## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>CAL ISUZU HURDLE</b>
<p><b>HUNTERS CREEK</b> (M Gillies) ran down the second and fourth fences.</p> <p><b>AUTHENTIC</b> (A Kuru) misjudged the fourth fence.</p> <p><b>ZA BRUTE</b> (E Farr) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>DERBY DAN</b> (M Mitchell) raced in restricted room when attempting to improve to the inside of <b>ZA BRUTE</b> having to be steadied near the 700 metres.</p> <p><b>AUTHENTIC</b> put in a poor jump at the third last fence.</p> <p><b>ZA BRUTE</b> and <b>AUTHENTIC</b> landed awkwardly after jumping the final fence.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>PORRITT SAND WAIKATO HURDLES</b>
<p><b>PROLOGUE</b> (A Kuru) and <b>ENDOR</b> (R Cully) put in poor jumps at the first fence.</p> <p><b>JUST GOT HOME</b> (D Nolan) jumped the second fence indifferently.</p> <p><b>ENDOR</b> shifted inwards crowding <b>WEE BISKIT</b> (E Farr) on to the hind quarters of <b>JUST GOT HOME</b> going into the first turn near the 2600 metres. R Cully was issued with a warning. <b>JUST GOT HOME</b> then made the bend awkwardly, and continued to race ungenerously when being restrained to avoid the heels of <b>MAHARISHI</b> (D Miller).</p> <p><b>THENAMESBOND</b> (M Gillies) badly misjudged the fifth fence near the 2000 metres, and knuckled on landing.</p> <p><b>JUST GOT HOME</b> again raced ungenerously when being steadied off the heels of <b>MAHARISHI</b> near the 1600 metres, and shifted outwards hampering <b>ENDOR</b> which was forced outwards into the line of <b>COMTE DE JEU</b> (A Tata).</p> <p><b>ENDOR</b> misjudged the fence near the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>THENAMESBOND</b> jumped the third last fence poorly.</p> <p>A Kuru (<b>PROLOGUE</b>) dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>NRM 1200</b>
<p><b>THE LAST SHOWER</b> (A Collett) jumped away awkwardly.</p>	

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>ALLIED SECURITY STEEPLECHASE</b>
<p><b>NELLS BELLE</b> (C Studd) underwent a veterinary inspection at the start being declared a late scratching at 12.11 pm as it was lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr N O'Dowd was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to <b>NELLS BELLE</b> racing next.</p> <p><b>THE OYSTERMAN</b> (E Farr) jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p><b>REVEAL</b> (T Harris) put in poor jumps at the third and fourth fences.</p> <p><b>JOKING</b> badly misjudged the fifth fence dislodging rider M Mitchell who was then struck by <b>REVEAL</b> which was attempting to take evasive action losing ground in the process. M Mitchell was checked by the course doctor and cleared to fulfil his remaining engagement.</p> <p><b>REVEAL</b> put in a poor jump at the first fence in the front straight on the first occasion (6<sup>th</sup> fence) before running down the next fence when hampered by the riderless horse. T Harris' saddle then shifted forwards with <b>REVEAL</b> being retired from the race shortly after.</p> <p><b>MANGAROA HUSTLER</b> (M Gillies) misjudged the fence near the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>IT'S A MESSAGE</b> (R Cully) misjudged the second last fence.</p> <p><b>SUNSET PASS</b> (D Miller) put in a poor jump at the second last fence and fell. Rider D Miller was uninjured. A veterinary examination of <b>SUNSET PASS</b> found the gelding to have suffered a hematoma to the chest region along with abrasions to the right fore and left hind legs.</p> <p><b>THE PAINTER</b> (R Cole) knuckled after jumping the second last fence.</p> <p><b>FAIR SCRIPT</b> (S Karnicnik) put in a poor jump at the final fence.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>WARREN STORM LIFEBROKERS WAIKATO STEEPLECHASE</b>
<p><b>SINISTA</b> (R Cole) was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p><b>ROSETOWN JOE</b> (C Perrett) jumped the fifth fence awkwardly.</p> <p><b>GOOSEBUMPS</b> (G Walsh) fell at the sixth fence hampering <b>CARINYA</b> (C Studd). Both horse and rider were uninjured.</p> <p><b>RACQUETOR</b> (S Karnicnik) badly misjudged the fence near the 1300 metres and blundered badly on landing severely hampering <b>JACK ROMANOV</b> (M Mitchell). <b>SINISTA</b> also put in a poor jump at that fence.</p> <p><b>ROSETOWN JOE</b> and <b>JACK ROMANOV</b> both put in poor jumps at the fence near the 1100 metres with <b>ROSETOWN JOE</b> then giving ground quickly.</p> <p><b>TIM</b> (T Harris) and <b>ROSETOWN JOE</b> were both retired from the race prior to the second last fence when well beaten.</p> <p><b>RACQUETOR</b> put in a poor jump at the second last fence.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>FAIRVIEW MOTORS 2100</b>
<p><b>MALBEC</b> (A Collett) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>TAAXMAN</b> (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p><b>TAAXMAN</b> raced ungenerously when being restrained after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>MAGNA CARTA</b> (V Colgan) in the early stages.</p> <p><b>EL SOLDADO</b> (U Holmquist) commenced to over-race when being restrained near the 1800 metres.</p> <p><b>MAGNA CARTA</b> had to be steadied to avoid the heels of <b>LION RED</b> (S Collett) near the 1700 metres with <b>EL SOLDADO</b> which was continuing to over-race then improving into restricted room to the inside of <b>MAGNA CARTA</b> despite the efforts of its rider, having to be firmly restrained for a distance. <b>EL SOLDADO</b> continued to over-race through the middle stages.</p> <p>T Thornton was unable to offer any excuses for the poor performance of <b>SECONDS OUT</b>.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>MAGNA CARTA</b> rider V Colgan advised that after over-racing early the gelding had then been caught flat-footed when the pace increased near the 600 metres where it had been unable to quicken.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>MICO PLUMBING 1400</b>
<p><b>SPIN DOCTOR</b> (A Schwerin) and <b>NEEDLLY</b> (A Collett) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SPIN DOCTOR</b> was inclined to lay out in the final straight when placed under pressure.</p> <p>The track was upgraded to Slow(9) effective race 7.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>PRINT HOUSE 1200</b>
<p><b>THIAGO</b> (D Hain) was slow to begin before being further hampered when runners to either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>OCEAN EMPEROR</b> (C Grylls) over-raced when being restrained shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>DENNIS DENUTO</b> (S Spratt) over-raced through the middle stages.</p> <p><b>OCEAN EMPEROR</b> had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p> <p><b>NIKI PIKI MILO</b> (A Jones) lay out under pressure near the 100 metres having to be straightened.</p> <p><b>DIVISSIMA</b> (A Collett) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of <b>HARBOUR STAR</b> (O Bosson) over the final 75 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>NEW WORLD TE RAPA 1400</b>
<p>After becoming fractious <b>ZERO TUA HUNDRED</b> (P Holmes) was removed from its barrier stall and examined by the veterinarian before being declared a late scratching at 3.08 pm as it had suffered an abrasion to the right foreleg.</p> <p><b>SANTIAGO</b> (L Innes) jumped away awkwardly.</p>	

