RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 THE WATERFRONT HOTEL MAIDEN

BURNING DEGREE began awkwardly, shifting in and making contact with SOLAR.

WHEN IN ROME was slow away and shortly after clipped the heel of CARLEEN.

WHEN IN ROME hung outwards throughout.

WYNTHORPE raced wide throughout.

TEMPLE TIGER made the first turn awkwardly and shifted out dictating **WORZEL GUMMIDGE** out on to **WYNTHORPE** which was bumped and momentarily unbalanced.

SOLAR hung outwards throughout and lost ground when shifting wide rounding the 400 metre bend.

Race 2 JUFFERMANS SURVEYORS 3&4YO'S

ELVIS bounded leaving the barrier and shifted in making contact with KEWZERO which became unbalanced.

DANASONIC began awkwardly and bounded losing considerable ground. Trainer P Fleming was advised that a warning is placed against DANASONIC regarding its barrier manners.

KEWZERO had to be steadied near the 800 metres when racing to the inside of **ELVIS** (J Parkes) which was angled inward when not the required distance clear. J Parkes was advised to exercise more care when in a similar situation in future.

MISS RHYTHMIC received a bump from **DIAMANTINE** near the 200m when **DIAMANTINE** was angled out in search of a clear run

Following the running of race 2 the track was upgraded to dead 4.

Race 3 BARRY DANIELS & SONS PAINTERS MAIDEN

DURHAM ROSE was slow to begin.

SCARRED was crowded leaving the barriers between **EYE RACED NINETY** which shifted out and **GOLDEN GLOW** which lay in.

SECONDS OUT and **ZAFRENZY** came together and bumped on jumping away.

SECONDS OUT raced three wide without cover throughout.

YANGTZE made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly dictating **EYE RACED NINETY** outwards into the line of **VICTORY CHAMPION** which had to be steadied to avoid that runner's heels.

SCARRED had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

GOLDEN GLOW shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres bumping with **BE THE MOST.**

SCARRED lost the off-hind plate during the running.

Race 4 COMCAT MAIDEN

BROKEN BELT shifted out abruptly on jumping hampering COUNTDOWN which lost ground.

GOLD PROMISE lay in shortly after leaving the barrier resulting in crowding to **TWIST AND TURN** and **SPENDAHOLIC**, with **TWIST AND TURN** losing ground.

SMOKED had to be steadied near the 1000 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of HONEY QUEEN.

SMOKED was then obliged to race wide for the remainder.

HONEY QUEEN raced three wide without cover throughout.

PENTAROSE shifted in under pressure over the final 100 metres.

Race 5 EKRAAR & ECHOES OF HEAVEN @ LINWOOD PARK 1400

BRAD THORN began awkwardly and shortly after was tightened when **SIR KINGWOOD** shifted out and away from **DURIE HILL**.

SIR KINGWOOD over raced in the early and middle stages and made the 900 metre bend awkwardly.

SIR GUS over raced in the backstraight.

When questioned into the disappointing run of **BRAD THORN** which was last throughout, Apprentice Jockey B Murray reported that **BRAD THORN** is best suited to racing in or near the lead and after missing the jump today failed to run on to any extent.

BRAD THORN underwent a veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 6 NZ BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE PEARL SERIES

MISS DAISY dislodged rider R Hannam during the preliminary, R Hannam was uninjured. MISS DAISY underwent and passed a veterinary inspection behind the barriers.

MISS DAISY and BIDDABLE came together leaving the barriers.

BETTER KEEPER was slow to begin.

STORMY LASS raced three wide without cover throughout.

BETTER KEEPER (K Chiong) shifted in passing the 200 metres resulting in **STORMY LASS** (D Bradley) having to be steadied off that runners heels. K Chiong was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).

CASSIE ANNE was held up for the majority of the home straight and went to the line untested.

When questioned into the run of **BIDDABLE** Jockey J Riddell advised that although **BIDDABLE** was not far behind the placegetters, in his opinion the mare was disappointing. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality.

Race 7 SEATON PARK 1200

H Tinsley was unable to make the contracted weight for **ONE DIREKTION** and was replaced by D Bradley. H Tinsley was fined \$200.

ONE DIREKTION began awkwardly and blundered on jumping away. Rider D Bradley advised the gelding felt uncomfortable in its action. **ONE DIREKTION** was not persevered with over the final stages as rider D Bradley considered something may be amiss. Stewards ordered a subsequent veterinary examination which did not reveal anything amiss.

SALUTE ME shifted out abruptly on jumping tightening FASHION GURU which lost ground.

WHATWEDO (S McKay) shifted in under pressure near the 150 metres momentarily hampering CATWOMANDU.

Apprentice Jockey S McKay was shown footage of his ride and advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

THEODORE raced a little erratically in the home straight and had to be straightened near the 100 metres and again near the finish when inclined to shift ground under pressure.

Race 8 NEW WORLD MERRILANDS 3210

GOOD RISK was a late scratching at 4.13 pm after dislodging rider S Doyle and galloped an excessive distance.

KING OF ROCK jumped away awkwardly and lost ground.

KING OF ROCK over raced when being restrained in the early stages.

JOKING raced keenly when racing outside the leader in the early and middle stages.

Over the final stages **SUPERTURF** and **KING OF ROCK** both shifted ground which resulted in **VICKI ANNE** racing in restricted room near the finish.

Race 9 POWERWORX OPEN

SEA EAGLE underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed fit to race after clipping the birdcage gate prior to parading.

ST RANSOM dislodged rider R Hannam behind the barrier, R Hannam was uninjured.

GO THUNDER, OUR GAZZA and SEA EAGLE were slow to begin.

I AM SAM raced three wide without cover throughout.

GOLD CARD shifted out rounding the 1600 metre corner and bumped TAURUS

SIR ELMO and **GYNETHANNE** made the final turn wide on the track.

Shortly after entering the home straight **SIR ELMO** shifted in simultaneously as **DUKE OF YORK** was improving into a narrow run to the outside of **OUR GAZZA** which shifted ground outwards marginally. This resulted in **SIR ELMO** having to be steaded

Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections of the 3rd placed **DUKE OF YORK** viewed coverage of tightening near the 200 metres from the second placed **OUR GAZZA**, but elected not to proceed with an objection.

When questioned into the run of **DUBAI BELLE** rider R Myers stated in her opinion **DUBAI BELLE** may have preferred a more rain affected track. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of **DUBAI BELLE** which failed to reveal any abnormality. When questioned into the run of **ST RANSOM** which was under pressure prior to entering the home straight rider R Hannam advised that **ST RANSOM** is better suited to a more rain affected going. A subsequent veterinary inspection of **ST RANSOM** failed to reveal any abnormality.

Race 10 PUKEKURA MOTOR LODGE 2000

FAST PROFIT shifted in leaving the barriers crowding **FLOOZIE CAT** which lost ground.

TRANSLUCENCE began awkwardly and was dictated wide when CLAPATHUNDA shifted out.

Shortly after entering the home straight **FAST PROFIT** (J Riddell) and **KING NERO** (H Tinsley) came together and bumped when both runners shifted ground. A short distance further **FAST PROFIT** lay out and further made contact with **KING NERO**. J Riddell was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances. Prior to the authorisation of dividends connections of the 3rd placed **KING NERO** viewed coverage of the tightening but elected not to proceed with an objection against the 2nd placed **FAST PROFIT**.

Rider D Bradley reported that TRANSLUCENCE was not suited to the dead 4 track conditions.

When questioned into the run of **FLOOZIE CAT** rider K Chiong stated that **FLOOZIE CAT** may prefer more rain affected going.
