metres.

MAN O' MANN made a poor leap at the fence by the 200 metres

**PUDDLE ALLEY** made firm contact with the fence at the 200 metres, losing momentum.

HARRY HILL and GARGAMEL both made poor leaps at the last fence.

A post race veterinary inspection of **PUDDLE ALLEY** revealed a minor laceration to the off hind leg which did not require further veterinary attention.

## Race 2 SHAWEIGH MAIDEN HURDLES (3000m)

LORD YARBOROUGH was a late scratching at 10.39 am.

OTTO THE GREAT was slow to begin.

**PRINCE EDEN** made a poor leap at the fence by the 2800 metres, losing ground.

**SIR MANAWA** made a poor leap at the fence by the 2400 metres.

**ISHIPAL** made a poor leap at the fence by the 2200 metres and mixed its jumping from that point onwards.

ISHIPAL and CRYSTAL DUKE made poor leaps at the 1400 metres and lost ground.

**ISHIPAL** made a slow leap at the fence by the 1200 metres.

SIR MANAWA ran the fence down at the 600 metres.

ISHIPAL gave ground from the fence at the 600 metres.

**PROXIMITY** made a poor leap at the last fence, becoming unbalanced on landing.

**ISHIPAL** made poor leaps at the final two fences. Rider R Cuneen reported that in his opinion the gelding had failed to see out the distance of today's race and had mixed its jumping throughout to finish in last place. A post race veterinary inspection of **ISHIPAL** revealed a poor post race recovery.

A post race veterinary inspection of **PRINCE EDEN** revealed the gelding to be awkward in its gait, with the connections advised that a vet clearance including a blood test must be undertaken prior to racing next.

## Race 3 D'CASH MAIDEN DASH (1200m)

MYSTIFY ME was a late scratching at 11.23 am on veterinary advice.

**ALPINE JULZ** was a late scratching at 1.20 pm on veterinary advice after dislodging rider K Mudhoo enroute to the start. K Mudhoo was attended to by St John Paramedics and cleared to fulfil his remaining riding engagement.

**ROUGH RULER** and **GO SOLO** were slow to begin.

NAVA raced keenly in the early stages.

**DOLLYADAY** got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained passing the 900 metres.

TIMELINE raced wide throughout.

NAVA raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

**GO SOLO** was held up in the early stages of the home straight, eventually finding clear racing room passing the 200 metres. **NAVA** had to steady passing the 300 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **DOLLYADAY** which shifted outwards. **ROUGH RULER** shifted ground outwards passing the 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner **NAVA**, rider R Bishop advised that the filly had raced greenly and had not appreciated racing tight to the inside of **TIMELINE** adding in his opinion the filly would take benefit from today's race.

# RAY JONES & SONS PLASTERING SPRINT R65 (1200m)

BACK IN THE DAY began awkwardly and got back.

Shortly after the start **EL DORADO SUN** had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of **HELL RAISER** (C Johnson) which shifted inwards when insufficiently clear. Rider C Johnson was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. **OWE THE RANSOM** (K Mudhoo) shifted inwards passing the 1100 metres and placed **GARTARTAN LAD** in restricted room. **GARTARTAN LAD** and **EL DORADO SUN** made contact and jostled for some strides with **EL DORADO SUN** losing ground. Rider K Mudhoo was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).

GILD THE LILY and AFRICAN STAR raced wide in the early stages.

ASK ME was held up for clear racing room early in the home straight.

ASK ME and EL DORADO SUN raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 200 metres.

A post race veterinary inspection of **OWE THE RANSOM** which returned to the birdcage with blood present in its mouth revealed a laceration to the tongue.

# EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES RST OPEN STEEPLECHASE (4280m)

**KEEP IT TIGHT** made a poor leap at the fence near the 2400 metres.

**JAMIE LEE** made a poor leap at the fence near the 2000 metres.

KEEP IT TIGHT made a poor leap at the fence near the 1000 metres, becoming unbalanced on landing.

JAMIE LEE was retired from this race passing the 200 metres and did not jump the last fence.

# Race 6 PORT FM & ONCEUPONATIME HANDICAP R75 (1200m)

**CRAFTY LOVE** blundered at the start.

**RESPLENDENT** was slow to begin.

**IRONWORKER** got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained in the early stages.

**DAVONE CODE** raced wide throughout.

**SOMETHINGS BURNING** raced keenly in the middle stages.

Passing the 300 metres **WHISKEY BOLERO** (L Callaway) shifted out buffeting **SOMETHING'S BURNING** which was checked and lost momentum. Rider L Callaway defended a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d). After viewing the replays and hearing submissions the JCA upheld the charge and suspended L Callaway's licence to ride at race meetings for 2 days effective 13 to 20 June inclusive.

**COFFEE** which had been attempting a marginal run to the inside of **CRAFTY LOVE** near the 200 metres was checked and lost momentum when **CRAFTY LOVE** shifted in and became unbalanced when shying away from **WHISKEY BOLERO** which was improving forward and inward at this point.

Following this race the connections of 2<sup>nd</sup> placed **SOMETHINGS BURNING** lodged a protest against 1<sup>st</sup> placed **WHISKEY BOLERO** under the provisions of Rule 642(1) alleging interference near the 300 metres. After viewing the replays and considering submissions the JCA dismissed the protest.

Race 7 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE R65 (1600m)

**PIENZA** had to steady shortly after the start when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **MONEYFORJAM** which shifted in abruptly.

PLACID PRINCESS raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

**PLACID PRINCESS** made the bend at the 1300 metres awkwardly, shifting wider and forcing **PIENZA** over extra ground. Also affected were **ROYAL DOLLAR** and **KEYNOTE** which were hampered. **PIENZA** raced wide from that point on.

**ROYAL DOLLAR** raced ungenerously early.

Passing the 900 metres **PARTY ICE** was steadied for some distance when awkwardly placed on heels.

PLACID PRINCESS was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

**ROYAL DOLLAR** raced greenly in the final straight and shifted outwards having to be straightened passing the

200metres.**ROYAL DOLLAR** continued to lay outwards and was straightened again passing the 100 metres. The connections were advised that a warning had been placed on **ROYAL DOLLAR**'s racing manners.

**MONEYFORJAM** which returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils was deemed to be a bleeder, with the connections advised that the mare would be stood down for the mandatory three months. Trainers T & M Stokes advised it was their intention to retire **MONEYFORJAM** from their stable.

**GOODBYE SENORITA** returned to the birdcage with a minor laceration to the near hind fetlock which did not require treatment. Rider C Johnson advised that **GOODBYE SENORITA** had travelled comfortably in the running however when placed under pressure in the concluding stages had failed to run on and had been disappointing.

# Race 8 SPEIGHTS STAYERS R75 (2100m)

**DELACROIX** underwent a pre race veterinary inspection and was passed fit to race.

**DUCHESSOFCAMBRIDGE** over raced passing the 1900 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **DELACROIX**. **SOMETHING ZED** over raced in the early stages.

POPPAS DELIGHT made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly.

Passing the 1400 metres **MISTER SPIDERMAN** had to steady momentarily when **MESSINES** shifted outwards when taken forward to lead.

**SOMETHING ZED** over raced for some distance passing the 1400 metres due to the lack of tempo.

**MISTER SPIDERMAN** raced wide from the 1400 metres.

SOUTHERN RAIDER was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

When spoken to regarding the performance of **MISTER SPIDERMAN**, apprentice rider S Wynne advised that the gelding had not been suited by the muddling tempo of today's race.
