Race 1	OULAGHAN FAMILY DISTANCE (2200 metres)			
REYKJAVIK (J Rid	ddell) began awkwardly.			
PACIFIC BELLE (R Hannam) was slow to begin.			
PICCADILLY (S D	oyle) raced wide rounding the first turn.			
HAWKEYE CHIE	(B Lammas) raced three wide without cover from the 1400 metres.			
CARNATION (M	Cameron) commenced to give ground passing the 500 metres and finished well back. When			
questioned, ride	r M Cameron could offer no tangible excuse.			
REYKJAVIK was	briefly held up rounding the bend near the 400 metres.			
PICCADILLY shif	ted out under pressure near the 200 metres inconveniencing HEZANAKILAD (K Myers), which had to			
shift in across th	at runner's heels to improve.			
Race 2	TERRACE END BOWLING CLUB STAYERS (2100 metres)			

THATZ LOUIE (K Chiong) shifted out leaving the barriers hampering **HOT LIPS** (M Cameron) which lost ground. **POWELKA** (S Collett) began awkwardly and shifted out hampering **ITSALLBELT** (K Smith) which lost ground. **POWELKA** raced wide over the early stages until near the 1500 metres.

SAVAROSE (R Goldsbury) raced three wide without cover over the final 1400 metres.

THATZ LOUIE commenced to give ground near the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight. When questioned, apprentice rider K Chiong reported that the gelding had made a respiratory noise throughout the running and was of the opinion that there may be something amiss. Trainer A Davies subsequently advised Stewards that an endoscopic examination following the race revealed the gelding being rated a grade four roarer.

STAR EMERALD (L Magorrian) was held up when attempting a marginal run near the 200 metres.

HOT LIPS was held up momentarily near the 200 metres.

OOEE (J Riddell) was inclined to shift ground inwards under pressure over the final 100 metres.

Race 3 MCLEAN FARRIERY PARTNERSHIP SPRINT (1400 metres)

BORDEAUX (M Cameron) was a late scratching at 1:18pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barriers prior to the start and sustaining abrasions to the hind legs. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed against **BORDEAUX** with respect to its barriers manners.

BOUDICA (M Dravitzki) and PRINCESS SIENNA (L Magorrian) were very slow to begin.

Apprentice L Magorrian reported that **PRINCESS SIENNA** had made a respiratory noise throughout the running. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare failed to reveal any abnormality.

ROSE AND CROWN (R Hannam) was obliged to race wide throughout.

COTTA PIN (J Riddell) raced greenly throughout and was inclined to lug outwards rounding the turn.

RUNNY HONEY (K Myers) was briefly held up near the 250 metres.

Apprentice rider K Chiong could offer no tangible excuse for the performance of **ASTUTE.**

Race 4 THE MEAT COMPANY DANNEVIRKE DASH (1200 metres)

The tongue tie was unable to be applied to TALK THE TORQUE (M Dravitzki).

STORMY LASS (K Myers) was slow to begin.

ON THE HILL (R Goldsbury) raced three wide without cover throughout.

ELYSIUM (S Collett) shifted out entering the home straight momentarily inconveniencing **ON THE HILL**. Rider S Collett was advised to exercise care.

VEININSKY (K Smith) had to be steadied near the 200 metres when racing to the outside of **DR PAUL** (C O'Beirne) which shifted out. Apprentice rider C O'Beirne was advised to exercise care.

TINKA TINKA (J Parkes) lay out under pressure over the final 100 metres and had to be straightened.

When questioned into the disappointing run of **EQUANIMITY**, rider M Cameron could offer no tangible excuse however was of the opinion the mare may be better suited for a longer distance at this stage of its preparation.

Race 5 DAVID TIMMINS ELECTRICAL METRIC MILE (1600 metres)

HIGGS BOSON (R Goldsbury) was slow to begin.

NORTH OF SUNSET shied when negotiating the crossing near the 1450 metres severely unbalancing apprentice rider M Dee. As a consequence, **PERFECT MIX** (K Myers) which was trailing was severely checked, losing ground.

WIGGLE (D Turner) raced three wide without.

MALROSE (L Magorrian) had to be steadied near the 400 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **REVOLVE** (R Hannam).

BROADWALK (J Riddell) had to be steadied near the 350 metres when becoming awkwardly placed to the outside of **RIGHT ROYAL ROSE** (V Johnston) which shifted out under pressure. **BROADWALK** then had to be angled inwards to obtain clear running.

PERFECT MIX was inclined to lay inwards throughout the final straight with rider K Myers changing her whip into the left hand near the 200 metres to rectify the mare's tendency.

Race 6 DANNEVIRKE CLAY TARGET CLUB '1600' (1600 metres)

IMA TUI GIRL (R Hannam) and SEAWEED (S Doyle) were slow to begin.

SPARX raced wide in the early stages and when taken forward to lead commenced to over-race, with apprentice rider T Baker unable to restrain his mount.

JAZZ ROCK (R Myers) lay out when making the bend near the 400 metres, forcing **LADY LIKE** (M Cameron) outwards into the line of **MISS PROFESSIONAL** (K Myers) which became unbalanced.

SANJARA (V Johnston) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the early stages of the home straight until near the 100 metres.

ZIPIT (R Hannam) began awkwardly losing ground.

MYSTERY GIFT (D Turner) was slow to begin.

REFLECT (S Collett) raced wide without cover until near the 1000 metres.

INDOLLJENCE (S Doyle) had to be steadied near the 500 metres when improving up on to the heels of **FOXCUB** (M Dee). **INDOLLJENCE** was then held up until near the 300 metres.

Race 8

BAMBRY'S WATER TREADMILL SPRINT (1400 metres)

JACKSSTAR (S Doyle) was slow away.

LOOKHEREPAL (R Hannam) over-raced for a short distance when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

SAMOGON (M Dravitzki) raced three wide without cover throughout.

VIA DOLOROSA (S Collett) was inclined to hang out inwards in the home straight.

LOOKHEREPAL was held up early in the home straight prior to being angled outwards near the 250 metres to improve.

Race 9 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 metres)

TE HANA (R Myers) was slow to begin.

LET ME THINK (K Myers) was held up throughout the final straight and went to the line untested.

Over the final stages **SHOWSTOPPER** (J Riddell) when attempting a narrow run, bumped the hind quarters of **OLIVIA MARY** (T Kahlon). A short distance further **POSTER GIRL** (D Turner) shifted in abruptly under hard riding, which resulted in **OLIVIA MARY** again being hampered. After questioning riders and viewing footage, the incident was considered beyond the control of Apprentice D Turner.

Prior to the authorization of dividends, connections of the 3rd placed **SHOWSTOPPER** and the 5th placed **OLIVIA MARY** viewed coverage of the final stages with a view to protesting against the 2nd placed runner **POSTER GIRL** (D Turner), however elected not to proceed with an objection.

Race 10 DANNEVIRKE SERVICES AND CITIZENS CLUB DASH (1200 metres)

HONEY QUEEN (V Johnston) began awkwardly, losing ground.

PANTANA (C O'Beirne) over-raced in the early and middle stages when being restrained.

DIAMOND CUT (B Lammas) raced three wide without cover throughout.

Following the event it was reported that **DIAMOND CUT** had lost the off front plate during the running.
