## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>INGHAM'S NUTRITION HANDICAP (1200 metres)</b>
<b>QUAKE</b> was a late scratching at 12.54pm behind the barrier after slipping over and injuring the right foreleg requiring veterinary attention. <b>WILD ROCK</b> bounded when the start was made, simultaneously as <b>PURE BLONDE</b> jumped in across the line of <b>WILD ROCK</b> , which lost ground and settled back.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>PIONEER 3YO MAIDEN (1200 metres)</b>
<b>CAVALRY</b> was awkward at the start and lost ground after being very slow into stride. <b>MOUNTAIN PRINCESS</b> was slow away. <b>LILY ROSE</b> and <b>SATIN RIDGE</b> were slow away. <b>THE JEUNEYMAN</b> and <b>IFFDABELLERINGS</b> raced keenly in the back straight and both had to be steadied off heels approaching the first turn. <b>K Myers (THE JEUNEYMAN)</b> said the colt raced greenly throughout. <b>IFFDABELLERINGS</b> was inclined to shift in over the final stages and had to be straightened.	

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>NUFARM HANDICAP (2100 metres)</b>
<p><b>MISS MOSSMAN</b> attempted to buck for some distance when the saddle slipped back marginally on jumping away. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on <b>MISS MOSSMAN</b> with respect to its racing manners. When questioned into the run of <b>MISS MOSSMAN</b>, rider <b>C Grylls</b> said that after being awkward in the early stages the mare travelled well until the home turn but when placed under pressure failed to respond, was disappointing and had no excuse. <b>DRAGON BEAUTY</b> was angled outwards near the 350 metres into a marginal gap which closed resulting in rider <b>M Hills</b> being held up, then having to angle the mare out near the 200 metres to improve.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>MARLEY HANDICAP (2200 metres)</b>
<p><b>SELWYN</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages and was eased outwards near the 1000 metres to avoid the rapidly tiring <b>THATZ LOUIE</b>.  <b>SHOW THE WORLD</b> raced three wide without cover throughout.  When questioned into the run of <b>THATZ LOUIE</b> which finished a long last, rider <b>K Chiong</b> was of the opinion there may be something wrong with the gelding's breathing. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer A Davies reported that the gelding may have got its tongue over the bit and was to consider altering the gear on <b>THATZ LOUIE</b> prior to its next start.  When questioned into the run of <b>SIR GUS</b>, rider <b>H Tinsley</b> reported that the gelding lugged throughout. Near the 800 metres <b>LITTLE STORM</b> was buffeted between <b>SHARBEELA (M Dee)</b> to its inside and <b>AUSTIN ROAD (J Parkes)</b>, which was improving to its outside. Both riders Dee and Parkes were advised to exercise care.  <b>SELWYN</b> lost the off side front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>AGRISEEDS HANDICAP (1200 metres)</b>
<p>When questioned into the run of <b>EIGHT SCHILLINGS</b>, rider <b>M Du Plessis</b> reported the gelding blew out over the final stages and would take natural improvement from the run.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>TRU TEST HANDICAP (1400 metres)</b>
<p><b>MISS APPLETON</b> jumped inwards when the start was made hampering <b>TALK THE TORQUE</b>, which settled back. <b>MALROSE</b> raced three wide without cover throughout.  <b>TALK THE TORQUE</b> was held up for a short distance near the 500 metre mark until entering the home straight. <b>JILTED</b> had to be angled wide in the home straight to improve.  <b>BATMAN</b> was obliged to race wide throughout.  <b>B Lammas</b> had no excuse for the disappointing run of <b>RANI AURORA</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>ECOLAB HANDICAP (1600 metres)</b>
<p><b>VOLKSWOOD</b> was tightened at the start and got back.  <b>MR DARCEE'S GOLD</b> raced wide without cover throughout.  <b>DELECTA DREIMS</b> was obliged to make its run wide rounding the turn. When questioned into the run of <b>DELECTA DREIMS</b>, rider <b>K Myers</b> said the mare never travelled well at any stage and was disappointing.  When questioned into the run of <b>HIGH FASHION</b> which disappointed, rider <b>H Tinsley</b> advised the mare's breathing pattern was unusual on pulling up and it may have held its breath during the running. Stewards ordered a subsequent veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be moderately distressed with signs of lameness in the right hind leg. Rider <b>V Ravikumar (VOLKSWOOD)</b> was reminded of his obligations with regard to his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>INL HANDICAP (1600 metres)</b>
<p><b>ROSAMOSA</b> was tightened at the start after <b>SLAZENJAH</b> shifted into its line.  <b>OUTSPOKEN</b> shifted in abruptly at the start resulting in the following being tightened, <b>MALACHY LAD</b>, <b>TRIPLE BILLING</b>, <b>PERRY MASON</b>, <b>OUT OF TIME</b> and <b>OEEE</b>, which was tightened between runners then became awkward in its action for several strides and attempted to buck near the crossing in the back straight. Connections were advised that a warning is placed on <b>OEEE</b> with regard to its racing manners.  <b>TRIPLE BILLING</b> had to be eased off the heels of <b>LORD CASANOVA</b> near the 1200 metres when over-racing.  <b>MASTER THOMAS</b> was inclined to shift out in the home straight and had to be straightened.  <b>PERRY MASON</b> raced in restricted room in the home straight until near the 100 metres.</p>
