RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CANCER SOCIETY – RAY LEE SPECIAL FUNDRAISER 1580
ELGAR (M Hills) was a little slow to begin.	
HEART OF GRACE (L Magorrian) jumped away awkwardly shifting out making firm contact with SETAROSSA (M Cameron) with both runners losing ground.	
FULLFLIGHT (D Hain) over-raced in the early stages.	
STYLE IS ETERNAL (M Sweeney) got its head up passing the 1100 metres when being firmly restrained off the heels of SETAROSSA .	
APACHE MOON (A Jones) raced three wide without cover throughout.	
When questioned into the disappointing performance of STYLE IS ETERNAL rider M Sweeney advised the mare would be	

better suited to more rain-affected tracks.	
Race 2	S L COMPUTING & CONSULTING 1150
<p>MILL LEE (M Hills) and ULTIMATE IMAGE (C Lammas) were both slow to begin. GOLD PROMISE (S Spratt) jumped away awkwardly shifting out hampering SAUCY MARY (R Smyth). CRUCIAL (M Cameron) and GOLD PROMISE raced keenly through the middle stages. SOLAR (S Collett) raced wide without cover throughout. SEA TIGER (D Hain) commenced to lay in passing the 600 metres and then when struck with the whip passing the 200 metres lay in and clipped a heel of GOLD PROMISE and fell. MILL LEE which was following was unable to avoid the fallen runner when it was regaining its feet and fell dislodging rider M Hills. SEA TIGER was uninjured. MILL LEE was treated for minor bruising by the Club's veterinarian. Both riders after undergoing a medical examination were passed fit to continue to fulfil their riding engagements. When questioned into the disappointing performance of CRUCIAL rider M Cameron advised that the gelding had over-raced in the early stages, and after being held up early in the final straight was unable to quicken when placed under pressure.</p>	
Race 3	BULLBARS @ HIGHVIEW STUD 1150
<p>ABSOLUTELY SACRED (L Satherley), MR KNOWITALL (S Spratt) and SNOW EXCUSE (U Holmquist) were all slow to begin. MAT DILLON (C Grylls) raced keenly in the early and middle stages. ONLYAROSE (A Jones) was inclined to lay out making the final bend, and continued to lay out in the final straight when placed under pressure. MR KNOWITALL was held up on the heels of ABSOLUTELY SACRED near the 250 metres having to shift in to obtain clear running, but was then denied clear running for the remainder of the race. TRAVEL WISE (M Cameron) lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 4	SWEET ORANGE @ HIGHVIEW STUD 1400
<p>TOP DRIVE (L Magorrian) jumped away awkwardly. NAUGHTY KNUCKLES (C Dell) was slow to begin. ERNIE (U Holmquist) and NAUGHTY KNUCKLES (C Dell) raced wide without cover throughout. Near the 1150 metres ERNIE raced in restricted room for a distance to the inside of TOP DRIVE when JOANNA (R Smyth) lay outwards. ERNIE over-raced in the middle stages. TINGED WITH GOLD (R Hutchings) was inclined to lay out from the 600 metres. Passing the 50 metres TASHA AIMEE (A Jones) had to shift out abruptly off the heels of the weakening TINGED WITH GOLD.</p>	
Race 5	QUINLAN ELECTRICAL 1150
<p>SWISS EXPRESS (R Hutchings) was slow to begin. MOONLIGHT MILE (M Hills) was slow to begin, then was further crowded losing ground between LIBERTY HEIGHTS (D Johnson) and THE SECRET'S OUT (M Cameron). HARBOUR ALERT (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly. CANDID MAN (B R Jones) began awkwardly shifting in. SIAN (L Satherley) commenced to hang out approaching the 900 metres and continued to hang out for the remainder of the race. DAYTIME ROBBERY (L Magorrian) got its head up and raced ungenerously passing the 900 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of LITTLE MISS MOSSOP (S Collett), and continued to hang out for the remainder of the race. LOVE TO LUCIA (J Wong) raced wide without cover throughout. Approaching the 800 metres SWISS EXPRESS when improving forward shifted out and inconvenienced SECRET'S OUT. When questioned into the performance of the favourite DAYTIME ROBBERY rider L Magorrian advised that he could offer no reason for the colt's performance apart from racing ungenerously through the middle stages.</p>	
Race 6	CRAIG'S TAKEAWAYS @ WHANGAMATA 1150
<p>Mr G Richardson the trainer of CRYSTALIGHT was fined \$50 for presenting CRYSTALIGHT to race without notified gear being blinkers. CRYSTALIGHT (C Grylls) was slow to begin. HUG A GINGA (L Satherley) had to be steadied shortly after the start when placed in restricted room when runners on either side shifted ground. Shortly after jumping away GOTTA KEEPER (B R Jones) had to steady when crowded between BACK ON SONG (R Hutchings) and PENZANCE (R Smyth) when both those runners shifted ground. PENZANCE over-raced through the middle stages. Near the 600 metres PRESUME (J Oliver) got its head up when having to be firmly restrained off heels for a distance. Near the 100 metres SEREIN (L Magorrian) improved for a run to the inside of PENZANCE which had shifted in slightly</p>	

with **SEREIN** then continuing to shift in when not clear of **THEODORE** (M Hills) which had to be sharply checked losing ground. L Magorrian admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) and after hearing evidence the Judicial Committee suspended L Magorrian's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 30 October up to and including racing on 7 November, 4 riding days.

Race 7 | **WAIPA WORKINGMENS CLUB 1400**

BRAH SPRING dislodged rider R Smyth during the preliminary galloping a short distance before being recaptured
BRAH SPRING underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared fit to start.
DORIAN GREY (L Magorrian) was slow to begin,
CONRWIN (J Oliver) jumped away awkwardly.
BRAH SPRING over-raced in the early and middle stages.
THE CANON (L Satherley) was inclined to lay out rounding the final bend.
Near the 200 metres **DORIAN GREY** had to shift in abruptly off the heels of the weakening **PASSING SHOT** (D Johnson) to obtain clear running.
The favourite **PASSING SHOT** raced in or near the lead until into the final straight and was quickly under pressure finishing well back. A post-race veterinary examination of **PASSING SHOT** did not reveal any abnormality. Rider D Johnson was unable to offer any reason for the colt's performance.

Race 8 | **BAUHINIA RACING STABLES LTD 1400**

QUICKASUCAN (M Wenn) jumped away awkwardly shifting in on to **BINGO** (D Johnson) forcing that runner into the line of **HAMACHO** (S Collett) with that runner having to steady off heels losing ground. Also crowded in this incident was **DREAMS MAKER** (S McKay).
MRS SIN (L Magorrian) was slow to begin.
OUR EEJAY (S Spratt) over-raced in the early stages having to be firmly restrained off the heels of runners ahead.
DREAMS MAKER got its head up approaching the 1200 metres when being firmly restrained off the heels of **BINGO** dropping back on to **HAMACHO** which had to be steadied.
HAMACHO over-raced for a distance through the middle stages.
ROYAL TOAST (R Smyth) raced wide without cover throughout.
MRS SIN raced keenly in the middle stages.
Passing the 800 metres **CHOCOLAT** (M Sweeney) got its head up and raced ungenerously for a distance.
When questioned into the performance of **CHOCOLAT** rider M Sweeney advised that after being slow away the mare raced ungenerously amongst other runners, and has run her better races when in the clear, but could offer no other reason for the disappointing performance.