**BINGO** (D Johnson) was slow to begin before being further hampered when **INCREDITABLE HULK** (V Colgan) lay out crowding **BINGO** on to **SANTIAGO** and **ROYAL SCEPTRE** (U Holmquist) which was forced on to the hind quarters of **HIGH SOCIETY** (V Gatu) with **ROYAL SCEPTRE** having to be steadied losing ground.

**GERRY MERITO** (G Cooksley) over-raced in the lead through the early and middle stages.

**INCREDITABLE HULK** made contact with **SKY IDEA** (M Chui) entering the final straight near the 400 metres with **SKY IDEA** then shifting away from that runner dictating **OHOPE PRINCE** (B R Jones) outwards into the line of **LUCKY COUNTRY** (S Collett) which had to steady.

**ROYAL SCEPTRE** was held up near the 200 metres having to be steadied to shift outwards across the heels of **HIGH SOCIETY**.

**HIGH SOCIETY** lost the right front plate during the running.

**Race 10**

**LODGE REAL ESTATE 1600**

**SHEEZ ALL HEART** (V Gatu), **LIGHT UP A SCREEN** (S Collett) and **SONIC ROCKET** (A Collett) were slow away.

**SHEEZ ALL HEART** over-raced in the lead in the early to middle stages.

**GOODN'TARG** (T Thornton) shifted outwards entering the final straight near the 400 metres dictating **LIGHT UP A SCREEN** outwards onto **COOL ONE** (A Schwerin).

**SONIC ROCKET** shifted away from **ADRIATIC PEARL** (B R Jones) near the 200 metres forcing **SHEEZ ALL HEART** across the heels of **HOLLYWOOD LAD** (D Johnson) before being straightened by its rider. A Collett was advised to exercise care.

**Race 11**

**WENTWOOD GRANGE 1600**

**BUDWISER** (V Gatu) was removed from the barriers after becoming fractious being declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 4.23 pm as it was bleeding from the left nostril.

**CANTINA** (D Johnson) and **HIGH TAIL IT** (A Jones) were slow away.

**GALAKTIKA** (O Bosson) began awkwardly hampering **READY EDDIE** (S Collett).

**CANTINA** was held up near the 350 metres.

B R Jones (**PIONEER**) was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 200 metres.
