Racing Te Aroha, 27 May 2015 Race 3 – Silver Fern Farms 2200 Following a meeting with the Racing Integrity Unit, Tuesday 2 June 2015, rider H Voss has relinquished her Class D Riders Licence. The Racing Integrity Unit has subsequently withdrawn two charges against H Voss that were filed with the Judicial Control Authority. H Voss has been relicensed as a Class E Rider, and is eligible to ride in races which are for Amateur Riders only.
Auckland Racing Club, 1 June 2015 Race 8 – Laser Group R65 1200 Mr G Rogerson was fined \$50 by the Judicial Committee after presenting SCUSA to race with incorrect gear.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	JIM FURNESS GRADER SERVICES 2000
JEM RUNNER (M Mitchell) was slow to begin, and then was further inconvenienced by QUANDO (E Farr) which shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier.	

<p>PRIZE LORD (D Miller) and STRATEGICLEIGH (C Studd) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>EL HEALO (P Ormsby) raced in restricted room to the inside of ZORY STAR (A Tata) passing the 1500 metres having to briefly steady.</p> <p>PRIZE LORD raced wide in the early and middle stages. PRIZE LORD commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>STRATEGICLEIGH lost the right front plate during the running.</p> <p>T Harris (ANNA KAYE) admitted a charge under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 200 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$300.</p>	
Race 2	SLATTERY CONTRACTING LTD 1400
<p>P Holmes was issued with a Minor Infringement Notice and fined the sum of \$200 after failing to make the carded weight for IN MEMORY OF. Due to no other suitable replacement rider having arrived on course P Holmes rode IN MEMORY OF at 1 kg over-weight.</p> <p>HARDY'S REVENGE (M Coleman) began awkwardly initially shifting out and making contact with CANCELLARA (K Myers), and then shifting back in making contact with FREEWHEELER (R Smyth).</p> <p>UP ON THE ROOF (L Magorrian) began awkwardly, and then was hampered by HERE'SHOPING (M Cameron) which shifted out.</p> <p>HUBBLE BUBBLE (M Hills) was crowded leaving the barrier between FORTUNE KEPT (S Collett) and MONEYBOX (D Johnson) both of which had begun awkwardly with HUBBLE BUBBLE losing ground.</p> <p>FREEWHEELER had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 800 metres CHAMPAGNE TASTES (S McKay) was steadied off heels and shifted out when awkwardly placed inconveniencing SCANDINAVIAN (C Lammas), IN MEMORY OF and HUBBLE BUBBLE which were all forced wider on the track.</p>	
Race 3	PGG WRIGHTSON 1600
<p>R Cole was granted permission to ride LUCKY RUBY 1 kg over-weight at his declared riding weight of 66 kgs as there was no other highweight rider available.</p> <p>VITALI (E Farr), DAHLS DELIGHT (S Karnicnik) and HEISTHEONE (P Ormsby) began awkwardly.</p> <p>BEVERLEY BECK (G Walsh) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>Approaching the 1500 metres VITALI commenced to lay out becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of DAHLS DELIGHT before clipping a heel of that runner and falling, badly hampering BEVERLEY BECK which lost ground. Rider E Farr was uninjured. VITALI underwent a veterinary examination which found the gelding to be bleeding from the right nostril due to the external trauma along with suffering abrasions to the right knee and left hock requiring veterinary treatment.</p>	
Race 4	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>FOUR DAY HIGH (B R Jones) was slow to begin.</p> <p>CARDINAL SIN (C Lammas) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>NATHALIE FALMET (C Grylls) began awkwardly initially making contact with LUCRETIA (S Spratt), then shifting back in making contact with SETAROSSA (S Collett) with NATHALIE FALMET losing ground.</p> <p>SETAROSSA lay out approaching the 1400 metres making contact with NATHALIE FALMET.</p> <p>SETAROSSA was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of NATHALIE FALMET near the 1200 metres. Contributing was slight outward movement from ROCK ROSE (M Cameron).</p>	
Race 5	TEAM WEALLEANS 1200
<p>POCKETS (C Lammas) began awkwardly, and then was crowded.</p> <p>LOTUS LAUD (D Hain) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Shortly after the start ZEDSATIONAL (S McKay) shifted in abruptly with SON OF CIVICS (U Holmquist) and LOTUS LAUD both becoming crowded and losing ground.</p> <p>INTENSE (D Johnson) raced in restricted room momentarily approaching the 1000 metres.</p> <p>POCKETS over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Passing the 350 metres SON OF CIVICS lay out inconveniencing DYLAN DE LAGO (M McNab) and ZEDSATIONAL.</p> <p>Rider U Holmquist reported that SON OF CIVICS had got its tongue over the bit during the running.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of INTENSE rider D Johnson could not offer any excuse for the gelding's poor performance today. A post-race veterinary inspection, including an endoscopic examination, revealed the gelding to be showing signs of a respiratory infection requiring veterinary treatment. Co-trainer Mr A Scott confirmed that INTENSE would now be spelled.</p>	
Race 6	MURRAY WILCOX LTD 1200
<p>PRESIDENT TOMADO (M Cameron) shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier crowding HOYT AXTON (B Hutton).</p> <p>LEON (S Spratt) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>ALMIGHTY SUN (L Magorrian) shifted out making contact with RUSSIAN MAGIC (U Holmquist) leaving the barrier.</p> <p>SHEEMA (M McNab) and ARCADE (S Collett) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of ALMIGHTY SUN apprentice L Magorrian advised that the gelding had not</p>	

felt comfortable in today's track conditions and in his opinion would be better suited by looser footing.	
Race 7	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>SOMBREUIL (M Coleman) began awkwardly making contact with CRYSTALIGHT (V Colgan) losing ground.</p> <p>SAYWHEN (D Johnson) shifted out leaving the barrier with VIVA LA JOUR (M Hills) shifting away from that runner and crowding MERITAGGIO (L Magorrian) which lost ground. Contributing was inward movement from DARTING (S McKay) which had begun awkwardly and shifted in.</p> <p>Approaching the 1200 metres RUBEE (M Cameron) lay out and away from CRYSTALIGHT which shifted out slightly crowding SAYWHEN which was steadied.</p> <p>MANAIA ROSE (U Holmquist) shifted in under pressure passing the 150 metres inconveniencing SOMBREUIL.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination of SAYWHEN did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 8	MATAMATA TRACTORS & MACHINERY 1400
<p>Trainer Mr G Rogerson was fined \$50 by the Judicial Committee after presenting ARMANDO (S Collett) to race with incorrect gear.</p> <p>SIR FRANCIS (M McNab) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MY SMILEY O'REILLY (B Hutton) shifted out leaving the barrier crowding TINY BIT BIG (C Perrett) and PAID PRIORITY (D Johnson) with PAID PRIORITY being hampered losing ground.</p> <p>Rider C Perrett (TINY BIT BIG) was spoken to regarding his use of the whip over the concluding stages.</p>
