RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WINDSOR PARK STALLIONS 3YO
<p>GRANITE (V Colgan) jumped away awkwardly. DON'T LOOK BACK (R Hutchings) was slow to begin. JACQUI ICKX (S Collett), GRANITE and KEEN TO KEEPER (C Lammas) all over-raced in the middle stages. LUNASA (A Jones) raced wide without cover throughout. ELUCIDATE (D Johnson) was inclined to lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 2	PAUL HICKEY-9 TO 3 ON THE HITS 1200
<p>SUAREZ (L Innes) jumped away awkwardly. AGOSTINI (R Hutchings) jumped away awkwardly, shifting out forcing KING PHEROZ (B R Jones) outwards into the line of ALL JOKES ASIDE (A Jones) which was hampered losing ground. ORANGE ROUGHIE (C Grylls) was crowded and hampered leaving the barriers. ROMAN HERO (K Myers) commenced to race fiercely approaching the 800 metres, shifting out off heels and forcing ORANGE ROUGHIE wide on the track. ROMAN HERO then raced wide without cover for a distance. Passing the 800 metres ASHWINI (D Johnson) commenced to hang outwards when making the bend, and continued to do so for the remainder of the race. ASHWINI could not be ridden to full advantage in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance of ORANGE ROUGHIE rider C Grylls advised that the mare had not had a favourable trip in transit which had been detrimental to its chances.</p>	

Race 3	ILES CASEY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1950
<p>STRATEGICLEIGH (J Oliver) was slow to begin. VILLA ELBA (M Coleman) jumped away awkwardly. ZIZI (C Dell) jumped away awkwardly, shifting out and hampering EL PISTOLA (B R Jones), IDAHO'S CHOICE (C Lammas), RESULT MERCHANT (S Collett) and TOFINO (R Hutchings). Contributing to this was inward movement from QUANTUM MAELSTROM (K Myers). ALEZAN (M Cameron) over-raced in the early and middle stages. After racing wide in the early stages IDAHO'S CHOICE was allowed to work forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres. VILLA ELBA raced wide without cover throughout. STRATEGICLEIGH raced ungenerously in the early stages, and hung out running wide when making the final bend. QUANTUM MAELSTROM had a tendency to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. TOFINO returned to scale missing the near fore plate.</p>	
Race 4	SPEEDY SIGNS-EMBROIDEME 1560
<p>THE GENERAL RIO (R Hutchings) jumped away awkwardly, shifting out, forcing OCEAN PARADE (S McKay) into the line of ASTONISHINGLY WELL with that runner blundering and unbalancing rider M Chui. SODALICIOUS (S Collett) raced keenly in the early and middle stages. OCEAN PARADE raced ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 1200 metres. Passing the 450 metres MIRAGE (C Lammas) lay out with SETAROSSA (C Grylls) shifting away from that runner, crowding THE GENERAL RIO which made contact with CARMEN SANDIEGO (V Colgan). SODALICIOUS was held up until near the 250 metres. OCEAN PARADE improved into a marginal run entering the final straight to the inside of the weakening MIRAGE. CARMEN SANDIEGO underwent an endoscopic examination following the race which was clear.</p>	
Race 5	ROTORUA REVIEW 1560
<p>CLOS DE TART (J Oliver) jumped away awkwardly. ATTICA (R Hutchings), OUR PRINCESS ZARA (S Collett) and CAPINSKY (O Bosson) were all slow to begin. CALL THE SHOTS (M Cameron) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages. MANAIA ROSE (D Johnson) raced keenly through the middle stages. CAPINSKY was obliged to race wide without cover throughout. Approaching the 100 metres ALL ABOUT FUN (K Myers) raced in restricted room between CAPINSKY and CALL THE SHOTS with CALL THE SHOTS then moving out slightly with ALL ABOUT FUN making contact with the hind quarters of CAPINSKY which was turned inwards. As a result ALL ABOUT FUN had to be checked losing ground.</p>	
Race 6	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1200
<p>ELUSIVE UNICORN (C Grylls) was slow to begin after being fractious in the barriers. LIME STREET (D Johnson) shifted out leaving the barrier, hampering HIGH TAIL IT (M Coleman). PRESUME (M Cameron) jumped away awkwardly, losing ground and then raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. ELUSIVE UNICORN underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to have lacerations to the hind legs.</p>	
Race 7	GROWNUPS.CO.NZ-50+? VISIT US 1950
<p>BERG EN DAL (R Hutchings) jumped away awkwardly. MAGIC MEMORIES (L Satherley) shifted out leaving the barrier, hampering AMITY DANE (C Dell). PRICKLEY PRINCESS (J Oliver) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding the performance of MATAGOURI rider C Grylls could offer no tangible excuse. MATAGOURI underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p>	
Race 8	MILLS REEF WINERY & RESTAURANT 1400
<p>TARTAN TWO (S Collett), KAAPRICORN (J Oliver) and NOTABADROOSTER (K Myers) were all slow to begin. GIVE GOLD (L Satherley) and WORTHISWAITNGOLD (A Jones) both raced wide throughout. BLACKJACK MAN (M Wenn) and OUR MOLLY MALONE (M Cameron) both over-raced in the middle stages. OUR KING SWAY (O Bosson) raced keenly in the early and middle stages. GIVE GOLD raced greenly for a distance passing the 600 metres. BLACKJACK MAN was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p>
