RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MATAMATA CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES 17TH DECEMBER 2000

ABSOLUTE GEM (K Joyce) and BO YING (U Holmquist) were slow away.

SHAMAL (V Colgan) raced keenly through the early stages.

SIR AL SYD (R Norvall) had to be firmly restrained off the heels of **ABSOLUTE GEM** near the 1400 metres when the pace was steadied. **SIR AL SYD** then raced three wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

When questioned L Satherley was unable to offer any excuses for the disappointing performance of **SAKHEE'S STAR**.

Race 2 ONSITE AUTO ELECTRICAL (2005) LIMITED 1600

ELGAR (M Hills) began awkwardly shifting outwards making contact with the hind quarters of **READY TO RUMBLE** (R Norvall) which became briefly unbalanced with **ELGAR** losing ground as a result.

DESTROYER (M Sweeney) shifted outwards abruptly jumping away hampering **IMPULSION** (C Lammas), **LA CHICA** (A Jones) and **NEK MINNIT** (D Hain) with **IMPULSION** and **LA CHICA** losing ground.

PRINCE OF PATCH (B R Jones) was slow away after being fractious in the barriers.

BOMAYE (V Colgan) was slow away.

ELGAR over-raced when being restrained near the 1400 metres.

DOURO (L Cropp) was steadied near the 1400 metres going back on to **IMPULSION** which got its head up and shifted outwards abruptly when being restrained.

FULLFLIGHT (S McKay) over-raced in the early and middle stages bumping with **BIT OF CRUMPET** (S Collett), which was also racing keenly, on a number of occasions passing the 1100 metres.

LA CHICA raced three wide without cover.

PRINCE OF PATCH and **IMPULSION** were held up rounding the turn passing the 400 metres.

Following this race the track was downgraded to Dead(6).

Race 3 PEARSON ENGINEERING LIMITED 1200

The start of this race was put back two minutes at the request of TAB Control. The start was further delayed when **LOVE TO LUCIA** (U Holmquist) escaped riderless from the start galloping back to the parade ring area where it lost its footing and fell over being declared a late scratching at 1.36 pm. **LOVE TO LUCIA** was attended to by the course veterinarian and found to have sustained a fractured left shoulder blade necessitating the filly being humanely euthanased.

IN MEMORY OF (B R Jones) was very slow to begin (4L).

CHILI PEPPER (V Colgan) began awkwardly.

BEAMING (L Innes) began awkwardly shifting outwards making contact with **ELLE GRACE** (L Magorrian) which was briefly unbalanced.

MAGIC SPELL (M Wenn), STRONG IMPACT (L Satherley) and MISS ELEGANTE (A Jones) were all slow away.

DASHA (M Hills) began awkwardly and shifted inwards abruptly shortly after.

Shortly after jumping away **FLYING BRIAR** (L Cropp) shifted outwards abruptly away from **CHILI PEPPER** making contact with **MEZZALUNA** (S Collett) which became briefly unbalanced.

CHILI PEPPER over-raced in the early stages.

FLYING BRIAR raced three wide without cover.

BEAMING was held up approaching the 200 metres making contact with the hind quarters of **MAGIC SPELL** when disappointed for a run. **BEAMING** was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

MISS ELEGANTE was held up near the 150 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **BEAMING**. MISS ELEGANTE then shifted inwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 75 metres.

CLAREVILLE FLIGHT (C Lammas) shifted outwards under pressure hampering **MEZZALUNA** and **CHILI PEPPER** passing the 150 metres. C Lammas was issued with a warning.

ELLE GRACE lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 4 MATAMATA COMMERCIAL CLEANERS 1200

Trainer Ms D Guy was fined \$50 after presenting **GAULTIER** with incorrect gear.

GAULTIER (M Wenn) began awkwardly before being reluctant to hit out in the early stages losing considerable ground.

HANDS ORF (R Norvall) began awkwardly losing ground.

MISCONCEIVED (S McKay) began awkwardly.

GOSHAWK (C Lammas) shifted inwards jumping away inconveniencing NORTHERN STAR (M Sweeney).

HEAVEN CAN WAIT (S Collett), **STOLEN DANCE** (L Satherley) and **TWICKENHAM** (D Hain) all over-raced in the middle stages. **LEGNANI** (V Colgan) had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres when **FANTA AZTEC** (B Hutton) shifted inwards. B Hutton was issued with a warning. **LEGNANI** then over-raced when being restrained.

HEAVEN CAN WAIT raced ungenerously when having to be firmly restrained going into the 800 metre turn.

MISCONCEIVED raced wide without cover.

