## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>BNZ Partners 2200</b>
<p><b>NANCYLEE</b> (C Grylls) began awkwardly before being further hampered when <b>TOP CHOICE</b> (M Du Plessis) shifted inwards abruptly leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>PEACEFULEASYFEELIN</b> (N Harris) was slow away.</p> <p><b>NANCYLEE</b> raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 2000 metres getting its head up.</p> <p><b>FAIR FLEET</b> (U Holmquist) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of <b>BELLINO</b> (D Nolan) which shifted inwards near the 1900 metres. D Nolan was advised to exercise more care.</p> <p><b>SHOW THE WORLD</b> (O Bosson) shifted outwards to obtain clear running rounding the turn near the 400 metres being taken wider by <b>STELLA</b> (L Magorrian) which lay out resulting in <b>TOP CHOICE</b>, <b>HER TO ETERNITY</b> (D Johnson) and <b>NANCYLEE</b> all being forced wider on the track.</p> <p>Apprentice <b>L Magorrian</b> (STELLA) was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Franklin Long Roofing Ltd 1600</b>
<p><b>WISECRACK</b> (BR Jones) was slow away.</p> <p><b>THE MENACE</b> (S Collett) began awkwardly crowding <b>SAKHEE'S SOLDIER</b> (M Cameron).</p> <p><b>KING KROVANH</b> (M Du Plessis) got its head up for a distance when being restrained off the heels of <b>THE MENACE</b> near the 1400 metres.</p>	

**THE MENACE** over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.  
**SCINTILLULA** (M Coleman) raced wide without cover throughout.  
**SAKHEE'S SOLDIER** was held up rounding the final turn and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 250 metres. When shifting outwards to obtain clear running **SAKHEE'S SOLDIER** made contact with **CANDLE IN THE WIND** (R Hutchings).

**Race 3** | **Murdoch Newell Stakes**

**INFIRAAJ** (C Lammas) began awkwardly.  
**CINEMATIC** (M Du Plessis) and **SHE IS STRYKING** (M Coleman) came together on jumping away.  
**WINDBORNE** (M Cameron) began awkwardly, shifting inwards abruptly making contact with **SHE IS STRYKING**.  
**THWAYYA** (D Johnson) shifted inwards abruptly on jumping hampering **FASCINATE ME** (C Grylls) with **FASCINATE ME** making contact with **THE DARK KNIGHT** (H Tinsley) losing ground (3L).  
**BATTLE PLAN** (O Bosson) shifted outwards abruptly on jumping away.  
**WINDBORNE** over-raced when being restrained going into the bend near the 900 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **THWAYYA** and shifting outwards hampering **SHE IS STRYKING**. Forced over extra ground as a result was **THE DARK KNIGHT** which then raced three wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader approaching the 600 metres.  
**SHOWBOY** (L Innes) had a tendency to race greenly when under pressure in the final straight.  
**WINDBORNE** lay in placing **CINEMATIC** in restricted room passing the 200 metres.  
**FASCINATE ME** had to be steadied to shift outwards across the heels of the weakening **THE DARK KNIGHT** approaching the 100 metres.  
**WINDBORNE** lost the right front plate during the running.

**Race 4** | **Campbell Tyson 1600**

**ETONIAN** (L Cropp), **THEWAYYOURAVE** (C Lammas) and **INA JAM** (L Magorrian) were slow away.  
**THEWAYYOURAVE** got its head up when being restrained near the 1400 metres.  
**FIAMETTE** (M Cameron) raced keenly in the middle stages.  
**HARRY CLAASSEN** (BR Jones) raced wide without cover.  
**M Coleman** admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted his mount **HILLSBOROUGH** to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of **REBEL ROSE** (D Nolan) which was forced inwards on to **PERFECT ROSE** (U Holmquist) which was checked near the 300 metres. After hearing submissions M Coleman was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 26 November 2014 up to and including racing on Wednesday 3 December 2014, 4 riding days.  
**ETONIAN** had some difficulty obtaining clear running inside the final 250 metres.  
**REBEL ROSE** lay out making contact with **ITSFORFREE** (R Myers) passing the 50 metres.  
**CAILEAG** (K Joyce) returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following an endoscopic examination **CAILEAG** was confirmed as a bleeder, now being subject to the mandatory three month stand down with a veterinary clearance then required prior to trialing or racing next.  
O Bosson, the rider of **BLACKJACK MAN**, reported that his mount had a tendency to hang during the running.

