RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HIREMASTER MAIDEN			
PERSERVERE (L Allpress) began awkwardly and settled back.				
DAN CUGAT and BEN'S LEGACY both over-raced in the early stages when being steadied into trailing positions.				
ELUSIVE BEN (L Hemi) hung outwards when racing onto the course proper and lost contact with the remainder of the field				
finishing a distant last. Trainer A Bidlake was advised that a warning would be placed on the horse's racing manners.				
When questioned regarding the run of FAALTLINE, H Tinsley said he was of the opinion the gelding, having its first start				
since September, would benefit from the run.				
Race 2	MILLS REEF WINERY 2YO			
ALWAYS READY (M Dravitzki) began a little awkwardly and settled back.				
THE AXE (S Doyle) hung outwards in the home straight.				
Race 3	GAZLEY HANDICAP			
FLOSCEES GOLD (K Myers) and HENI (R Myers) were both away awkwardly.				
HENI then commenced to race keenly in the early and middle stages.				
PASS IT ON (N Teeluck) shifted out a significant distance in the home straight under hard riding dictating SILVER BUBBLES				
(L Chiong) and HENI over considerable extra ground.				

Prior to the authorisation of dividends the connections of the 4th placed **SILVER BUBBLES** lodged a protest against the 2nd placed **PASS IT ON** alleging interference inside the final 100 metres. The JCA, after hearing all evidence dismissed the protest and placings stood.

N Teeluck subsequently admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 368 (1) (d) and had his jockey's licence suspended from the close of racing on 1 May 2015 until the close of racing on 16 May 2015 (4 days).

When questioned regarding the run of **PLATINUM LINCOLN**, **D Bradley** was of the opinion that the gelding was feeling its joints. Connections advised they would assess the geldings future. **M McNellis** advised Stewards he was feeling the effects of the flu suffered during the week so was stood down for his remaining rides.

Race 4 JOHN TURKINGTON FORESTRY HANDICAP

ROCK BAND (K Smith) began awkwardly and got back.

THE BEAUT (K Chiong) raced wide without cover for the majority

Prior to the declaration of dividends the Stewards requested a ruling as to whether **PICCADILLY (K Myers)** received a fair start after being very slow away. After viewing the evidence the JCA declared the horse did receive a fair start and was therefore confirmed a runner.

When questioned into the run of **BEAU AGEN**, **R Goldsbury** advised that the gelding felt lethargic throughout. Trainer **C Eagle** advised the gelding may now be freshened prior to next racing.

Race 5 TRENTHAM ARMY CAMP TRIBUTE 3YO

BUSHFIRE (L Hemi) jumped outwards abruptly at the start hampering **FIGURACE (H Tinsley)** which settled back as a result. **OCEAN EMPEROR (K Myers)** over-raced in the lead throughout.

POROTENE DIVA had to be steadied when racing adjacent to the outside fence at approximately the 200 metre mark after racing up onto the heels of **OUTSPOKEN (K Chiong) which shifted out.**

BUSHFIRE had to be angled out when racing in restricted room near the 250 metres and then tended to lug out over the final 200 metres.

A post-race veterinary examination of **OCEAN EMPEROR** which failed to finish the race off as expected, did not reveal any abnormalities. Rider **K Myers** advised the gelding over-raced when in the lead and had failed to settle, having little left when asked to produce in the home straight.

Race 6

WELLINGTON MOUNTED RIFLES REMEMBRANCE MAIDEN

KEEN TEMPO (R Goldsbury) bounded at the start but recovered quickly to lead.

MASTER JACK (L Allpress) hung out shortly after the start hampering NITRO TED (B Lammas) which settled back. MASTER JACK and REGAL STEPS (K Myers) raced keenly in the early stages.

AWESOME PRINCESS (K Smith) was tightened shortly before straightening when attempting a marginal run between PAMPAS PRINCESS (H Tinsley) racing to its inside and YOU'LL DO ME (D Mo) to its outside. As a result AWESOME PRINCESS had to steady and change ground to the inside to find clear room.

Race 7 ZEPHYR CONSULTING HANDICAP

SOU'EAST (L Hemi) was slow to begin. (3 lengths)

WRITTEN COMMAND (R Hannam) raced three-wide without cover throughout.

R Hannam was reminded of his obligations with regard to his whip use prior to the 200 metres.

Race 8 TUI-BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889

LET'S (R Goldsbury) and ATHENRY (D Mo) were both slow away.

OUTOFTIME (K Chiong) raced wide without cover throughout.

A charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 200 metres under Rule 638 (3) (b) was laid against apprentice **N Teeluck** (**ADRIENNE**) and adjourned to a time to be confirmed to allow rider **Teeluck** to confer with his employer, trainer **K Zimmerman**.
