MISS PARETO (K Myers) was slow away.				
THERAPY (A Collett) jumped away awkwardly.				
ALL ROADS (S Collett) raced ungenerously when being restrained to avoid the heels of UP ON THE ROOF (M Cameron)				
going into the bend near the 800 metres.				
<b>PROCRASTINATE</b> (M Du Plessis) was held up when disappointed for a run to the inside of <b>YEAH BRO</b> (C Grylls) near the 250				
metres. <b>PROCRASTINATE</b> then shifted outwards across heels to obtain clear running approaching the 100 metres.				
ALL ROADS had a tendency to lay in in the final straight.				
Race 2	Kumara Capital Mdn 1000			
ATUA (M Du Plessis) and PLAYBOY PRINCE (R Norvall) were slow away.				
ROCK MY SOUL (P Holmes) jumped away awkwardly.				
PLAYBOY PRINCE hung outwards throughout.				
SIAN (C Grylls) raced three wide without cover throughout.				
ROCK MY SOUL had to be steadied after improving on to the heels of JET FIGHTER (A Collett) approaching the 400 metres.				
ROCK MY SOUL made contact with JET FIGHTER when improving into a tight run near the 300 metres. SIAN then shifted				
outwards away from JET FIGHTER with PLAYBOY PRINCE, HAPI GIRL (M Cameron) and ATUA all being taken wider as a				

result. Race 3 Dargaville Museum Rating 65 1800 NIGHTSHIFT (J Oliver) was slow away. EMMUSKA (R Smyth) shifted outwards when jumping away crowding ALPHABET STREET (A Schwerin) on to DESTERRO (M Du Plessis), SPEEDY JAX (C Grylls) and BACHELOR BRAVE (A Collett). EMMUSKA hung outwards around the bend leaving the straight on the first occasion taking ALPHABET STREET and SHARPSHOOTER (A Jones) wider on the track. ALPHABET STREET over-raced in the middle stages and was in restricted room to the inside of EMMUSKA approaching the 800 metres with EMMUSKA having to be steadied briefly when awkwardly placed on the heels of WEST END (D Nolan) which was improving forward. **SHARPSHOOTER** raced wide without cover throughout. **SPEEDY JAX** was held up for a distance passing the 450 metres and early in the final straight. SOPRAFFINA (S Collett) lay in passing the 300 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of IN A MINUTE (K Myers) having to be steadied. **SNOW SECRET** (L Innes) lay in under pressure in the final straight. Lion Red 3YO Mdn 1000 Race 4 ALL THE ANSWERS (M Du Plessis) was slow to begin. BELLA MOSSA dropped its head as the gates were opening, then jumped away very awkwardly, rearing and throwing its head in the air striking Rider C Grylls in the face. BELLA MOSSA continued to race ungenerously in the early stages losing several lengths. BELLA MOSSA will be required to trial satisfactorily prior to racing next. THREE ELEVENS (A Collett) reared at the start and began awkwardly. **IDEAL ME** (A Schwerin) began awkwardly making solid contact with **ALL DRESSED UP** (K Myers) which was hampered. BELLA MOSSA continued to race ungenerously approaching the bend near the 800 metres. ALL THE ANSWERS made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly shifting outwards across the heels of FORTIUS (S Collett) having to be steadied. Race 5 McKay Electrical Dargaville Rating 65 1400 **GOLDEN DOWNS** (S McKay) was slow to begin. **MISTER TOM** (L Innes) and **PACHENKO** (A Jones) both began awkwardly. STOLE MY THUNDER (C Grylls) was inclined to over-race in the lead through the early and middle stages. FLICKA OF GOLD (A Collett) was held up until near the 250 metres having to shift out across heels to obtain clear running. **RIVER RAIDER** (Z Moki) shifted out under pressure approaching the 250 metres taking **GOTTA KEEPER** (M Cameron) wider on the track. **RIVER RAIDER** then continued to lay out under pressure for the remainder of the race. Northern Wairoa Golf Club Dargaville Mdn 2000 Race 6 LIKEWISE (J Oliver) was slow away. **PLENTEOUS** (P Holmes) was hampered when crowded shortly after the start losing ground. LIKEWISE went off stride when attempting to jump a dark patch of grass approximately 100 metres after the start and then raced wide for the remainder of the race. A PERTE DE VUE (Z Moki) had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of CHAMPAGNE ARGONNE (D Nolan) which shifted in near the 1800 metres. TWILIGHT OFFER (M Du Plessis) got its head up making the bend awkwardly when leaving the straight on the first occasion. CITY EXPRESS (C Grylls) had to be firmly restrained off the heels of BAHRELLA (A Jones) near the 1500 metres. FROCK (M Cameron) shifted out off the heels of MONTIGO (L Innes) dictating A PERTE DE VUE out on to LIKEWISE passing the 600 metres. LIKEWISE again attempted to jump the same patch of grass in the final straight and was not persevered with for the remainder of the race. A PERTE DE VUE lay out around the bend near the 350 metres making contact with LIKEWISE. SUZERAIN (A Collett) had to shift in off the heels of BAHRELLA to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres. Tane Mahuta Rating 65 1200 Race 7 **CELTIC BOY** (M Du Plessis) was slow to begin. When being steadied approaching the 1000 metres ROCK ROYALTY (L Magorrian) made slight contact with JUST THE DEAL (A Jones) then shifted inwards away from that runner bumping PARISIENNE JEWEL (M Cameron). **OVERNIGHTSENSATION** (A Collett) raced three wide without cover. **ROCK ROYALTY** was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight and was eased down over the final 100 metres when well beaten. Rider L Magorrian advised the filly had raced greenly amongst other horses during the running and had felt a little indifferent in its action after changing legs late in the race. A post race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 8 Polwarth Design Mdn 1400

Following his ride in Race 6 **D Nolan** advised that he was feeling unwell and after being examined by the Course Doctor was stood down from his remaining ride and was replaced by P Holmes on **BOOTYFUL**.

SUPER READY (M Cameron) blundered leaving the barriers.

**HANDSOME WARRIOR** (G Cooksley) was slow away. **HANDSOME WARRIOR** then settled a clear last losing contact with the body of the field towards the end of the back straight and was not persevered with from near the 800 metres. Rider G Cooksley stated that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action and failed to hit out freely. A post race veterinary examination found the gelding to be lame in the left fore fetlock. Trainer D Wiles was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to **HANDSOME WARRIOR** racing again.

LONG HARBOUR (A Collett) began awkwardly.

SECLUDED (M Du Plessis) raced three wide without cover.

LONG HARBOUR had to be steadied to avoid the heels of QUICK ANSWER (C Grylls) near the 850 metres.

**RIVERDEEP** (L Innes) lay out under pressure over the final 100 metres with **FINNS HALO** (R Norvall) shifting away from that runner over the concluding stages.