**Race 5** | **H R Fiske & Sons Ltd 1400**

**MANGAROA MINI** (M Cameron) was removed from the barriers after being fractious and declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.52pm after suffering minor lacerations to both hind legs. **MANGAROA MINI** was found to be in season.  
The barrier gate on **BIGGIN HILL** (D Nolan) was slow to open. Due to **BIGGIN HILL** finishing in third placing under the provisions of Rule 632 no further action could be taken.  
**ELUSIVE GOLD** (O Bosson) jumped in the air as the start was affected, losing ground.  
**MONEYTREE** (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly, making contact with the side of its barrier stall.  
**MONEYTREE** had to be steadied near the 1200 metres when crowded for room to the inside of **LE CHOIX** (V Colgan) which was taken in by **FLUORO LITE** (B Hutton) which shifted in and away from **BEYOND DESIRE** (S Collett).

**Race 6** | **NRM / Auckland Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes**

**PUSSY O'REILLY** (O Bosson) began awkwardly, losing ground. On viewing video footage immediately after the race it was apparent that the barrier gate on **PUSSY O'REILLY** had been slow to open. A request for a ruling was filed with the Judicial Committee who determined that **PUSSY O'REILLY**, which had finished in 4<sup>th</sup> placing, had been denied a fair start and declaring the mare to be a non-starter with all bets on that runner to be refunded.  
**NEEDLILY** (C Lammas) was slow away.  
**QUEENS ROSE** (N Harris) was steadied passing the 1200 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of **MISS PELEAR** (M Cameron). M Cameron was advised to exercise more care.  
**MOOZON** (M Sweeney), which was racing keenly, raced wide without cover until near the 700 metres.  
Following the race **MOOCHI ME** was found to have bled from both nostrils and now faces the mandatory three month stand down period with a veterinary clearance then required prior to racing or trialing.  
When questioned regarding the performance of **THE FILLY** rider M Hills was unable to offer any tangible excuse other than the mare possibly being better suited by some easing of the ground. A post race veterinary examination found the mare to have been galloped on to the near hind leg.

