## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>LADY KINTYRE'S LEGACY LIVES ON</b>
Mr W Carter was fined \$50 for presenting <b>SINO HEIGHTS</b> to race without notified gear being pacifiers. <b>COMMENT</b> (U Holmquist), <b>SEA OCTOPUS</b> (S Collett) and <b>CRUCIAL</b> (K Myers) were slow away. <b>LOUVRES</b> (L Magorrian) raced three wide without cover. <b>DASHA</b> (M Hills) raced in restricted room passing the 600 metres to the inside of <b>LOUVRES</b> . Near the 350 metres <b>FLYING BRIAR</b> (L Cropp) was held up having to steady and shift out to obtain clear running taking <b>MISCONCEIVED</b> (B R Jones) over extra ground. Jockey B R Jones then elected to shift in across the heels of <b>FLYING BRIAR</b> near the 250 metres, and was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight. L Cropp was issued with a warning. When questioned into the disappointing performance of the favourite <b>SPARKLING SWORD</b> rider M Sweeney advised that	

after beginning well was out-paced in the early stages settling back and when placed under pressure failed to respond. M Sweeney advised that the mare may be feeling the effects of the firmer track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>BUCK'S SPORTS BAR &amp; GRILL 1400</b>
<p><b>MIZ OLDFIELDS ROAD</b> (V Colgan) became fractious in the barriers, rearing and turning around becoming cast over the back gate for some time before being freed. <b>MIZ OLDFIELDS ROAD</b> was declared a late scratching at 12.42 pm. A stable representative was advised that the filly would be required to barrier trial satisfactorily prior to racing again.</p> <p><b>KEEPING TOM</b> (N Harris) and <b>TWILIGHT OFFER</b> (M Du Plessis) both began awkwardly crowding <b>OPERATIC RESCUE</b> (L Innes) and <b>BUFF THE DIAMOND</b> (M Hills). As a result both <b>BUFF THE DIAMOND</b> and <b>TWILIGHT OFFER</b> lost ground.</p> <p><b>SOLO</b> (S Collett) was hampered leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>KEEPING TOM</b> got its head up when being restrained passing the 1150 metres, and continued to over-race for a distance.</p> <p><b>TWILIGHT OFFER</b> lost the near front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>TE AWAMUTU PLUMBING &amp; DRAINAGE 1580</b>
<p><b>ROGART</b> (M Hills) lay in leaving the barriers hampering <b>TAKE FIRE</b> (L Innes) which lost ground.</p> <p><b>TOP DRIVE</b> (L Magorrian) began awkwardly with its rider becoming unbalanced.</p> <p><b>ALI</b> (B R Jones) shifted out jumping away bumping <b>IDAHO'S CHOICE</b> (M Du Plessis).</p> <p>Just prior to the crossing <b>PINZ CHARMING</b> (M Sweeney) when racing greenly shifted out making contact with <b>CARMEN SANDIEGO</b> (V Colgan) which had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>TINGED WITH GOLD</b> (R Hutchings). <b>CARMEN SANDIEGO</b> then over-raced for a short distance.</p> <p><b>LOTTI O'REILLY</b> (A Jones) made the crossing shortly after the start awkwardly.</p> <p><b>IDAHO'S CHOICE</b> hung out around the bend near the 1100 metres taking <b>PINZ CHARMING</b> wider on the track.</p> <p><b>LOTTI O'REILLY</b> over-raced in the early stages making the bend awkwardly near the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>TUKAWA</b> (D Johnson) was held up between the 400 and 200 metres before obtaining clear running.</p> <p>Approaching the 200 metres <b>CARMEN SANDIEGO</b> had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>ALI</b> which was taken out by <b>TAKE FIRE</b> which was shifting out to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>PINZ CHARMING</b> after racing greenly in the early and middle stages became tailed off and was not persevered with over the concluding stages. Jockey M Sweeney could offer no further explanation. Trainer Mr J Pender advised that the gelding was unsuited by the firmer track conditions, and that it will now be spelled.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>FARRELLY CALF REARING 2000</b>
