RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RODDY MCRAE DISTANCE (2100m)
<p>LYKAROC was fractious in its barrier.</p> <p>I'M YOUR MAN shifted out on jumping, bumping with COOL HAND DUKE.</p> <p>SKYBIRD began awkwardly.</p> <p>THE DUKE'S SECRET jumped out at the start making heavy contact with OMA ELLE, which was unbalanced. OMA ELLE was further hampered when SCARRED shifted in shortly after.</p> <p>ST'RUTH and ZEDACE were slow to begin.</p> <p>MINSTREL FLYER made the first turn awkwardly and ran wide for a short distance.</p> <p>LAST TRUMP lay out rounding the first turn, dictating ZEDACE over extra ground. ZEDACE then raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of LYKAROC, rider M Dravitzki said that after being fractious in its barrier then racing in restricted room rounding the final turn, the gelding failed to respond when asked to quicken in the home straight and she was to advise connections that blinkers may prove beneficial. R Stam, the rider of OMA ELLE was advised to exercise care after he allowed his mount to shift out rounding the final turn, tightening ZEDACE.</p>	

Race 2	THE MEAT COMPANY DANNEVIRKE STAYERS (2200m)
<p>O'CEIRINS SECRET got back at the start.</p> <p>MR COOL BOY was inclined to over-race in the early stages and had to be restrained off heels for a distance near the 1600 metres.</p> <p>SHOTGUN weakened passing the 600 metres and came back on to MR COOL BOY, which became badly held up and lost ground.</p> <p>JACK'S BOY (R Hannam) had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed inside the heels of VICKI ANNE (R Myers) and JIMMY MAC (D Bradley) passing the 500 metres. After questioning riders it could not be established that fault lay with any particular rider.</p> <p>JUST ISHI lay out in the early part of the final straight and finished the race off wide on the track.</p> <p>Track conditions were upgraded to Good (3) following Race 2.</p>	
Race 3	MURRAY CONTRACTORS DASH (1200m)
<p>FIFTEENSIXTY (J Oliver) was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 1.22pm. Connections were advised that a clearance is required.</p> <p>ELUSIVE JANE underwent a nasal inspection by the veterinary surgeon after bumping its nose on the gates when loaded away. ELUSIVE JANE was cleared to start.</p> <p>WORZEL GUMMIDGE began awkwardly and lost several lengths.</p> <p>MOUNTAIN PRINCESS began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>HUNDYAMONTH raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ARIBASAN was held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres.</p> <p>WHEELER FORTUNE was dictated wide by outward movement from SUCHAPALAVA (N Teeluck) early in the home straight. N Teeluck was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>WHEELER FORTUNE (R Hutchings) shifted in under hard riding over the final stages placing SUCHAPALAVA in restricted room. Apprentice R Hutchings (WHEELER FORTUNE) was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).</p> <p>UNICO shifted out under pressure passing the 200 metres and could not be ridden to full advantage thereafter.</p>	
Race 4	MIKE JAMES PLUMBING SPRINT (1400m)
<p>CHUCK IT IN BRO hung in abruptly shortly after leaving the barriers resulting in POSTER GIRL, DONNA BEEL, LUCQUIDE and FERRAGOSTO all being hampered and losing ground. CHUCK IT IN BRO then raced greenly for some distance in the back straight.</p> <p>OBRAHMA raced greenly shortly after leaving the barriers and lost ground.</p> <p>SALLYMONT JEU raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>DONNA BEEL was held up passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>N Teeluck, (FERRAGOSTO) was shown footage of his ride after he allowed his mount to shift wide on the turn dictating DONNA BEEL over extra ground. M Dravitzki (DONNA BEEL) said that her mount did not corner well, despite the inside pressure however, rider N Teeluck was advised to make a greater effort to maintain his correct line of running.</p>	
Race 5	JAMESON'S MOTOR TRIMMERS & UPHOLSTERERS SPRINT (1400m)