A post race veterinary examination of <b>FIX</b> did not reveal any abnormality.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>Vernon &amp; Vazey Truck Parts Ltd 1600</b>
<p><b>SHOW NO EMOTION</b> (M Cameron) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SULTRY ASSASSIN</b> (M Du Plessis) shifted inwards abruptly on jumping away making contact with <b>CURIOUS</b> (D Johnson) forcing that runner in on to <b>THEE ACHIEVER</b> (C Grylls) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>NORDIC KNIGHT</b> (N Harris) began awkwardly hampering <b>JAGERSFONTEIN</b> (R Myers) and <b>SECRET WHISPER</b> (B Hutton).</p> <p><b>VEGAS NIGHT</b> (M Coleman) lay in shortly after jumping away further hampering <b>NORDIC KNIGHT</b>, <b>JAGERSFONTEIN</b> and <b>SECRET WHISPER</b>.</p> <p><b>CURIOUS</b> over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>SULTRY ASSASSIN</b> raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>CASINO PARK</b> (L Magorrian) lay in placing <b>ENDORSEMENT</b> (M Hills) in restricted room near the 700 metres with <b>ENDORSEMENT</b> having to be steadied losing ground. L Magorrian was issued with a warning.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>Chep Pallecon Solutions Counties Cup</b>
<p><b>LITTLE ALFIE BROWN</b> (L Satherley) began awkwardly hampering <b>COACHLINE</b> (O Bosson), <b>DECORAH</b> (D Johnson) and <b>DELAGO'S SECRET</b> (M Du Plessis) with <b>DECORAH</b> and <b>DELAGO'S SECRET</b> being the worst affected, losing ground.</p> <p><b>LADY LE FAY</b> (S Collett) was slow away.</p> <p><b>COACHLINE</b> raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>LION RED</b> (R Myers) made contact with <b>COACHLINE</b> on two occasions near the 600 metres when attempting to shift outwards. R Myers was advised to exercise care.</p> <p><b>DELAGO'S SECRET</b> had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>NOBLE WARRIOR</b> (R Norvall) shifted outwards under pressure inconveniencing <b>NOTHING TRIVIAL</b> (BR Jones) near the 50 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>IMG Counties Bowl</b>
<p>Trainer <b>N Tiley</b> was fined \$50 after presenting <b>RICH'N UNHITCHED</b> with incorrect gear.</p> <p><b>TIME AFTER TIME</b> (M Hills) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MOSSE</b> (N Harris) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of <b>RICH'N UNHITCHED</b> (L Innes) which shifted inwards passing the 1000 metres. L Innes was issued with a warning and advised to ensure that he is fully clear when shifting ground in future.</p> <p><b>MOSSE</b> then commenced to over-race badly approaching the 900 metres, racing ungenerously through the middle stages forcing <b>CIVICS ROCK</b> (O Bosson) over extra ground near the 850 metres when making the bend awkwardly.</p> <p><b>DURHAM TOWN</b> (V Colgan) over-raced in the middle stages having to be firmly restrained, shifting outwards to avoid the heels of <b>HANNAH MARY</b> (S Collett) near the 700 metres. <b>DURHAM TOWN</b> then continued to race fiercely for a distance.</p> <p><b>TIME AFTER TIME</b> had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p> <p><b>HANNAH MARY</b> which had been attempting to improve into a marginal run to the inside of <b>RUUD AWAKENING</b> (D Johnson) was briefly crowded when <b>RUUD AWAKENING</b> lay in near the 250 metres before being corrected by its rider.</p> <p><b>HANNAH MARY</b> was then angled outwards across the heels of <b>RUUD AWAKENING</b>. Prior to the authorisation of dividends the connections of <b>HANNAH MARY</b> (4<sup>th</sup>) viewed Stewards' footage with a view to lodging an objection against <b>RUUD AWAKENING</b> (2nd) but elected not to proceed.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>Brokerweb Risk Services 1400</b>
<p><b>CHARLIE FARLEY</b> underwent a pre race veterinary examination after sustaining an abrasion to its head when being transported to the races being passed fit to run.</p> <p><b>MASSALE</b> (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly, shifting in dictating <b>CIVETTA</b> (S Collett) inwards making contact with the hind quarters of <b>DUFELLFORTE</b> (O Bosson) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>PICO TURQUINO</b> (L Innes) began awkwardly and shifting inwards with <b>PRINCESS MICHELLA</b> shifting away from that runner crowding <b>PACE SETTER</b> (V Colgan) which was hampered for a distance making contact with the hind quarters of <b>SHEBANG</b> (M Cameron) which became unbalanced.</p> <p><b>ARROW IN THE SAND</b> (M Coleman) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>BITETHEBULLET</b> (R Hutchings) was slow away.</p> <p><b>DUFELLFORTE</b> was restrained to avoid the heels of <b>CIVETTA</b> approaching the 1200 metres when that runner shifted inwards when not fully clear. S Collett was advised to exercise more care.</p> <p><b>CHARLIE FARLEY</b> (H Tinsley), <b>PRINCESS MICHELLA</b>, <b>GARDONE</b> (C Lammass), <b>DUFELLFORTE</b>, <b>PICO TURQUINO</b>, <b>PACE SETTER</b> and <b>SHEBANG</b> all over-raced in the middle stages when the pace eased.</p> <p><b>BOB VALDEZ</b> (B Hutton) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>MASSALE</b> shifted outwards slightly under pressure passing the 300 metres dictating <b>GERRY MERITO</b> (L Magorrian) outwards crowding <b>CIVETTA</b> on to <b>BOB VALDEZ</b>.</p> <p><b>HEEZA DREIMER</b> (R Myers) was held up when disappointed for a run to the inside of <b>CHARLIE FARLEY</b> approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>Following the race <b>SHEBANG</b> required veterinary treatment for lacerations to the hind legs where it had been galloped on.</p>
