RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	H&T AGRONOMICS / AGRICOM HURDLE
<p>ZA BRUTE (K Peterson) was slow to begin and was then inclined to race keenly in the early stages. Rider K Peterson lost the use of his left stirrup iron for a short distance after jumping the first fence.</p> <p>ZA BRUTE was retired from the event near the 400 metres when well back and out of contention. A post-race veterinary examination of ZA BRUTE failed to reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>MY MAGICIAN (M Cropp) jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p>PROLOGUE (A Kuru) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>HEMINGWAY (M Gillies) put in a poor jump at the 900 metres.</p> <p>PROLOGUE put in an awkward jump at the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p>MY MAGICIAN was retired from the event after jumping the fence near the 300 metres when well out of contention. M Cropp said the gelding blew quite hard after the race and was of the opinion MY MAGICIAN would benefit from the run. A post-race veterinary inspection of MY MAGICIAN failed to reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
Race 2	CR GRACE STEEPLECHASE
<p>DUMINY had to be re-saddled prior to the commencement of the open start when the pad beneath the saddle shifted during its preliminary. The saddle on DUMINY slipped forward on jumping the first fence and the gelding was pulled up and took no further part. Rider A Kuru was questioned and he advised that he was satisfied with the re-saddling prior to the commencement and added that he had ridden DUMINY in the same gear at its previous start without incident.</p> <p>THE FOX (D Miller) and MCCULLEY (S Fannin) came together on jumping the first fence.</p>	

<p>THE FOX ran wide and jumped the crossing heading into the back straight on the first occasion and lost approx. 2 lengths.</p> <p>THE FOX raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>IN FOR FUN (K Peterson) unbalanced the rider at the first fence in the home straight on the final round.</p> <p>WILBUR (M Gillies) and RACQUETOR (M Cropp) bumped heavily at the fence near the 1600 metres on the final round.</p> <p>RACQUETOR and IN FOR FUN jumped slowly at the rear throughout.</p> <p>IN FOR FUN was retired from the event prior to the fence at the 1100 metres after jumping indifferently at several fences.</p> <p>RACQUETOR (M Cropp) after jumping indifferently at several fences, was retired from the event after jumping the fence near the 900 metres when out of contention. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.</p> <p>WILBUR was inclined to run down its fences throughout losing ground and was retired passing the 600metres when well back and out of contention. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>AND THATZ SCOTTY (M McNelis) was retired from the event when well back and out of contention near the 400 metres.</p> <p>CARINYA and YORKIE bumped after jumping the last when YORKIE shifted ground under pressure.</p>	
WATER FORCE / PLASMA BIOTECH MAIDEN	
<p>FERNLIN (N Teeluck) began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>THE DUKE'S SECRET (M Dee) shifted in shortly after the start and bumped with SILVER NANCHO (J Parkes).</p> <p>STARBOX (S Collett) raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SILVER NANCHO over-raced in the early stages and going into the bend near the 900 metres had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of FLOSCEE'S GOLD (V Colgan).</p> <p>J Riddell reported that TROJAN raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>IT'S YOUR CALL (C Johnson) was held up rounding the final bend and only obtained clear running near the 200 metres.</p> <p>DAYTIME ROBBERY (A Jones) shifted out near the 200 metres resulting in SILVER NANCHO having to shift ground outwards to improve. A Jones was shown footage of her ride and advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.</p> <p>OUTSPOKEN (R Myers) raced in restricted room near the finish.</p>	
Race 4	NUFARM MAIDEN
<p>MWAADAN and DAL FINIAN (B Lammas) were slow to begin.</p> <p>OLLIE RED (A Donald) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LAST TRUMP (K Smith) raced keenly in the run down the back straight.</p> <p>SASHAY (D Bradley) over-reacted when being steadied near the 900 metres.</p> <p>SASHAY was held up for a run approaching the 200 metres and had to shift in across the heels of PACIFIC BELLE (N Teeluck) to obtain clear running.</p> <p>SIR CARLOS (C Johnson) raced keenly at the rear of the field in the early and middle stages. C Johnson was questioned regarding his ride of SIR CARLOS which was noticeably restrained shortly after the start. C Johnson advised that his instructions were to ride the gelding off the pace on this occasion as it had failed to perform when ridden handy at its previous two starts. C Johnson said SIR CARLOS over-raced throughout and had little left at the finish.</p> <p>The rider of OLLIE RED (A Donald) was shown footage of his ride and reminded of his obligations with regard to his use of the whip on a horse out of contention.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the improved performance of the winner JANDAKOT, trainer S Hamill advised the track conditions at the gelding's previous start at Taupo were too testing over 1800 metres on that occasion and was suited to the improved going today.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of ZED LEPPÉLIN, R Hannam said the gelding lacked early pace and although running on fairly over the final stages, was disappointing. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
Race 5	JOHN TURKINGTON FORESTRY HANDICAP
