Race 1	NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race
<p>OKAGBARE (M Cameron) began awkwardly.</p> <p>COOL CASSIE (B Hutton) was slow away.</p> <p>OKAGBARE and QUEEN OF COOL (S Spratt) raced wide without cover rounding the bend.</p> <p>KEANDRA (M Sweeney) made the bend awkwardly when laying out, having to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of SLEEK SECRET (K Myers) near the 500 metres.</p> <p>DEVIANT MISS (R Smyth) was held up early in the final straight and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.</p> <p>KEANDRA shifted out under pressure passing the 50 metres, inconveniencing SLEEK SECRET and COOL CASSIE which were both forced wider on the track.</p>	

Race 2	NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race
<p>BOLSHOI BALLET was a late scratching at 10.15am after being injured in transit to the races. DE CHINE (K Myers) began awkwardly. ROCKET NAVIGATOR (V Gatu) shifted out passing the 600 metres and then raced wide without cover. DE CHINE raced greenly when making the final turn. SHERADREAM (B Hutton) was inclined to lay out when placed under pressure, shifting out inside the final 100 metres despite the efforts of its rider, inconveniencing SACRED DESIRE (L Innes) which had to steady approaching winning post.</p>	
Race 3	Owners & Trainers Lounge 1200
<p>BANNERMAN (D Johnson) was slow away. PRO FUMO (M Sweeney) began awkwardly. PIEOMIE (M McNab) bumped with SHANTAV (L Innes) near the 1100 metres with PIEOMIE then having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MISS ELEGANTE (A Jones). MISS ELEGANTE raced three wide without cover. PRO FUMO raced greenly in the early to middle stages. SCHOLES (B Hutton) was held up for clear running early in the final straight. FORTIUS (P Holmes) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight. DIVERGENT (S Collett) shifted out approaching the 100 metres to avoid the heels of the tiring BUSTER BLOODVESSEL (S Spratt).</p>	
Race 4	Racing at Avondale Friday 17 July 2015
<p>WILL FERRET was reluctant to walk up behind the barriers prior to the start. Trainer Mr S Marsh was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding. The Starter was spoken to regarding the manner in which the buggy whip was used in an attempt to encourage WILL FERRET to load. KING TAI SING (R Smyth) was slow away. VENTURA (M McNab) and JUST CALL ME RIO (T Thornton) came together when leaving the barriers. TRISHA (B Hutton) began awkwardly and raced ungenerously in the early stages losing ground. Both TRISHA and KING TAI SING then continued to lose ground losing contact with the body of the field in the early stages. KATANGO (S Collett) also lost contact with the body of the field going into the bend near the 900 metres. JUST CALL ME RIO over-raced in the early stages making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly. STABIKRAFT (P Holmes) raced wide without cover. LARCENY (C Lammass) over-raced when being steadied passing the 800 metres then having to be restrained to avoid the heels of JUST CALL ME RIO with LARCENY then shifting outwards, hampering DINAH LEE (M Coleman). VENTURA shifted out approaching the 400 metres with JUST CALL ME RIO shifting away from that runner when hanging, becoming awkwardly placed and steadying. VENTURA shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 350 metres inconveniencing RICO (M Cameron) which had commenced to weaken. Rider D Johnson (WILL FERRET) was reprimanded regarding her whip use prior to the 200 metres, further being advised that a warning would be placed on her record. LARCENY underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have a slower than normal recovery rate.</p>	
Race 5	Jones Accounting & Financial Services 2100
<p>RUM'N'COKE (M McNab) began awkwardly. EL DISPARO (S Collett) began awkwardly, crowding VERY ASTUTE (M Hills) on to BIXBY (D Johnson). STYLE IS ETERNAL (M Cameron) had a tendency to over-race in the early and middle stages. Passing the 1700 metres ARITE GURU (R Smyth) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of SKY MUSIC (C Lammass). ARITE GURU then over-raced for a distance. Passing the 600 metres INA JAM (L Magorrian) shifted out making contact with the hind quarters of SHEEZ THE BOSS (K Myers) which then shifted out slightly with TUKAWA (BR Jones) which was awkwardly placed on that runner's heels then shifting out, hampering RIVA BALLERINA (R Scott) which was weakening, which shifted out and hampered BIXBY and MIA ROSE (U Holmquist). Rider B Jones was advised he must exercise greater care in similar circumstances. Passing the 300 metres SHEEZ THE BOSS was briefly crowded between EL DISPARO and TUKAWA both of which shifted ground.</p>	

