RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NABBY'S BOXING GYM 2100
<p>KINDALEICA (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly, shifting out, forcing ST D'ORE (L Magorrian) out into the line of LE'VANTOS (J Parkes) which was hampered. Contributing was slight inward movement from I'M ALL YOURS (R Hutchings).</p> <p>KINDALEICA (C Grylls) raced ungenerously in the early stages when being steadied.</p> <p>DON ENVY (J Wong) became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1700 metres, shifting in and tightening TABLE ONE (M Hills).</p> <p>IZ (M Sweeney) raced wide without cover until working forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>EPICUREAN (M Cameron) was held up for a distance from near the 600 metres until entering the final straight.</p> <p>LE'VANTOS had a tendency to lay in when placed under pressure making contact with STRAIGHT FURROW (B R Jones) passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>LE BON FIN (M Dee) was held up until passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>TABLE ONE had to change ground to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of EPICUREAN rider M Cameron advised that the mare had travelled well throughout the race, but failed to respond once placed under pressure in the final straight, and could offer no tangible excuse for the horse's performance. EPICUREAN underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality other than a slower than normal recovery.</p>	

When questioned regarding the improved performance of **LE BON FIN** co-trainer T Autridge advised that the gelding had appreciated today's better track conditions.

Race 2 | **TOPSOIL & SAND SUPPLIES (2011) LTD 1200**

PERSUASIVE (M Coleman) knuckled leaving the barrier.

ASON (A Jones) jumped away awkwardly.

SECRET POWER (K Myers) was hampered leaving the barrier.

ASON raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 900 metres **BACK ON SONG** (R Hutchings) was steadied when racing in restricted room to the inside of **PRINCESS MICHELLA** (D Johnson) which was also steadying.

Passing the 375 metres **BACK ON SONG** shifted out placing **LOOKATMEPINS** (C Grylls) in restricted room. **PERSUASIVE** which was held up then shifted in to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres, crowding **LOOKATMEPINS** which was hampered losing ground. M Coleman admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with his licence to ride in races being suspended by the Judicial Committee 9 – 16 October inclusive, 4 riding days.

CRYSTALIGHT (V Colgan) was placed in restricted room passing the 350 metres.

CHARLIE FARLEY (J Wong) was inclined to race greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.

The track was downgraded to Dead (6) following race 2.

Race 3 | **WWW.TERAPARACING.CO.NZ**

KALEVALA (K Myers) was slow to begin.

Passing the 1000 metres **DREAMS MAKER** (S Spratt) commenced to race ungenerously when placed in restricted room to the inside of **ALWAYS ON MY MIND** (R Smyth) which lay in despite the efforts of its rider. **DREAMS MAKER** then continue to race ungenerously for a distance with **KALEVALA** then becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels passing the 900 metres having to steady and change ground.

Approaching the 900 metres **TORNADO ALLEY** (D Johnson) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **CHEEKY BOY** (M Du Plessis) and commenced to race ungenerously. **LAMASON** (M Cameron) then shifted in, dictating **CHEEKY BOY** inwards, crowding **TORNADO ALLEY** which was hampered, losing ground. Rider M Cameron was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on his record.

LAMASON raced wide without cover.

LAMASON commenced to race greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight, shifting in passing the 250 metres, inconveniencing **GRANT'S GIRL** (A Jones).

When questioned regarding the performance of **TORNADO ALLEY** rider D Johnson advised that after racing ungenerously in the early stages, **TORNADO ALLEY** had made ground fairly when placed under pressure, and believed the gelding would appreciate improved track conditions and a step up in distance.

Race 4 | **WAIKATO FARMERS MARKETS @ TE RAPA 1200**

VINNIE EAGLE (L Innes) reared as the start was made losing ground.

THE COSMOS (J Parkes) was slow to begin.

CHAMPAGNE REIN (M Du Plessis) and **SHEES FLAWLESS** (V Colgan) both raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

PURCENTAGE (C Grylls) was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.

When questioned regarding the performance of **CHAMPAGNE REIN** rider M Du Plessis could offer no tangible excuses.

CHAMPAGNE REIN underwent a subsequent veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 5 | **SENSORTRONIC SCALES 1200**

ONLYAROSE (M Du Plessis) and **LE CHOIX** (K Leung) were both slow to begin.

LE CHOIX raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SULTRY ASSASSIN (D Johnson) raced wide without cover throughout.

