Race 2 GREYTOWN FRESHCHOICE 3YO 1400

LYRIC'S WAY (L Hemi) shifted out abruptly on jumping hampering DR WATSON (S McKay) which lost ground.

HOT IN THE CITY (A Collett) was slow away.

POROTENE RIPPA (R Hannam) and ST MATTHEW (H Tinsley) came together at the start.

DR WATSON was denied a marginal run to the inside of **STORMFORCE WINDS (J Riddell)** passing the 250 metres and had to shift ground inwards across that runner's heels to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

Race 3 SOUTH WAIRARAPA VETERINARY SERVICES 1400

M McNelis was issued with a Minor Infringement Notice and fined \$200 under Rule 330 (3) (c) when he was unable to make the weight on VERACIOUS in this event as well as FRUITION (r4), SLACK THE DIVER (r6) and PHOENIX TYCOON (r7). N Teeluck rode VERACIOUS.

TUMNAHULLA (D Bradley) hung out abruptly leaving the barrier tightening **IF POSSIBLE (R Norvall)** which lost ground. **QUEENOFHARPZ (R Hannam)** was slow to begin.

GOLDYSOX (J Shackleton) over-raced in the early stages.

QUEENOFHARPZ (R Hannam) was held up rounding the final bend and was unable to find clear running throughout the final straight, going to the line untested.

VERACIOUS was held up in the early part of the final straight and then raced in restricted room over the final stages. **GOLDYSOX (J Shackleton)** lay out under pressure rounding the final turn taking **ALARINDA (R Myers)** and **POROTENE MAGNUM (J Parkes)** wider.

Race 4 FAULTY & SYBIL'S DAY OUT 1000

ARCHANGEL (J Parkes); KERMIT (T Johnson) and THEODORE (R Goldsbury) were all slow away.

OUR DEBUTANTE (S McKay) and **KEEPTHESECRET (H Tinsley)** bumped near the 200 metres when both runners shifted ground.

Race 5 PLATINUM HOMES 2200

The start was delayed when **SHOT OF IRISH** proved difficult to load. Trainer **J Wallace** was advised that a warning would be placed on the mare's barrier manners.

THE DUKE'S SECRET (R Hannam) jumped inward at the start bumping with MAC DARA (R Norvall).

AL MUNROE (T Johnson) began awkwardly and settled back.

I'MA COLOMBIAN (A Collett) jumped away slowly and then contacted the hindquarters of CAN COUP (J Parkes) and lost ground in consequence.

SHOT OF RISH (R Myers) raced wide around the first turn.

AL MUNROE raced wide throughout.

I'MA COLOMBIAN improved onto heels near the 600 metres and had to be steadied.

I'MA COLOMBIAN was obliged to make its finishing run wide around the final bend.

Rider **N Teeluck** reported that in his opinion **FRUITION** got its tongue over the bit and was not persevered with over the final stages.

Race 6 RANCHMANS 2050

ZARTAN (M Dravitzki) was tightened and lost ground leaving the barriers.

SOU'EAST (R Myers) was slow away.

WOTABUZZ (J Shackleton) had to steady shortly after the start when inside SAN PEDRO (J Riddell) and VICEROY (A Collett which were crowded inwards by SLACK THE DIVER (L Hemi). L Hemi was issued with a warning.

JACK'S BOY (H Tinsley) and JIMMY MAC (S McKay) raced wide around the first bend with JIMMY MAC continuing to race wide throughout.

SELWYN (K Smith) raced wide in the run through the back straight.

ZARTAN over-raced in the middle stages.

IF I CAN I CAN (R Hannam) compounded near the 600 metres and was not persevered with. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be displaying an irregular heartbeat. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance, including the results of an ECG, must be produced prior to **IF I CAN I CAN** next racing.

Following the event connections of the second placed **JACK'S BOY** lodged a protest against the winner **JIMMY MAC** alleging interference over the final stages. After hearing all evidence and submissions the JCA upheld the protest and placings now read 2-7-10-6-13

S McKay admitted an associated charge of careless riding under Rule 638 (1) (d) and after considering submissions on penalty the Judicial Committee suspended Apprentice McKay's licence to ride in races from the close of racing on Thursday 4 June 2015 until the close of racing on Wednesday 17 June 2015 (5 days)

L Hemi the rider of **SLACK THE DIVER** which finished tailed off advised that the gelding's breathing was irregular during the running. The Stewards ordered that a veterinary clearance, including endoscopic examination following a gallop of a minimum of 1000 metres, must be furnished prior to **SLACK THE DIVER** next racing.

Race 7 CHALLENGE GREYTOWN 1600

JAZZ ROCK (S McKay) and ZEDBEE (C O'Bierne) were slow to begin.

RED MELODY (L Hemi) hung out leaving the barriers crowding **FRIED RICE (M Dravitzki)** which was tightened and lost ground.

FRIED RICE over-raced in the early and middle stages.

CHANTILLY LASS (A Collett) was held up and unable to improve near the straight entrance only obtaining clear running passing the 100 metres and when attempting to improve into a narrow run near the 200 metres.bumped with **MASH (K Smith)**

MISS PROFESSIONAL (D Bradley) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight so was angled out near the 75 metres to improve.

PARTY GIRL (R Norvall) lay out under pressure in the final straight,

When questioned regarding the performance of **JACKOFALL, J Parkes** reported that the gelding failed to see out the 1600 metres and would be better suited to a shorter distance.

Race 8 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

KATIE O'CEIRIN (J Parkes), CRAFTY LADY (S McKay); WAIZ ONE (N Teeluck) and NIPPA MARY (R Norvall) were all slow away.

TARIHIRA (R Myers) raced wide throughout.

CRAFTY LADY hung out rounding the first turn.

KATIE O'CEIRIN went off-stride momentarily near the 50 metres.
