### **RACE COMMENTS:**

## Race 1 RACE IMAGES – FOR WINNING MEMORIES 1600

**BROTHER BAM BAM** (C Studd) began awkwardly, losing ground.

MAX A MISS (R Cole) over-raced in the early stages, and then raced wide for the remainder of the race.

**LEIF ERIKSON** (T Harris) made the bend awkwardly passing the 950 metres, shifting out, making contact with **MAX A MISS**.

Rider A Kuru reported that FLYING BRIAR had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

## Race 2 VERO INSURANCE 3YO

After becoming fractious in the barriers **OFFSPRING** (J Oliver) was removed and underwent a veterinary inspection, being initially cleared fit to race. After being re-loaded **OFFSPRING** was again removed and declared a late scratching at 1.10 pm on veterinary advice as the filly had commenced to bleed significantly from a laceration in the nostril.

MAREEBA (S Collett) shifted in abruptly leaving the barrier, hampering RYKER (M McNab) which lost ground.

KIDDO (U Holmquist) was slow away.

**TREVITA** (R Smyth) commenced to hang out around the bend near the 800 metres, and then raced wide for the remainder of the race.

RYKER was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight having to be corrected by its rider several times.

Jockey L Innes reported that **OUR MYSTERE** had made abnormal breathing noises. **OUR MYSTERE** underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which found the filly to have a respiratory condition which affected air flow causing reduced performance. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required before **OUR MYSTERE** races next.

## Race 3 PARAMOUNT HIRE GROUP HWT

THE KAKAHU EXPRESS (D Miller) began awkwardly, making contact with JACK ROMANOV (M Mitchell).

BIXBY (C Studd) raced wide without cover in the early stages.

Approaching the 1700 metres **BIXBY** shifted in, crowding **BAHHTON** (E Farr) which had to steady. Rider C Studd was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on his record. Contributing was slight outward movement from **THE KAKAHU EXPRESS**.

**BAHHTON** raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

### Race 4 WILL JOHNSON-9 TO 3 ON THE HITS 1200

**ALMIGHTY SUN** (L Magorrian) began awkwardly, shifting in, with **OUR IFFRAAJ** (J Oliver) shifting away from that runner causing crowding to **ENURE** (R Smyth) and **ISHARA YAR** (D Johnson) which made contact with **POWER STAR** (S McKay) which became briefly unbalanced.

PINTEREST (S Collett) and PINZ CHARMING (M McNab) both began awkwardly, losing ground.

Passing the 1000 metres **OUR IFFRAAJ** and **ENURE** both raced in restricted room to the inside of **ALMIGHTY SUN** which then shifted in slightly. **OUR IFFRAAJ** then lay in further, away from **ALMIGHTY SUN** further crowding **ENURE** which was steadied. L Magorrian was issued with a warning. Contributing was outward movement from **ISHARA YAR** which made the bend awkwardly. **ISHARA YAR** then raced ungenerously for a distance.

POWER STAR also made the 900 metre bend awkwardly.

### Race 5 TAURANGA HARDWARE & PLUMBING 1400

**BELLE DUCHESSE** (M Du Plessis) had to steady shortly after jumping away when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **JESDEMONA** (P Holmes) which shifted out.

**LEICA DREIM** (A Collett) had to be steadied shortly after jumping away when awkwardly placed on the heels of **REBEL ROSE** (D Johnson).

**JESDEMONA** over-raced in the early stages having to be steadied off the heels of **EKSUUDE** (R Hutchings) for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

# Race 6 ULTIMATE MOTOR GROUP 1200

YSABELLA BRAVE (U Holmquist) began awkwardly, shifting in, with **DEAGON** (M Du Plessis) shifting away from that runner, losing ground.

AMBER RAYNE (R Smyth) began awkwardly.

NIGHEAN (A Collett) had to steady when crowded shortly after leaving the barrier.

When making the bend passing the 800 metres I'M BRONSON (S McKay), NECTACOLECTA (L Magorrian) and DOIKNOWYOU (M McNab) all raced in restricted room between SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS (P Holmes) and STRALIS (D Johnson) both of which shifted ground.

Passing the 300 metres **STRALIS** lay in when placed under pressure, making contact with **DOIKNOWYOU** which became unbalanced and then made contact with the hind quarters of **YSABELLA BRAVE** which also became unbalanced.

**DEAGON** which was not persevered with in the home straight, underwent a veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

When questioned regarding the performance of **KEEPING TOM** rider A Jones advised that she had got further back than intended and had been unable to recover.

### Race 7 STEWART BROWNE ELECTRICAL 1400

**CELTIC CHIEF** (U Holmquist) had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed near the 400 metres.

Apprentice riders R Hutchings (BACK ON SONG) and L Magorrian (MR KANTON) were both reminded of their obligations when riding out to the finish of a race when circumstances permit them to do so.

## Race 8 AZTECH SIGNS TAURANGA 1400

**GREEN EASY** (S Collett) began awkwardly losing ground.

**TEGWIN** (B Hutton) was slow away (3L).