Approaching the 900 metres **PUI PUI** (S Spratt) raced in restricted room between **SULTRY ASSASSIN** which lay in despite the efforts of its rider and **VILLARS** (V Colgan) which shifted out slightly. As a result **PUI PUI** was hampered losing ground.

Passing the 250 metres **RICH BILLIE MARSH** (J Parkes) shifted out slightly under pressure hampering **ALICE WEBB ELLIS** (R Smyth) which had shifted in under pressure, with **ALICE WEBB ELLIS** then shifting out to obtain clear running.

VILLARS shifted out passing the 150 metres inconveniencing **ONLYAROSE**.

Race 6 | **HISTORIAN 1400**

DIORELLA (C Grylls) began awkwardly losing ground.

THE PAPERBOY (K Leung) shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers, crowding **APACHEE TAAT** (U Holmquist).

ZELDARA (M Du Plessis) and **PANNO ROSSA** (D Johnson) were both slow to begin.

CAPE MAPPERLEY (J Parkes) began awkwardly.
BAJOUR (V Colgan) travelled wide without cover for the majority of the race.
CAPE MAPPERLEY was steadied passing the 1200 metres when awkwardly placed.
Passing the 400 metres **POLISH** (L Innes) shifted to the outside of **BAJOUR** to obtain clear running with **BAJOUR** then shifting out under pressure dictating **POLISH** out slightly, crowding **WAZUNGU** (K Myers).
APACHEE TAAT was held up passing the 400 metres, shifting inwards to obtain clear running, and then was again held up passing the 200 metres.

Race 7 | **WAIKATO THOROUGHBRED RACE HORSE OWNERS 1400**

CAPONE (V Colgan) and **SPIN DOCTOR** (R Hutchings) both began awkwardly.
CAPONE over-raced when being steadied approaching the 900 metres.
Approaching the 600 metres **KAPSBOY** (U Holmquist) had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.
Passing the 250 metres **KAPSBOY** became awkwardly placed on the heels of **BREAKING DAWN** (N Harris) which shifted out. Contributing was inward movement from **JUBILATE** (M Coleman).
The connections of **KAPSBOY** viewed Stewards footage following the race, electing not to proceed with an objection.

Race 8 | **NRM 1600**

Apprentice rider Z Moki (**DOUCETTE**) was fined \$100 for failing to claim down to her published riding weight.
EEZEMOOVA (L Magorrian) was slow to begin.
ESKABAR (M Dee) shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers, crowding **DOUCETTE** (Z Moki), **GESEMI** (M Cameron), **WAJIMA** (M Du Plessis) and **MARANUI** (M Hills) with **MARANUI** then making contact with the hind quarters of **SING FOR THE SUN** (R Smyth) which became unbalanced. As a result **MARANUI** and **WAJIMA** (M Du Plessis) lost considerable ground.
Passing the 600 metres **SIR LANCELOT** (M Chui) steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.
R Smyth (**SING FOR THE SUN**) dropped her whip near the 500 metres.
SATAY (D Bradley) improved into a run to the outside of **SANASAR** (R Hutchings) passing the 150 metres with **SANASAR** then shifting out, crowding **SATAY** on to the hind quarters of **THEE ACHIEVER** (C Grylls). Apprentice rider R Hutchings was advised that he must exercise greater care.
SO HIGH (S Spratt) which gave ground when placed under pressure in the final straight, was not persevered with over the final 150 metres. **SO HIGH** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 9 | **HINUERA LODGE 1600**

Permission was given to trainer Steven Ramsay to remove the pacifiers from **DUQUESA** (S Collett) due to track conditions.
SHOW THE WORLD (O Bosson) was slow to begin.
DUQUESA and **FULL MONTY** (D Johnson) both began awkwardly.
CELTIC CHIEF (M Dee) over-raced through the middle stages.
Approaching the 400 metres **DUQUESA** lay out with **GWYNEDD** (M Wenn) shifting away from that runner, crowding **CODY CAT** (L Magorrian) on to the hind quarters of **GUESS WHAT** (J Oliver).
OSMUNDA (M Cameron) was held up until passing the 250 metres.
Approaching the 100 metres **FLYING ORCA** (U Holmquist) raced in restricted room between **DUQUESA** and **OUI** (M Du Plessis) both of which shifted ground slightly with **FLYING ORCA** making contact with **DUQUESA**.
The connections of **GWYNEDD** advised the mare will now be given a break after a disappointing performance.
