Race 8 – Tui – Backing a Winner Since 1889 Handicap

Apprentice jockey **N Teeluck** (ADRIENNE) admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b) at a deferred hearing in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 200 metres. **N Teeluck** had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 16 May up to and including 28 May (4 days). This suspension will commence after his current term of suspension expires.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	KAY ZED RACING HANDICAP (1400 metres)
D Mo (THE GRADUATE) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b) with regard to the use of his whip prior to the 200 metres. BRAD THORN lay out under pressure near the post and bumped with NIPPIN . When questioned in the run of IF I CAN I CAN rider R Hannam said the mare would prefer any easing in the going.	
Race 2	HOROWHENUA SHELTER TRIMMERS MAIDEN (1200 metres)
DR WATSON was crowded on jumping between POP HIT and HANDYMAN and as a result got back. ALARINDA shifted out and away from SHEZAKIWI on jumping, this resulting in LINCOLN PARK being tightened and losing ground. O'CEIRINS WHISPER began awkwardly and was slow away. SHEZAKIWI and LYRIC'S WAY were held up and unable to improve for some distance prior to the 400 metres. J Parkes the rider of O'CEIRINS WHISPER was shown footage of his ride and reminded of his obligations when shifting ground when attempting a run prior to the 400 metres, bumping and forcing DR WATSON over extra ground. POP HIT raced in restricted room throughout the home straight.	

Apprentice jockeys M Dravitzki (MEZZALUNA) and S McKay (SHEZAKIWI) were shown footage of their respective rides and reminded to their obligations with regard to their whip use on runners out of contention.	
Race 3	HOWIE AND LORRAINE MATHEWS RACING STABLES HANDICAP (1200 metres)
<p>HOT SPOT bounded on jumping and got back.</p> <p>FLOSCEE'S GOLD began awkwardly.</p> <p>JUSTLIKEYASISTER was slow to jump and then further hampered when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>BALLYBAY over-raced in the lead throughout.</p> <p>THE QUIET MAN was held up in the early part of the final straight and again near the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 4	KEN THOMSON MEMORIAL (1600 metres)
<p>GRACE WITH POWER shifted in abruptly at the start hampering RASA LILA and JUST GOT HOME, with JUST GOT HOME losing ground.</p> <p>GRACE WITH POWER raced three wide without cover early and then was forced four wide rounding the turn when RASA LILA improved to its inside.</p>	
Race 5	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600 metres)
<p>WAIPATIKI GIRL began awkwardly, shifted out and bumped TIDDLY.</p> <p>THE DUKE'S SECRET was slow to begin and shortly after was crowded when between SHE'S POPPY and LADY JESSICA.</p> <p>THELIONZSHADOW was slow in the early stages.</p> <p>SOPHIE over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>SHE KNOWS raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>AVATRIX was held up for a short distance prior to entering the home straight.</p> <p>K Chiong (LADY JESSICA) was reminded of her obligations regarding the use of her whip on a runner out of contention.</p>	
Race 6	MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS HANDICAP (2100 metres)
<p>SUPERTURF lay out making the first turn.</p> <p>DOUBLE O SEVEN improved wide from the 1200 metres.</p> <p>SPRING CHEER had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the final turn and near the 200 metres was crowded out onto the heels of FREDERICK WILLIAM by GREY POWER which lay out under pressure, with SPRING CHEER only obtaining clear running over the final 100 metres.</p>	
Race 7	CREATIVE CATERING HANDICAP (1200 metres)
<p>THE LONE RANGER and KUZANOV both bounded on jumping with THE LONE RANGER making heavy contact with MCLAREN. KUZANOV then shifted in and became awkwardly placed and contacted the heels of MCLAREN, becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>COASTAL EXPRESS was slow to begin.</p> <p>THE LONE RANGER over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>JOEY JONZ had to be steadied going into the first turn and then raced keenly for some distance.</p> <p>DAIELLO raced keenly when three wide without cover in the middle stages.</p> <p>GOOD ONE GLADDY was held up rounding the turn and in the early part of the final straight.</p> <p>SHE'S SLINKY and JOEY JONZ were both held up for a brief distance rounding the turn.</p> <p>COASTAL EXPRESS was held up for a short distance near the 400 metres and then had to be angled inwards to improve.</p> <p>DAIELLO lay in under pressure in the final straight and near the 200 metres shifted in and bumped with JOEY JONZ.</p>	
Race 8	RACHAEL FROST RACING HANDICAP (1600 metres)
<p>SAVARHYS reared and dislodged rider C Lammas in the stalls immediately prior to the start being effected. Stewards filed a request for a ruling under Rule 632 inquiring as to whether the gelding did receive a fair start. After hearing evidence from rider C Lammas, starter G Phillips and viewing coverage of the incident, SAVARHYS was declared a runner by the JCA. Rider C Lammas was uninjured. Connections were advised that SAVARHYS must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to its next start.</p> <p>KAIRANGA LAD jumped out abruptly at the start hampering WEBBY, DON'TSTOPGIRL, JUST A CHARLIE and SHEZENTHUSIASTIC.</p> <p>SHANKLY began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>PARTY GIRL shifted out on jumping away tightening JED CLAMPETT.</p> <p>SHANKLY and READY EDDIE raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p>JED CLAMPETT was held up passing the 500 metres until near the 250 metres.</p> <p>JUMANAH and KAIRANGA LAD were held up rounding the turn and the early part of the final straight.</p>	

JUST A CHARLIE shifted in and away from the riderless **SAVARHYS** and in doing so halted the momentum of **KAIRANGA LAD** which was improving to the inside **KAIRANGA LAD** which then had to shift across heels to continue to improve. **JED CLAMPETT** raced in restricted room when inclined to lay inwards under pressure over the final 150 metres and made contact with **SOUTHERN SECRET**.