<p>STAR EMERALD shifted in abruptly shortly after jumping away severely hampering EDGE OF GLORY, BAZINGER and GIRL WITH A PEARL.</p> <p>ELLIE'O was slow to begin.</p> <p>Christopher Dell, the rider of PERFECT MIX lost his off-side stirrup iron near the 500 metres and became dislodged. C Dell was uninjured.</p> <p>GIRL WITH A PEARL raced wide for the majority of the event.</p> <p>TANSAVA hung out rounding the final turn and lost ground.</p>	
Race 6	BAMBRY'S WATER TREADMILL METRIC MILE (1600m)
<p>MUNGO JERRY and MISS ANA were slow to begin.</p> <p>MISSTEEFLYING made the first bend awkwardly and then raced three wide without cover for the remainder.</p> <p>N Teeluck (CENTRE ATTENTION) was shown footage of his ride in the presence of his employer K Zimmerman, after he allowed his mount to shift out in the home straight initially hampering GOLD CARD near the 150 metres and then continuing to let his mount shift out. N Teeluck was advised that he is expected to straighten his mount much sooner than he has on this occasion and issued with a warning under rule 638(1)(d).</p> <p>LIV'N PARADISE raced in restricted room rounding the turn gaining clear running near the 350 metres.</p> <p>When questioned into the disappointing run of GENDARME, rider D Johnson had no tangible excuse, however was of the opinion the gelding had been short in its action on pulling up. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed GENDARME had suffered minor lacerations to the right hind leg consistent with having been galloped on.</p>	

Race 7	D&G AUTOSPRAY DISTANCE (2100m)
<p>PATIENCE was slow to begin.</p> <p>THE PAINTER began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>LORRAINE blundered shortly after leaving the barriers, shifted out making heavy contact with GOLDEN PENNY. Also affected was CASINO JACK which was buffeted for a short distance.</p> <p>EXQUISITE JEWEL was slow to begin.</p> <p>PATIENCE (C O'Beirne) commenced to race fiercely in the home straight on the first occasion which resulted in the saddle slipping forward and apprentice C O'Beirne being unable to control the mare. PATIENCE ran off when making the turn into the back straight near the 1400 metres. Miss O'Beirne then lost the use of her irons, which resulted her becoming dislodged near the 1000 metres. Miss O'Beirne was attended by St John medical personnel and cleared to ride.</p>	
Race 8	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200m)
<p>I'MA COLOMBIAN was very slow to begin and lost several lengths (4L).</p> <p>LAWRIES CHOICE began awkwardly.</p> <p>HONEY QUEEN was slow to begin.</p> <p>I'MA COLOMBIAN (J Riddell) had to be checked off the heels of BLACK FERN (A Jones) when that runner shifted in passing the 800 metres. When questioned A Jones concurred with the stewards that she had placed I'MA COLOMBIAN in restricted room only after receiving a bump from CATALINA DE LAGO. A Jones was given the benefit of a doubt but was advised that she is expected to exercise better judgment in future.</p> <p>EYESONYOU was held up early in the home straight prior to being angled inwards to improve. EYESONYOU was held up for the majority of the home straight only obtaining clear running over the last 100 metres.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of SCARLET LETTER which disappointed, rider R Myers could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 9	PAHIATUA GOLF CLUB SPRINT (1400m)
<p>LAMBORGHINI and PICCADILLY were tightened at the start when there was movement from runners either side.</p> <p>GUY was slow away.</p> <p>STONEMASON raced keenly and had to be restrained for some distance in the back straight.</p> <p>SPECIAL BID had to be steadied off heels approaching the first turn and lost ground.</p> <p>GUY had to steady near the 800 metres.</p> <p>PICCADILLY was held up rounding the home turn.</p> <p>CAULFIELD was angled outwards near the 350 metres in search of clear running and in doing so bumped DIXIE EXPRESS which became momentarily unbalanced. DIXIE EXPRESS and CAULFIELD both shifted ground outwards under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>Prior to the authorisation of dividends a protest was lodged by the connections of the 3rd placed DIXIE EXPRESS against the 2nd placed CAULFIELD alleging interference in the home straight. After deliberations the JCA dismissed the protest.</p>
