Race 1	MANGOIHE LOGGING / APB ELECTRICAL 2YO
<p>The start was delayed 2 minutes due to some runners being slow to load.</p> <p>Trainer G Vile was advised that a warning would be placed on LIANA for barrier manners after the filly proved difficult to load.</p> <p>FIVE TO MIDNIGHT (K Myers) began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>STROLLING VAGABOND (D Mo) began very awkwardly and shifted in abruptly. STROLLING VAGABOND then raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>ALARMIST (J Parkes) lay out under pressure over the final 400 metres having to be straightened.</p>	
Race 2	SB CONTRACTORS / TAYLOR AGRICULTURE 3YO
<p>GOOD MAMA (R Hannam) shifted out on jumping bumping with SLIMLINE (R Myers).</p> <p>BUSHFIRE (L Hemi) jumped out abruptly at the start bumping heavily with LEEDS (J Riddell) which lost ground.</p> <p>A TAD LEICA (R Goldsbury) lay in across the heels of LEEDS near the 700 metres and had to be steadied.</p> <p>DARCI MAC (D Mo) lay out under pressure throughout the final straight and passing the 150 metres shifted out abruptly and had to be straightened resulting in apprentice D Mo being unable to fully test DARCI MAC.</p>

<p>Trainer R Bergerson was given permission to remove the blinkers of LET ME THINK due to the track conditions.</p> <p>KENNY'S CHANCE (R Harris) began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>KENNY'S CHANCE shifted ground under pressure in the home straight and was then briefly inconvenienced near the 200 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of VIBRANT MOSS (K Myers).</p> <p>D Bradley reported that PHILIPA CHARLOTTE which finished a distant last, failed to handle the heavy track.</p>	
Race 7	TRC TOYOTA HANDICAP
<p>H TINSLEY was fined \$100 when he was unable to make the weight for ARIZONA JAZZ. He was replaced by R Hannam.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of TALLYHO TWINKLETOES, rider K Myers reported the gelding had failed to handle the very heavy track.</p>	
Race 8	JAMES BULL MEMORIAL GOLD CUP - Listed
<p>TAURUS (J Oliver) and BONNY HEIGHTS (D Bradley) came together and bumped heavily when the start was made with TAURUS settling back.</p> <p>DANZA LAD (K Smith) raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>TAURUS was held up for a short distance rounding the home turn and was then tightened and had to change ground near the 200 metres after ST RANSOM (R Hannam) shifted out under pressure dictating BONNY HEIGHTS out into the line of TAURUS.</p> <p>J Parkes reported that THORN PRINCE was never comfortable in the heavy going.</p>	
Race 9	TOD SEEDS / TURF STAR HANDICAP