VERY ASTUTE which became tailed off during the running, underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 6 | **www.ajc.co.nz 1200**

NULLA CREEK (C Lammas) and **BLUE POOL BLUR** (S Collett) were slow away.

CROSSBOW (D Johnson) began awkwardly.

SPECIAL DUKE (M Coleman) commenced to over-race when being steadied near the 1000 metres continuing to do so through the middle stages.

RAROONEY (R Smyth) raced three wide without cover.

BLUE POOL BLUR got its head up and raced ungenerously going into the bend near the 900 metres.

Approaching the 600 metres **PRINCE OF PASSION** (M McNab) shifted out off the heels of **MR LUIGI** (S Spratt) which was steadying, forcing **SUMMER'S DAY** (L Innes) wider on the track. Forced wider as a result was **WINTIME** (M Hills). Rider M McNab was advised he must exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

SPECIAL DUKE (M Coleman) had to shift in approaching the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

When questioned regarding the performance of **WINTIME** Rider M Hills advised that after being pushed wide when making the final bend the filly had taken some time to recover but in his opinion would benefit from the experience of today's race.

Race 7 | **Harry Skinner Memorial 1600**

PREMINGER (L Magorrian) and **READY TO RUMBLE** (U Holmquist) were both fractious in the barriers.

CHASING AMY (T Thornton) was slow to begin (4L).

BAHRELLA (A Jones) began awkwardly hampering **BRAVO SUPREMO** (M McNab) and **PREMINGER**.

LOUVRES (S Spratt) began awkwardly.

NOWHERE MAN (M Cameron) hung outwards throughout.

PREMINGER raced wide throughout.

NOWHERE MAN continued to hang out in the final straight placing its rider at a disadvantage.

THE ARABIAN DUKE (S Collett) shifted away from **THE HAWK** (D Johnson) approaching the 300 metres crowding **POSTD'OR** (B Hutton) briefly.

Race 8 | **Bundy Lad G2 Memsie Stakes Winner 1400**

NIGHEAN (R Smyth) jumped inwards when leaving the barriers, hampering **RICH TED** (S Spratt).

HEEZA DREIMER (A Jones) and **ROYAL COMMAND** (M McNab) were slow away.

JUD STRUNK (D Hain) raced wide without cover.

CHECKOUTTHEMISSSES (C Lammas) commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 1200 metres and continued to do so for a distance.

Passing the 900 metres **SPRINGLOADED** (U Holmquist) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **NIGHEAN** which steadied when shifting in. Apprentice Rider R Smyth was advised she must exercise greater care.

HE'S A BIGDEEL (M Cameron) was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight, shifting in approaching the 300 metres.

GOTTA KEEPER (BR Jones) shifted out passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 9 | **Rosebank Business Association 1400**

SOUTHERNMAN (L Magorrian) was slow away (3L).

RIVER FORCE (K Myers) shifted out slightly when being steadied off the heels of **THE GREAT FOX** (BR Jones) near the 800 metres making contact with **MILLS 'N' BOON** (Z Moki) whose rider became unbalanced hampering **LAFFAIRE** (D Johnson).

SYRIANA (M Hills) shifted outwards near the 700 metres with **CHADSDALE** (C Lammas) then becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels and shifting outwards hampering **MOST LIKELY** (T Thornton) and **ICE COOL** (A Jones) which were both taken wider on the track.

CHADSDALE shifted outwards under pressure over the concluding stages crowding **ICE COOL** on to **KEEPHERINMIND** (M Coleman) just short of the finish.