<p><b>KATY O'BEEL</b> (N Harris) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>BOMAYE</b> (L Magorrian) and <b>CORUNDUM</b> (D Johnson) were both slow away.</p> <p><b>LOOK WHOS ASKING</b> (S Spratt) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>NEK MINNIT</b> (L Cropp) shifted out to obtain clear running rounding the final turn near the 250 metres crowding <b>MONGOLIAN HERO</b> (V Colgan) on to <b>TASHA AIMEE</b> (M Cameron).</p> <p>R Hutchings the rider of <b>ALEZAN</b> was issued with a warning over the use of his whip.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CRAIG'S TAKEAWAYS @ WHANGAMATA 2000</b>
<p><b>MYSTIC MAN</b> (M Wenn) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MALACHY LAD</b> (C Grylls) shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barriers hampering <b>QUICKASUCAN</b> (M Hills).</p> <p><b>DREIMS OF GOLD</b> (M Du Plessis) and <b>I'M ALL YOURS</b> (M Cameron) both began awkwardly crowding <b>MR TOOGOOD</b> (L Magorrian) and <b>FAIRY STORY</b> (S Spratt) which both lost ground.</p> <p><b>MYSTIC MAN</b> over-raced when being restrained near the 1700 metres.</p> <p>Near the 1600 metres <b>MALACHY LAD</b> when racing ungenerously shifted out leaving the straight, and when being corrected shifted into the line of <b>CALL THE SHOTS</b> (S Collett) which had to be steadied.</p> <p><b>ONE O EIGHT</b> (M Sweeney) raced wide through the early stages.</p> <p><b>TOKOMUTU JUDGE</b> (J Oliver) was held up for a short distance rounding the bend into the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>BOXING DAY @ PIRONGIA 1580</b>
<p><b>THE SHACKLER</b> (L Magorrian) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>RODDICK</b> (M Du Plessis) knuckled on jumping away.</p> <p><b>TORRICELLA</b> (R Hutchings) shifted in on jumping away making contact with <b>MIHAIA</b> (D Johnson) with that runner shifting in bumping <b>MISS FOXWOOD</b> (V Colgan) which became briefly unbalanced. <b>MISS FOXWOOD</b> then lay out making contact with <b>MIHAIA</b> for a short distance.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>STEPHEN MARSH RACING STABLES 1400</b>
<p><b>VICTOR HUGO</b> (M Cameron) was slow away.</p> <p><b>SEREIN</b> (L Magorrian) knuckled jumping away.</p> <p><b>BHIWANI</b> (V Colgan) had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>STEFFI'S SECRET</b> (U Holmquist) shifted outwards to obtain clear running approaching the 100 metres inconveniencing <b>SEREIN</b>.</p>	

S Spratt reported that her mount <b>SATANICO</b> was feeling the effects of the firmer track conditions.	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>BLAIR THOMSON FAREWELL 1400</b>
<p><b>DIAMOND EDGE</b> (M Cameron) was slow away.</p> <p><b>LABELS</b> (R Hutchings) began a little awkwardly before being further hampered when crowded by <b>WAYNE</b> (S Collett) which was taken in by <b>BACK ON SONG</b> (L Magorrian).</p> <p>Near the 1200 metres <b>DIAMOND THORN</b> (J Robinson) shifted out slightly with <b>IMPY LUIS</b> (V Colgan) having to shift out abruptly off that runner's heels taking <b>DIAMOND EDGE</b> wider on the track.</p> <p><b>CHOCOLAT</b> (M Sweeney) was obliged to race wide throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 400 metres <b>MIA'S CHOICE</b> (D Johnson) had to shift out off the heels of the weakening <b>CHOCOLAT</b>.</p> <p><b>ATTENTION SEEKER</b> (C Grylls) lay out throughout, and made the final bend awkwardly.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>BAKER FORSMAN RACING STABLES 1150</b>
<p><b>PINZANO</b> (S Spratt) broke through the front of its barrier stall. <b>PINZANO</b> was quickly brought under control by its rider and returned to the start where it was declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 4.48 pm.</p> <p><b>MANIKYA</b> (B Hutton), <b>MATAATUA</b> (C Grylls) and <b>SECRET POWER</b> (M McNab) were all slow away.</p> <p><b>REPULSE BAY</b> (M Wenn) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>MANIKYA</b> was held up rounding the final turn, and had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>ALUKA</b> (J Oliver) near the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>SECRET POWER</b> (M McNab) lay in rounding the final bend becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>REPULSE BAY</b> (V Colgan).</p> <p><b>ADRENALINE RUSH</b> (Z Moki) was held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight before improving into a tight run which presented to the inside of <b>BONETE</b> near the 150 metres.</p>
