## Race 1 PLACEMAKERS MAIDEN

**JUST COLLIE** (K Smith) was tightened leaving the barriers between **SERENE STAR** (L Hemi) and **TE MATA'S HORSE** (R Hannam), both of which shifted ground.

**MA BELLE KATE** (R Goldsbury) over-raced in the early stages and passing the winning post on the first occasion had to be steadied when awkwardly placed near the heels of **NO QUOTA** (M Dravitzki).

**UPPER CUT** (T Johnson) over-raced through the early and middle stages.

NO QUOTA raced three wide without cover from near the 1200 metres.

MA BELLE KATE made the bend near the 400 metres awkwardly.

**UPPER CUT** lay inwards under pressure over the final 50 metres.

Rider M McNelis (HANCOCK) was issued with a warning with regards to the use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

## Race 2 GUTHRIE BOWRON SUPERSTORE MAIDEN

**ELUSIVE JANE** (S McKay) was slow to begin.

CHATEAU MAROUX (R Hannam) got its head up when being restrained near the 900 metres.

ALLEZ VOUS (M McNelis) raced wide without cover throughout.

**ELUSIVE JANE** had to be steadied near the 600 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of **RED BORDEAUX** (R Myers).

**BELLA MOSSA** (U Holmquist) shifted inwards under pressure near the 50 metres inconveniencing **MAYARI** (K Myers). When questioned regarding the performance of **RED BORDEAUX**, rider R Myers could offer no tangible excuse.

### Race 3 CARTERS HANDICAP

ALLSTARS (K Myers) shifted in leaving the barriers bumping heavily with DON'T BLAME BUSTER (U Holmquist).

**BACHELOR MAN** (M Singh) began awkwardly and was then inclined to lay inwards for a short distance.

**DON'T BLAME BUSTER** commenced to over-race near the 900 metres having to be firmly restrained off the heels of **SPENDAHOLIC** (S McKay).

**BACHELOR MAN** over-raced in the early and middle stages.

ITSA HOUDINI (K Chiong) raced wide without cover throughout.

**DON'T BLAME BUSTER** had to be steadied for a distance near the 500 metres when improving up onto the heels of **SPENDAHOLIC.** 

BY THE POWERS (J Shackleton) lay out rounding the bend near the 400 metres.

**SPENDAHOLIC** (S McKay) shifted outwards near the 350 metres momentarily hampering **ITS AHOUDINI**. S McKay was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

**ALLSTARS** raced in restricted room near the 100 metres.

THE QUIET MAN (D Bradley) lost its near hind-plate during the running.

#### Race 4 NOEL'S BUILDINGS MAIDEN

**SAINT JUNE** (M Singh) began awkwardly.

**DAL AMORE** (J Shackleton) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**ALAMBER** (D Bradley) raced three wide without cover throughout.

HIGH COMMISSIONER (H Tinsley) was held up entering the final straight until obtaining clear running near the 200 metres.

WHOSTAKIN YOUHOME (R Hannam) lay inwards under pressure near the 200 metres and had to be straightened.

VITALIA (J Parkes) hung in throughout the final straight and had to be continuously straightened.

When questioned regarding the performance of ALAMBER, rider D Bradley could offer no tangible excuse.

## Race 5 BENCHTOP SURFACES HANDICAP

**ROYAL HAZE** (S McKay) reared leaving the barriers, settling back.

POPPAS DELIGHT (C O'Beirne) over-raced in the early stages and near the 900 metres hung outwards into the line of

ROYAL HAZE which was tightened and had to change ground.

## Race 6 SPRAY SPECIALISTS MAIDEN

JACKSSTAR (R Hannam) began awkwardly.

**DAL LAUREON** (C O'Beirne) raced wide without cover.

**MEZZALUNA** (L Hemi) over-raced in the early stages and had to be steadied off the heels of **JITZU** near the 900 metres.

**MY ALAROSE** (D Bradley) commenced to give ground rapidly from near the 600 metres. When questioned, Rider D Bradley could offer no tangible excuse.

### Race 7 GARY DYER PAINTERS & DECORATORS HANDICAP

**ZINIKA** (M Dravitzki) was declared a late scratching at 3.29pm after becoming cast in its gate. Connections were advised that a warning is placed against **ZINIKI** with regard to its barrier manners.

ANOTHER BACHELOR (S McKay) and LUAS (M Singh) came together leaving the barriers.

**ADRIENNE** (L Hemi) jumped away awkwardly.

LE MANS (J Parkes) was slow to begin.

**NEEDS TO PLAY** (K Chiong) raced wide without cover throughout.

**ADRIENNE** shifted out under pressure over the final 150 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **NEEDS TO PLAY**, rider K Chiong reported that the mare may have been unsuited to today's heavy track conditions.

Rider M Singh (LUAS) dropped his whip passing the 400 metres.
