### RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 Rotary 2400

**STAGEHAND** (L Magorrian), **SAVED BY THE BELL** (D Johnson) and **REKA** (L Satherley) all began awkwardly losing ground. Passing the 2300 metres **SAVED BY THE BELL** commenced to race ungenerously having to be steadied off the heels of **TE KINGI** (V Colgan) when that runner was taken in by **KENDOKA** (M Cameron). **SAVED BY THE BELL** continued to race ungenerously for the majority of the race.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **STAGEHAND** apprentice L Magorrian advised that the gelding had travelled comfortably until placed under pressure where it had been unable to quicken and had felt flat. A post race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

### Race 2 The Estate Church Bay 1200

AIRMAN (C Dell) began awkwardly.

**THE FIRE INSIDE** (M Sweeney) had to be steadied when crowded for room near the 1000 metres by **GET OUT OF IT** (S Spratt) which lay in away from **HANNAH MARY** (L Magorrian) which was shifting in. With video footage proving inconclusive apprentice L Magorrian was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

HADDON HALL (M Cameron) lay out rounding the final turn.

**TIGER MOSS** (J Wong) was held up near the 400 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

**FRANK WHITAKER** (O Bosson) lay out under pressure approaching the 200 metres resulting in **AIRMAN** (C Dell) having to steady when taken out on to the heels of **HADDON HALL** which shifted in slightly. O Bosson was advised to exercise more care.

Race 3 Ventell Limited 1200

AIRFIELD ROAD (C Dell) shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barriers hampering MIGHTY MATT (M Du Plessis), PAN DULCE (R Smyth) and QUEENS ROSE (N Harris) with MIGHTY MATT losing considerable ground.

GUEVARA (L Magorrian) began awkwardly before being further hampered.

AIRFIELD ROAD ducked outwards away from the running rail near the 1100 metres inconveniencing PAN DULCE. GUEVARA raced three wide without cover.

MAGIC BELLE (J Oliver) hung outwards throughout the race.

PAN DULCE was held up near the 300 metres.

Race 4 Ray White NZ Mitchelson Cup

**INTRANSIGENT** (J Wong) was slow to begin.

**CORNELIUS** (K Leung) raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1900 metres.

**CORNELIUS** lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 5 Ray White City Realty 2100

MISS CITRON (R Hutchings) and ON PAROLE (J Oliver) began awkwardly losing ground.

KEEP ROCKING (K Leung) shifted outwards leaving the barriers crowding KALINDA.

Passing the 1850 metres **KEEP ROCKING** had to be steadied off the heels of **VICEROY** (O Bosson) which lay in when being steadied after improving to become awkwardly placed inside the heels of **SAME AS** (C Grylls).

ALL ZEDIN DONE (J Wong) raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1800 metres placing MISS CITRON in restricted room.

Near the 1700 metres **MISS CITRON** shifted outwards to avoid the heels of **TOP CHOICE** (M Du Plessis) which was being restrained when racing keenly resulting in **ALL ZEDIN DONE** being inconvenienced.

**VICEROY** raced wide without cover around the first bend until improving forward to lead near the 1500 metres.

**TOP CHOICE** over-raced in the middle stages shifting away from the running rail to avoid the heels of **HENRY TUDOR** (D Johnson) near the 1400 metres forcing **JOCHEN RINDT** (M Wenn) three wide for a short distance.

**KALINDA** had to be firmly restrained after improving to become awkwardly placed inside the heels of **ON PAROLE** near the 1200 metres.

**JOCHEN RINDT** was steadied when racing in restricted room approaching the 800 metres after **MISS CITRON** shifted outwards to avoid the heels of **HENRY TUDOR**.

**SAME AS** lay out rounding the final turn having to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **TOP CHOICE** near the 500 metres.

**TOP CHOICE** lay out under pressure in the straight.

ALL ZEDIN DONE lay out under pressure inconveniencing MISS CITRON near the 75 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **HENRY TUDOR** rider D Johnson was unable to offer any excuses other than in her opinion the gelding possibly feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer Ms P Ranui confirmed that **HENRY TUDOR** was now likely to be spelled.

