RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MID WINTER CHRISTMAS RACES JUNE 20 RATING 75 (1200m)
<p>PERCY POSSUM began awkwardly. CORBYN was slow to begin. DOMINIO shifted out on jumping hampering SOMETHINGS BURNING and RIVERTAINÉ COUP. SOMETHINGS BURNING and COFFEE over raced for a distance passing the 900 metres. DOMINIO raced greenly when making the junction onto the course proper near the 600 metres and hung out hampering SOMETHINGS BURNING and ACHOO. DOMINIO then continued to hang out and was unable to be ridden to any advantage thereafter. Trainers N & R Lloyd were advised that a warning had been placed against DOMINIO's racing manners. SOMETHINGS BURNING lay out under pressure in the final straight. PERCY POSSUM raced greenly when placed under pressure near the 400 metres.</p>	

D Walsh (ACHOO) reported that in his opinion the mare would be better suited to a longer distance.	
Race 2	NZ BLOODSTOCK TWO-YEAR-OLD (1200m)
<p>JOHNNY JONES began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>HAPI ASSASSIN raced fiercely for a short distance in the early stages.</p> <p>LINDIS PASS raced three wide throughout and was momentarily hampered passing the 600 metres when HAPI ASSASSIN made the junction awkwardly.</p>	
Race 3	RICCARTON PARK FUNCTION CENTRE OPEN HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>PARAKETO began awkwardly.</p> <p>PARAKETO was held up in the early stages of the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of JAZZMAN, apprentice rider A Morgan was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited to being challenged in the lead.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner MEURSAULT, rider M Cameron advised that the mare had been out-paced throughout but battled fairly over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 4	SPEIGHT'S MID ALE RATING 75 (2000m)
<p>MISTER SPIDERMAN was slow to begin and got back.</p> <p>MISTER SPIDERMAN had to be steadied off heels for a short distance passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>NO EMOTION was held up in the early part of the final straight.</p> <p>MISTER SPIDERMAN lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the improved performance of COMMANDING OAK, trainer M Pitman advised that the gelding had benefited from the step up in distance and the firmer nature of today's going.</p> <p>Apprentice B Murray was issued with a warning in respect of his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres and advised that he must modify his riding style.</p>	
Race 5	DOWNLOAD OUR APP NOW MAIDEN (1400m)
<p>NAKOMA struck the barriers when jumping and as a result began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>WANDERIN ALONG was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers and lost ground.</p> <p>MUSTANG SALLY raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>JIGGER INN (S Spratt) was held up in the early part of the final straight and when taken out near the 350 metres to improve shifted out into the line of RAPT N RED which had to steady. S Spratt was advised to exercise care. A little further on JIGGER INN bumped with TELL THE WORLD which was hanging in under pressure.</p> <p>FERAL ICE was held up passing the 600 metres to near the 300 metres and had difficulty finding clear running for the remainder.</p> <p>TOMM JONES was held up for the majority of the final straight, only obtaining clear running passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>GALAXY GARDENS over-raced for some distance near the 100 metres and had to be restrained off heels.</p> <p>D Walsh, the rider of TELL THE WORLD, reported that the gelding had hung throughout and could not be ridden to full advantage.</p>	
Race 6	FIBER-FRESH RATING 75 (1600m)
<p>KAGE IS KING began awkwardly.</p> <p>PRINCE RANSOM, CLEM, FOREVER VITAL and KAGE IS KING all over raced passing the 1200 metres when the tempo eased.</p> <p>CLEM was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>KAGE IS KING was held up for a short distance on entering the final straight.</p> <p>VANQUISHED had to steady passing the 200 metres when placed in restricted room between DOUBLE BLUE and PRINCE RANSOM (M Cameron) which lay in under hard riding. M Cameron was advised he must exercise greater care.</p>	
Race 7	LINDAUER OPEN HANDICAP (1600m)
<p>KING PRAWN was slow to begin.</p> <p>DICKENS began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>KING PRAWN had to be steadied off heels near the 800 metres when racing keenly.</p> <p>CAPO raced keenly for a short distance passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>KING PRAWN was crowded and had to steady passing the 500 metres when inside DICKENS (A Collett). After questioning riders and viewing footage it was determined that DICKENS, after shifting inwards to improve, had been taken in marginally when awkwardly inside the heels of ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA when that runner lay in. Given all the circumstances Miss Collett was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised she must exercise greater care in future when shifting ground.</p> <p>RED RIPPER which returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils underwent a post-race veterinary inspection and was declared a bleeder. RED RIPPER was stood down for the mandatory three months.</p>	
Race 8	CHRISTCHURCH CASINO RATING 65 (1800m)
<p>SOMETHING ZED stood flat footed when the barriers were released and losing several lengths.</p> <p>PARTY ICE, which was fractious in the barriers, reared as the start was made, severely unbalancing rider S Wynne with this in PARTY ICE being slow away.</p> <p>PROPITIOUS and INIS ROSE were slow away.</p> <p>INIS ROSE raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SOMETHING ZED over raced badly throughout.</p>	

MISSTEEFLYING was crowded when placed in restricted room near the 400 metres between **BELLALEAH** and **ANGEL FALLS**.

Race 9

RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (1400m)

GOTTAGETMYWOOHOO began awkwardly and lost ground.

EMM GEE began awkwardly and shortly after was hampered when **SPRINGWATER** shifted in on leaving the barriers.

SPRINGWATER was then in turn crowded for a short distance when inside **KODEMA** which was taken in by **BIG HOSS** (S Muniandy) which was improving forward to lead. **S Muniandy** was issued with a warning and advised he must maintain his correct line of running when leaving the barriers.

SPRINGWATER was restrained early and over-raced for some distance thereafter.

KODEMA raced three wide without cover throughout.

MAL D'MOUR raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

SPRINGWATER was crowded and directed inward near the 1000 metres when **PLACID PRINCESS** (S Wynne) shifted in to obtain a position more adjacent to the rail. **S Wynne** was issued with a warning and advised she must ensure full clearance exists when shifting ground.

SPRINGWATER was held up rounding the turn and only obtained clear running near the 150 metres.

DIAMOND EDGE was held up passing the 400 metres and when in clear running near the 250 metres raced greenly.
