RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	AEROSPREAD SPRINT (1400 metres)
<p>POPPAS DELIGHT was slow to begin and then lost further ground when inclined to hang outwards in the early stages.</p> <p>PADDY OWEN began awkwardly.</p> <p>MANU was inclined to hang outwards when over-racing in the lead throughout.</p> <p>BLATHWAYT was held up entering the home straight and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 400 metres, bumped with DANCER'S TALE.</p> <p>PADDY OWEN was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of DANCER'S TALE, which failed to finish the race off as expected, rider L Allpress was of the opinion the mare may be better suited to 1200 metres.</p>	
Race 2	CHB ANGUS BREEDERS MAIDEN MILE (1600 metres)
<p>KINGIESSTAR was slow to begin.</p> <p>BANTENEIGHTY commenced to over-race in the early stages and then made the bend near the 1300 metres awkwardly.</p> <p>CRYSTAL SECRET was inclined to lay in under pressure throughout the final straight and had to be continually straightened.</p>	
Race 3	BEL GROUP / BEN ALLEN TRANSPORT MAIDEN SPRINT (1200 metres)
<p>DAYTIME ROBBERY began awkwardly and shortly after was inconvenienced by KINGOFPLATINUM which had begun awkwardly and shifted inwards.</p>	

CENTURION was slow to begin.

SIMPLETIN raced three wide without cover throughout.

KINGOFPLATINUM had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 300 metres.

THE BANDITO (M Dravitzki) improved up on to the heels of **DAYTIME ROBBERY** near the 250 metres and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running inconvenienced **CENTURION**. **M Dravitzki** was advised to exercise care.

Over the final stages **SLIMLINE** shifted in under pressure and prior to being straightened placed **ROCKY MOLLOY** in restricted room near the winning post.

Race 4	FARMLANDS / CENTRALINES HANDICAP SPRINT (1200 metres)

DON'T CHANGE shifted out leaving the barriers, bumping with **ADRIENNE** which in turn made contact with the hind quarters of **ZINIKA**, which became momentarily unbalanced.

Race 5	PETER EVANS MAIDEN SPRINT (1400 metres)

CORNWALL was slow to begin.

KEEN TEMPO reared leaving the barriers making heavy contact with **ROSSINI GIRL**, which lost ground.

R Hannam the rider of **RED REBEL** was reminded of his obligations to be clear of other runners after he allowed his mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not clear of **TICKET CLIPPER**, which was hampered. **TICKET CLIPPER** then commenced to over-race.

SOLUTE raced greenly early in the home straight.

TICKET CLIPPER raced greenly over the final 100 metres and could not be fully tested.

Race 6	CENTRAL FM 3YO SPRINT (1400 metres)

KEEP US HAPPY was slow to begin.

LAUTARO began awkwardly losing ground.

PERFECT PITCH raced three wide without cover over the final 900 metres.

TAYLA MAID had to be steadied near the 650 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of **TE MATA'S HORSE**.

R Myers reported that in her opinion **LAUTARO** may be better suited to 1600 metres.

Race 7	JOHN TURKINGTON FORESTRY WAIPUKURAU CUP (2100 metres)

ZEDETTA and **KALINGA** were slow to begin.

CAJUN was crowded leaving the barriers between **ROSEHIP**, which shifted outwards and **PIRINITETE**, which shifted inwards.

SLAZENJAH hung outwards and made the first bend awkwardly.

EVASIVE TRACY raced three wide without cover throughout.

MAKO lay in under pressure throughout the final straight, requiring rider **H Tinsley** to swap the whip into his left hand.

When questioned regarding the performance of **SHEZASTUNNA**, rider **M Cameron** could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 8	MITRE 10 / CHB MAIL HANDICAP MILE (1600 metres)

DUKEBOX underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers and was cleared to start after becoming fractious in its stall, rearing and escaping for a short distance. A warning is placed against **DUKEBOX** with regard to its barrier manners

SHEZENTHUSIASTIC was slow to begin.

PHOENIX TYCOON raced three wide without cover throughout.

DUKEBOX had to be steadied off heels when over-racing near the 800 metres.

DUKEBOX shifted in under pressure near the 250 metres inconveniencing **TAKE OFF**.

SHEZENTHUSIASTIC raced in restricted room over the final 50 metres.
