RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TE AWAMUTU COURIER 1150
<p>LEICA DREIM (C Barnes) was slow to begin, and was further hampered when MY SMILEY O'REILLY (B Hutton) shifted out when leaving the barrier.</p> <p>Near the 1000 metres CARUSO (V Gatu) got its head up when being firmly restrained shifting out across the heels of MY SMILEY O'REILLY (B Hutton).</p> <p>CAPISTRANO PEARL (J Oliver) lay out around the bend passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>JESSICOVA (R Smyth) had to shift out off the heels of the weakening MY SMILEY O'REILLY to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of the favourite HOLD THE PHONE rider R Hutchings advised the Stewards that the gelding had sweated up badly prior to the start which in his opinion had been detrimental to its chances.</p>	
Race 2	STEWART ALEXANDER GOLF 1150
<p>FLORENCE IN FRANCE (R Smyth) after getting a leg over the front of the starting stalls underwent a veterinary examination and was cleared to race.</p> <p>FLORENCE IN FRANCE was slow to begin.</p> <p>OBLIVION (S McKay) had to be steadied shortly after jumping away to avoid the heels of MACEDON (R Hutchings).</p> <p>LADDIE OF OAKVIEW (L Magorrian) shifted out passing the 950 metres making contact with MACEDON.</p> <p>DINAH LEE (C Barnes) had to steady near the 800 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of MACEDON.</p>	

<p>LADDIE OF OAKVIEW made the bend near the 600 metres awkwardly when racing keenly.</p> <p>SUPERMATIC (M Dravitzki) shifted out passing the 400 metres making contact with MACEDON and became briefly unbalanced.</p>	
Race 3	TE ATA RESTHOME 1400
<p>LOUVRES (Z Moki) and ROCKTOBER (S McKay) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>LOUVRES got its head up making the bend near the 1150 metres awkwardly, and then continued to over-race through the middle stages.</p> <p>ROCKTOBER got its head up when being steadied off heels passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p>LOUVRES raced in restricted room over the concluding stages to the inside of WHAT'S UP ALF (C Barnes). Rider C Barnes was advised of her obligations when riding her mounts out over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 4	TIMMO ITM 2000
<p>LE MOUSSIER (L Magorrian) raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>CRIMSON PRINCE (R Hutchings) lay out around the bend near the 1500 metres.</p> <p>THATZ IT (R Goldsbury) raced wide for the majority of the race, and in particular very wide through the middle stages for no apparent reason. When questioned regarding her ride apprentice Goldsbury stated that the gelding had felt uncomfortable with the turning nature of the track. Notwithstanding Miss Goldsbury's explanation she was advised that the Stewards would expect her to ride in a more competitive manner in future.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of CRIMSON PRINCE, which was not persevered with over the final 200 metres, rider R Hutchings advised the gelding found today's track conditions too firm.</p> <p>TOKOMUTU JUDGE (J Oliver) was briefly held up passing the 300 metres having to shift out across the heels of FAST PROFIT (A Collett) to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 5	KELLY & BRYANT CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1580
<p>Shortly after the start CAPISTRANO MAGIC (J Oliver) shifted in placing MAHARISHI (V Gatu) in restricted room for a short distance.</p> <p>WAIPIPI LAD (B Hutton) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>GOODN'TARG (L Magorrian) made contact with the running rail passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>CAPISTRANO MAGIC raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>WAIPIPI LAD (B Hutton) shifted in passing the 50 metres making contact with GOODSPEED (R Goldsbury).</p> <p>CAPISTRANO MAGIC broke down shortly after the finish and was humanely euthanased having fractured the left hind leg.</p>	
Race 6	NIGEL PITCON AUTO ELECTRICAL 1580
<p>SILVERADO (S McKay) was slow away.</p> <p>SUZERAIN (L Magorrian) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with the hind quarters of MINGS GIRL (C Barnes) and shifted back out on to the heels of SHIMMY (R Hutchings) which had shifted in abruptly clipping a heel and blundering.</p> <p>SILVERADO over-raced through the middle stages.</p> <p>Near the 400 metres SINGLE SHOT (V Gatu) lay in and when being corrected shifted out with CHAPRISE (A Collett) improving to its inside. Apprentice Gatu was shown video footage of the incident.</p> <p>SINGLE SHOT and CHAPRISE came together on at least three occasions in the final straight.</p>	
Race 7	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1400
<p>SOUL SISTA (R Hutchings) and FLYING BRIAR (B Hutton) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>SISTERHOOD (J Oliver) over-raced through the middle stages.</p> <p>SOUL SISTA lay in under pressure in the final straight making contact with SISTERHOOD near the 200 metres, and again near the 150 metres. Rider R Hutchings was reminded of his obligations when riding his mount out in the final straight.</p> <p>L Magorrian the rider of NABBED was spoken to regarding his whip use in the final straight.</p>	
Race 8	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1150
<p>REPULSE BAY (M Dravitzki) began awkwardly.</p> <p>SHEBANG (J Oliver) had to steady shortly after the start when awkwardly placed on the heels of SHESELUSIVE (R Hutchings).</p> <p>MARGARET ANN (A Collett) had to be firmly restrained for a distance when awkwardly placed on heels when the pace steadied passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>REPULSE BAY got its head up when being restrained off the heels of LADY JAY (A Schwerin) passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>REPULSE BAY was held up for clear running passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>The siren was sounded instigating a protest lodged by the connections of the third place horse SHESELUSIVE against the first placed horse LADY JAY alleging interference near the 100 metres. After hearing submissions from the</p>	

connections of both runners and viewing all relevant videos the protest was dismissed. Rider A Schwerin was advised to exercise care when riding her mount out in the final straight.