<p>On and off course patrons were advised that ACUTELY GOLD was in season.</p> <p>DELICIANO (S Collett) shifted out abruptly on jumping making heavy contact with JOSEPHINE (C O'Beirne) which was in turn forced out into the line of LADY PLATINUM (M Dee)</p> <p>GO THUNDER (J Parkes) was slow away.</p> <p>JUST ISHI (J Gracioso) had to be steadied when attempting a narrow gap to the inside of SADLERS ROCK (V Colgan) near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>JOSEPHINE(C O'Beirne) shifted out under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>Rider's R Myers (NGARIO) and J Parkes (GO THUNDER) reported that their respective mounts were unsuited to the firmer track conditions today.</p>	
Race 6	FARMERS TRANSPORT HANDICAP
<p>JUST CHARLIE (R Myers) was crowded leaving the barriers between THE PAINTER (N Teeluck) and ZCASTLE (K Smith) which shifted in.</p> <p>BEEBEE STAR (B Lammas) was slow to begin.</p> <p>THE PAINTER over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>DAL VUITTON (C Johnson) raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	

<p>ELATED (C O'Beirne) was held up for the majority of the home straight and only obtained clear running over the final 50 metres.</p> <p>ADIDAZLER (M Dee) had to steady when attempting a narrow gap passing the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 7	PILET CONTRACTING / PIONEER SEEDS HANDICAP
<p>JUMP FOR JOY (B Lammas) and DON'T BLAME BUSTER (H Tinsley) were crowded shortly after the start by SLICE OF CLASS (R Myers) which shifted out and RIVERMAN JACK (V Johnston) which jumped away awkwardly then shifted in.</p> <p>JACKSON STREET (R Hannam) was slow away.</p> <p>PONEKE (V Colgan) raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>The saddle on MIBACHELORBOY shifted forward near the 800 metres placing rider N Teeluck at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>Near the 300 metres, PERRY MASON (M Dee) when leading, ducked out abruptly forcing HANDLE ME WITH CARE (J Parkes) outward onto MIBACHELORBOY which was hampered. Also affected were SINGLE MISSION (K Smith), RIVERMAN JACK, PAITENCE (C Johnson) and JACKSON STREET all of which were forced over some extra ground.</p> <p>BAZINGER (M Dravitzki) shifted out under pressure near the 100 metres, hampering HANDLE ME WITH CARE. M Dravitzki advised stewards that her mount had shifted out more abruptly than she anticipated however she was reminded of her obligations to other runners when shifting ground.</p>	
Race 8	MARSH INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP
<p>PETITE BRIGITTE (V Colgan) was away awkwardly.</p> <p>VINCENT STREET (A Taylor) shifted in leaving the barriers crowding PLATINUM LINCOLN (D Bradley).</p> <p>ALL'S FAIR (J Parkes) raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>DR PAUL and LIBERATING (A Jones) made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly with LIBERATING having to steady further to avoid the heels of ALL'S FAIR.</p> <p>PLATINUM LINCOLN was held up throughout the final straight and went to the line not fully tested.</p> <p>DR PAUL (C O'Beirne) was held up in the final straight until near the 100 metres.</p> <p>CENTRE ATTENTION (H Tinsley) was unable to find clear racing room in the home straight until near the 150 metre mark. Prior to the authorisation of dividends, connections of the 2nd placed VINCENT STREET viewed coverage of the finish after there was some contact between VINCENT STREET and the winner MIGHTY SOLOMAN close to the post but elected not to proceed with an objection.</p>	
Race 9	MERIAL ANCARE METRIC MILE – GROUP III
<p>H Tinsley was replaced on JULINSKY PRINCE after he failed to make the carded weight. After deliberations the JCA imposed a \$250 penalty under Rule 330 (3) (c). As race conditions specified no apprentice allowances, connections opted to engage stable apprentice V Ravikumar as the replacement rider of JULINSKY PRINCE.</p> <p>ANNIESSTAR (R Hannam) was slow away and then further hampered when MISS SELBY was dictated inwards by PUCCINI (V Colgan).</p> <p>NORTH AND SOUTH C Johnson) began awkwardly.</p> <p>IAMISHWARA (A Taylor) raced four-wide throughout.</p> <p>WEISSMULLER (V Johnston) and DANZA LAD (D Hain) over-raced in the back straight</p> <p>In the run down the back straight JULINSKY PRINCE appeared to shy and shifted out momentarily hampering PUCCINI and PERCY (N Teeluck).</p> <p>PERCY raced three-wide throughout.</p> <p>SANGSTER (J Riddell) was crowded when attempting a run near the 200 metres and had to shift ground inward in order to improve.</p> <p>ANNIESSTAR (R Hannam) was held up near the 250 metres, having to angle out across the heels of DUBAI BELLE (D Bradley) in order to improve.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of MISS SELBY, S Doyle said the mare travelled comfortably throughout but when placed under pressure in the final straight failed to respond as expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare pulled up in normal post-race condition. Trainer J Bary advised he would monitor the progress of MISS SELBY and report to the stewards.</p>	
Race 10	WRIGHT LIVESTOCK / MANAWATU TOYOTA HANDICAP
<p>THE BACHELOR (J Shackleton) blundered when awkwardly away then raced three-wide without cover throughout</p> <p>VICKI ANNE (V Johnston) was slow away.</p> <p>WOW WHATA PRINCESS (V Ravikumar) was briefly held up passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>WIGGLE (J Riddell) was held up in the early part of the final straight until gaining clear running near the 250 metres.</p> <p>STELLA BELLA (R Hannam) was held up for some distance in the final straight only gaining clear running inside the final 150 metres.</p> <p>SAINT KITT (J Parkes) was held up in the final straight until near the 100 metres.</p> <p>N Teeluck (FLEMINGTON) and V Johnston (VICKI ANNE) were both issued with warnings with regard to the use of the whip on a horse out of contention.</p>
