Race 1 Pancake House OMA 3100 Hurdle

MUTT WILLIAMS (Emily Farr) jumped the first fence poorly.

MANOEUVRE (C Singer) and BALLYPIPER (D Miller) put in poor jumps at the second fence losing momentum.

Passing the 2700 metres **WEST END** (Shaun Phelan) had to steady then becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **MAGNA CARTA** (A Kuru) which shifted out.

MANOEUVRE landed awkwardly at the fence near the 2200 metres and shifted out hampering **MUTT WILLIAMS**. **MANOEUVRE** jumped indifferently for the remainder of the race

At the fence near the 2000 metres **ISDABICKY** (A Tata) put in a poor jump and knuckled badly on landing almost dislodging its rider.

MANOEUVRE and MUTT WILLIAMS became tailed off and did not jump the final three fences.

MR CHEZ (M Mitchell) hit the second to last fence hard and fell and badly hampered in the incident was ISDABICKY. A post-race veterinary examination of ISTABICKY found the gelding to have a laceration to the right nostril.

Near the 2900 metres **GET FLASH** (M McNelis) shifted in abruptly crowding **MONI NUI** (D Miller) in onto **BACK IN BLACK** (C Thornton) which was also crowded making contact with the running rail.

Passing the 2700 metres **GET FLASH** improved into a marginal run to the inside of **ENDOR** (M Mitchell) and was hampered. Passing the 2500 metres **GET FLASH** went off stride and ducked out.

BACK IN BLACK put in a poor jump at the fence near the 2200 metres knuckling on landing almost dislodging its rider.

ENDOR put in a poor jump at the third to last fence and knuckled on landing becoming unbalanced.

BACK IN BLACK knuckled on landing at the last fence becoming unbalance.

Race 3 Super Liquor Te Aroha 1000

THE SECRET'S OUT (Danielle Johnson) and VIRTUOUS (M Cameron) were slow to begin.

JAYLA MONET (U Holmquist) began very awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of **FLYING SIEGE** (T Thornton) with both runners losing ground.

Passing the 700 metres **THE SECRET'S OUT** became awkwardly placed on the heels of **SUFFIRE** (J Wong) which was racing greenly.

MY PALOMA (D Hain) lay in passing the 300 metres having to straighten when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MAIA'S ANGEL (M Du Plessis) then continued to lay in for the remainder of the race.

THE SECRET'S OUT raced greenly in the final straight.

VIRTUOUS lay in under pressure over the final 100 metres.