## Race 6 Allied Workforce Soliloquy Stakes

**BEL SORRISO** (S Spratt) became fractious in its barrier and was removed to undergo a veterinary inspection. **BEL SORRISO** was found to have suffered a number of superficial lacerations, requiring subsequent veterinary treatment, being declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 3.23pm. Trainer Mr G Searle advised that **BEL SORRISO** would now be spelled. **LA BELLE ETOILE** (J Oliver) began awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of **CHOICE** (M Du Plessis) which became

unbalanced with LA BELLE ETOILE losing ground.

**BIG DREAMER** (V Colgan) began awkwardly losing ground.

VAVASOUR (D Johnson) was slow to begin.

Approaching the 1200 metres **SEA OF SPEED** (S Collett) got its head up and raced ungenerously when being restrained, shifting inwards and crowding **EYESONYOU** (R Hutchings) which had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **CHOICE**. Also hampered as a result was **LA BELLE ETOILE** which had been attempting to improve to the inside of **EYESONYOU** becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels and over-racing for a distance.

Passing the 1200 metres the pace of the race eased with **EYESONYOU** having to be firmly restrained off the heels of **CHOICE**, going back onto, and further hampering **LA BELLE ETOILE**. **VAVASOUR** and **BIG DREAMER** also had to be firmly restrained to avoid heels at that point of the race.

**EYESONYOU** had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

Near the 175 metres **VAVASOUR** shifted away from **SEA OF SPEED** making contact with **BIG DREAMER**. Prior to the authorisation of dividends the connections of **BIG DREAMER** viewed video footage before deciding not to proceed with a protest.

On return to the enclosure **CHOICE** was observed to have been galloped on to the right hind leg.

## Race 7 Manuka Doctor Bonecrusher Stakes

**SHANZOU** reared as the start was affected, unseating Rider L Innes who was then dislodged. L Innes was uninjured. Trainer Mr R Collett was advised that **SHANZOU** would be required to barrier trial satisfactorily prior to racing next. **KNIGHT COURT** (D Nolan) began awkwardly.

**SYDNEY CARTON** (O Bosson) and **ALL GOOD THINGS** (P Holmes) both raced ungenerously in the early stages coming together near the 1300 metres. **KNIGHT COURT**, which was over-racing, then improved to become awkwardly placed inside the heels of **BAZZ** (C Grylls) crowding **ALL GOOD THINGS** and **SYDNEY CARTON** which again came together approaching the 1200 metres.

SYDNEY CARTON, ALL GOOD THINGS and KNIGHT COURT all continued to race ungenerously into the middle stages. PASSING SHOT (M Du Plessis) commenced to over-race when passed by the riderless horse near the 800 metres TWYA (M Sweeney) lay out rounding the final turn and continued to do so in the straight.

### Race 8 Life Education Ambassador Terenzo Bozzone Mile

WATTLE BAY (M Sweeney) was slow to begin.

**UNCLE SHAYNE** (J Wong) was steadied passing the 1200 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of **POLLY FLINDERS** (V Colgan).

**DRAGONKEEPER** (R Smyth) hung outwards rounding the bend and continued to do so in the final straight finishing on the extreme outside of the track.

**BONINSKY** (J Oliver) had to be steadied away from the heels of **JOEY JONZ** (L Magorrian) near the 200 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of **JOEY JONZ** apprentice L Magorrian advised that in his opinion the gelding is better suited to a more rain affected track. A post race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

## Race 9 Mortgage & Insurance People 1400

KAGE IS KING (D Johnson) was slow away.

**LOLA BRIGIDA** (J Oliver) and **RAP N TAP** (S Spratt) were crowded leaving the barriers when **BULLDOZER** (L Magorrian) jumped inwards.

**BULLDOZER** shifted outwards under pressure inconveniencing **THEBESTOFYOU** (R Smyth) passing the 150 metres. Apprentice L Magorrian was advised that in future he must stop riding and straighten his mount more quickly than he had on this occasion.

**SMEDLEY** (S Collett) lay out under pressure in the final straight.

KAGE IS KING was not persevered with over the final 200 metres after commencing to hang out when well back.