TWICKENHAM was not persevered with from the 400 metres with rider D Hain advising that the gelding had hung outwards before shortening stride rounding the turn. A post-race veterinary examination of **TWICKENHAM** did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

GOSHAWK lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Apprentice A Jones (BROWN GIRL) dropped her whip passing the 200 metres.

TAKE FIRE (L Innes) shifted outwards inconveniencing LEGNANI near the 150 metres.

Race 5 TIRAU VETERINARY CENTRE 1200

MATAATUA (C Lammas) began very awkwardly jumping in the air and losing ground.

SIERRA BEEL (V Colgan) was taken out by **ALUKA** (S McKay) leaving the barriers causing crowding to **O'REILLY'S GOLD** (A Jones) and **BONETE** (M Wenn). Contributing was **CHANEL NUMBER FIVE** (L Satherley) which jumped inwards.

PERIDOT (M Hills) raced wide without cover.

LESLIE'S LEGACY (R Smyth) was held up rounding the final turn, and was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight. **PERIDOT** lay in under pressure in the final straight with **SIERRA BEEL** being taken in by the runner placing **MATAATUA** in restricted room approaching the 100 metres. **MATAATUA** continued to race in tight quarters for the remainder of the race.

Race 6 MATAMATA POST & RAIL ITM 1400

DANZABEEL (L Innes) began awkwardly shifting outwards making firm contact with **TREVITA** (R Smyth).

ROCKING TO RIO (M Sweeney) stumbled badly on jumping losing ground.

CATARINA (B Hutton) began awkwardly losing ground.

DELUXE EDITION (A Jones) was slow away.

SHARP CHOICE (L Satherley) jumped away awkwardly.

SOUND PROPOSITION (B R Jones) over-raced badly in the early and middle stages on a moderate pace.

SONIC JET (V Colgan), **DANZABEEL** (L Innes), **HOT PROPERTY** (M Wenn), **ARPEGGIO** (C Lammas) and **SHARP CHOICE** all over-raced when the pace steadied further approaching the 1000 metres. Apprentice R Smyth (**TREVITA**) was advised that in future she must not ease the pace to a degree which puts other riders in difficulty.

TREVITA shifted inwards under pressure away from **SONIC JET** passing the 200 metres. After straightening her mount apprentice R Smyth again commenced to ride with the whip with **TREVITA** further shifting inwards into the line of **SHARP CHOICE** which had to steady to shift outwards across the heels of **TREVITA**. R Smyth was issued with a warning.

HOT PROPERTY lay in under pressure bumping **SOUND PROPOSITION** approaching the 100 metres.

Race 7 NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY CENTRE 1400

POPPAS DELIGHT (A Jones) began awkwardly losing ground, then hung outwards around the bend finishing wide out on the track. Stable representative Mrs V Hillis was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding for its racing manners

DARK AND STORMY (V Colgan) dipped crossing the junction on to the course proper near the 1200 metres.

Race 8 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

CORUNDUM (V Colgan) shifted outwards abruptly jumping away making contact with **STARS IN ALIGN** (S Collett).

LIBERTY HEIGHTS (M Wenn) shifted outwards away from **WHATWILLBEWILLBE** (U Holmquist) which had begun awkwardly hampering **SUZERAIN** (M Sweeney) which lost ground. Contributing was inward movement from **WORKS WONDERS** (L Satherley).

LIL MISS WAITOKI (C Lammas) raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

STARS IN ALIGN made contact with the hind quarters of **BRAMPTON LOCO** (B R Jones) when attempting to obtain clear running near the 300 metres. **STARS IN ALIGN** continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running, again making contact with **BRAMPTON LOCO** when attempting a marginal run to the inside of that runner near the 200 metres. **STARS IN ALIGN** then shifted inwards across heels obtaining clear running passing the 150 metres.

WORKS WONDERS shifted inwards under pressure inconveniencing PENTAROSE (A Jones) passing the 200 metres.

Race 9 BNZ PARTNERS 2000

WAZUNGU (R Norvall) was crowded on jumping away losing ground when runners to either side shifted ground.

Passing the 1900 metres **CHOYSA** (S Collett) shifted outwards away from **ESKABAR** (L Innes) making contact with **SAVABELLA ROSE** (L Magorrian).

WAZUNGU had to be firmly restrained off the heels of SOPHISTICATE (A Jones) near the 1700 metres.

TABLE ONE (M Hills) raced wide without cover.

WAZUNGU was steadied when racing in restricted room passing the 700 metres.

CHOYSA had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **ESKABAR** when weakening passing the 400 metres.

SAVABELLA ROSE shifted outwards under pressure inconveniencing **ESKABAR** near the 200 metres with **ESKABAR** then shifting away from **SAVABELLA ROSE**. L Magorrian was advised to exercise care.
