## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>FARMLANDS CO OPERATIVE HURDLE</b>
<p>R Cole was unable to claim down to his declared riding weight of 65 kgs riding <b>SUGGEST GOLD</b> 0.5 kgs over-weight at 66.5 kgs. R Cole was fined \$250 by the Judicial Committee.</p> <p><b>SHOW THE BEEL</b> (M Mitchell) and <b>SUGGEST GOLD</b> (R Cole) were slow away.</p> <p><b>MANOEUVRE</b> (N Quinn) jumped slowly at the rear throughout.</p> <p><b>SHOW THE BEEL</b> hit the fence near the 1700 metres and fell. Rider M Mitchell was uninjured. <b>SHOW THE BEEL</b> was attended to by the course veterinary staff and x-rayed revealing a fracture to the left shoulder.</p> <p><b>SUGGEST GOLD</b> jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p><b>SECRET WHISPER</b> (D Miller) misjudged the fence near the 1100 metres. <b>ROOF OF RECKONING</b> (M Cropp) also put in an indifferent jump at that fence.</p> <p><b>SECRET WHISPER</b> again put in a poor jump at the fence near the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>SUGGEST GOLD</b> and <b>MANOEUVRE</b> were both retired from the race prior to the second last fence when well beaten.</p> <p><b>OUR ALCHEMIST</b> (M Gillies) landed awkwardly and blundered after jumping the second last fence losing considerable momentum.</p> <p><b>IRISHWISE</b> (S Fannin) hit the second last fence.</p> <p><b>WEST END</b> (S Phelan), <b>OUR ALCHEMIST</b> and <b>SECRET WHISPER</b> all put in poor jumps at the last fence.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>TEAM WEALLEANS HURDLE</b>
<p><b>SUPERTURF</b> (C Studd) and <b>MANGAROA HUSTLER</b> (N Quinn) were both slow away.</p> <p><b>RUSSIANOV</b> (M McNelis) put in a poor jump at the first fence and continued to jump indifferently at the rear throughout before being retired from the race prior to the second last fence when well beaten.</p> <p><b>CRIKEY CRON</b> (M Gillies) jumped the first three fences indifferently. <b>CRIKEY CRON</b> put in a poor jump at the fence near the</p>	

<p>1100 metres and again at the second last fence. Rider M Gillies was unable to offer any excuses for the gelding's disappointing performance other than not feeling entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.</p> <p><b>MR KANTON</b> (E Farr) and <b>BRAVE BUCCANEER</b> (M Mitchell) both ran down the two fences in the home straight on the first occasion.</p> <p><b>BALLROOM</b> (M Cropp) had to be restrained to avoid the heels of <b>BRAVE BUCCANEER</b> passing the 1600 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>SWEENEY TOWNSEND &amp; ASSOCIATES – ROTORUA &amp; BAY OF PLENTY HUNT CUP</b>
<p><b>KICK BACK</b> (S Fannin) was slow away.</p> <p><b>I'M ISAAC</b> (D Miller) hit the fence near the 1000 metres on the second occasion.</p> <p><b>BILLY ELLIOT</b> (M Gillies) hit the fence near the 1700 metres.</p> <p><b>SUPERCHARGED</b> (R Cole) gave ground quickly after jumping the fence near the 1100 metres, and after dropping out to a distant last was retired from the race prior to the second last fence. Rider R Cole advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.</p> <p><b>KICK BACK</b> misjudged the last fence.</p> <p>M Gillies advised that his mount <b>BILLY ELLIOT</b> had felt a little indifferent in its action on pulling up. Post-race veterinary examinations of both <b>BILLY ELLIOT</b> and <b>SUPERCHARGED</b> did not reveal any abnormalities</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>AONGATETE COOLSTORES LTD 1950</b>
<p><b>RIVER FORCE</b> (J Wong) began awkwardly making contact with <b>ZEDACE</b> (M Sweeney) and then stumbled.</p> <p><b>BIDING TIME</b> (R Hutchings) shifted outwards jumping away forcing <b>HIGH DISDAIN</b> (L Satherley) out on to the hind quarters of <b>THE TALISMAN</b> (R Norvall) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>ZEDACE</b> over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>THE TALISMAN</b> over-raced when being restrained going into the first turn near the 1500 metres.</p> <p><b>IT'S A WONDER</b> (K Myers) raced wide without cover around the first bend.</p> <p>R Norvall (<b>THE TALISMAN</b>) was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>T W MOORE LTD HIGHWEIGHT 2200</b>
<p><b>HAVE NO MERCY</b> (M Cropp) shifted outwards on jumping away crowding <b>RED RUBY</b> (R Hutchings) which lost ground.</p> <p><b>PRESTIGIOSA</b> (M Gillies), <b>BAHHTON</b> (S Phelan) and <b>HOUNDSCRY</b> (S Fannin) were all slow away.</p> <p>Rider R Cole (<b>HE'S DAN</b>) advised that the gelding had found today's conditions too testing under its big weight. Trainer Glynn Brick advised that it was now his intention to spell <b>HE'S DAN</b>.</p> <p><b>HAVE NO MERCY</b> gave ground quickly passing the 600 metres and was not persevered with from the 400 metres. Rider M Cropp advised that the gelding had hung throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery rate.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>BURTON CONSTRUCTION LTD – FLAIR AMATEUR SERIES 1950</b>
<p><b>MAILLY</b> (S MacNab) clipped a heel and blundered shortly after jumping away between <b>JESSHANIMO</b> (N Jamieson) and <b>NGATIRA GOLD</b> (H Cushing) losing ground as a result.</p> <p>M Roustoby admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted his mount <b>ARAKI</b> to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear forcing <b>NGATIRA GOLD</b> (H Cushing) inwards resulting in <b>PREFONTAINE</b> (L Kennedy) being checked near the 1700 metres. Also having to then be steadied to avoid the heels of <b>NGATIRA GOLD</b> was <b>REEPERBAHN</b> (C Myers). After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended M Roustoby from the conclusion of racing today, Sunday 14 September, until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 28 September, one riding day.</p> <p><b>RICH TED</b> (J Reid) improved on to the heels of <b>PREFONTAINE</b> near the 1100 metres, striking a heel and blundering hampering <b>JESSHANIMO</b>.</p> <p>R Simpson (<b>ISDABICKY</b>) was reprimanded after making a celebratory gesture just prior to the winning post.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the poor performance of <b>REEPERBAHN</b> C Myers was of the opinion that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer Mr K Myers advised that it was now his intention to spell <b>REEPERBAHN</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>BALLANCE AGRI – NUTRIENTS 1200</b>
<p>Trainer N Mortimer was fined \$50 after presenting <b>SODALICIOUS</b> to race without notified gear being blinkers.</p> <p><b>SECRET PLAN</b> (M Wenn) was slow away.</p> <p><b>SODALICIOUS</b> (S McKay) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SODALICIOUS</b> over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>SODALICIOUS</b> was struck over the head by the whip of L Satherley (<b>LADY HUNTINGDON</b>) near the 300 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>PEARCE FLOORING LTD 1200</b>
<p><b>WHATWEDO</b> (S McKay) was slow away.</p> <p><b>WHATWEDO</b> raced keenly in the middle stages when being restrained.</p>
