## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>DIRECT FISH &amp; OYSTERS PREMIER</b>
<b>CROCODILE CANYON (R Myers)</b> was slow away then over-raced when being restrained through the middle stages before racing three wide without cover from the 900 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>GUARANTOR</b> , rider L Allpress advised that in her opinion the slow tempo of the race had not suited her mount. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>TUI – BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 2YO PREMIER</b>
<b>PLATINUM EXPRESS (R Hannam)</b> bumped with <b>PLATINUM LOOKER (M Cameron)</b> leaving the barriers. <b>DAPONTE (K Myers)</b> and <b>BUFFALO CHIEF (V Colgan)</b> were slow to begin. <b>DAPONTE</b> shifted outwards shortly after the start when over-racing making contact with the hindquarters of <b>IN ANOTHER LIFE (M McNab)</b> which was unbalanced briefly. <b>BUFFALO CHIEF</b> raced fiercely in the early stages and had to be shifted outwards abruptly when racing up onto the heels of <b>DAPONTE</b> near the 700 metres.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>RACE WITH US richardsonracing.co.nz</b>
<b>BACK ON SONG (R Hutchings)</b> was slow away.	

<p><b>BRONSTEEL (N Teeluck)</b> raced keenly early and had to be steadied off heels for some distance approaching the 900 metres. <b>BRONSTEEL</b> continued to over-race through the middle stages and made the final turn awkwardly, running wide. <b>BELLA'S DELIGHT (C Grylls)</b> made the first turn awkwardly and had to be steadied. <b>HEZA REBEL (A Jones)</b> raced three wide without cover throughout. <b>THIEN LY (J Riddell)</b> was held up for a short distance prior to entering the home straight. <b>HOT SPOT (R Myers)</b> had to be steadied when crowded for room passing the 200 metres. <b>GEMMA LASS (K Myers)</b> was inclined to lay inwards in the final straight having to be steadied when hampered by <b>THIEN LY</b> which lay in under pressure near the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 4	<b>LIFE PHARMACY QUEENSGATE PREMIER</b>
<p><b>MAE WEST (R Myers)</b> jumped outwards abruptly at the start hampering <b>DILLINGER (H Tinsley)</b> and <b>ZUMBA (J Parkes)</b> both of which settled back as a result. <b>WAIKAHA (O Bosson)</b> raced three wide without cover before improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 800 metres. <b>WILLS ROAD</b> raced keenly in the lead in the middle stages. <b>CASINO (R Hannam)</b> raced keenly in the middle stages and was unable to find clear running in the final straight until passing the 150 metres. <b>MAE WEST</b> had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. <b>H Tinsley</b> reported that the tongue tie on <b>DILLINGER</b> had become detached during the race.</p>	
Race 5	<b>HIREMASTER NEW ZEALAND ST LEGER - Listed</b>
<p><b>M Cameron</b> replaced <b>D Turner</b> on <b>EYEFUL TOWER</b> due to a transport delay. <b>EPINEAUX (R Myers)</b> was hampered leaving the barriers between <b>BAJOUR (K Myers)</b> which shifted outwards abruptly and <b>EYEFUL TOWER (M Cameron)</b> which shifted inwards abruptly. <b>TEQUILA SUNRISE (R Hutchings)</b> was slow away. <b>RASA LILA (V Colgan)</b> hung out leaving the barriers forcing <b>ANDALUCI (C Grylls)</b> wider on the track. <b>TIPPERARY (M du Plessis)</b> was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers. <b>IFFWEDANCE (J Riddell)</b> raced keenly when being restrained to avoid the heels of <b>ODABELLA (R Hannam)</b> near the 1800 metres. <b>COOL HAND DUKE (O Bosson)</b> raced up onto heels near the 500 metres and had to be severely restrained. <b>EPINEAUX</b> has to be steadied when racing in restricted room near the 400 metres. <b>RASA LILA</b> and <b>ANDALUCI</b> came together on several occasions in the final straight. <b>TIPPERARY</b> was unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>RASA LILA</b>, <b>V Colgan</b> said that the mare had travelled well but had failed to finish the race off once asked to quicken near the 400 metres and had been disappointing.</p>	
Race 6	<b>CARTERS MELBOUNE RACING CLUB LIGHTNING HANDICAP - Listed</b>
<p><b>ANGELICA HALL (D Johnson)</b> and <b>WHOSEYOURMASTER (H Tinsley)</b> jumped away awkwardly and came together. <b>COSMIC CUBE (R Hutchings)</b> began awkwardly. <b>TOMO VALEA (D Walsh)</b> commenced to over-race shortly after the start and continued to do so through the middle stages. <b>COUP AY TEE (M Cameron)</b> had to be restrained to avoid the heels of <b>HANNH MARY (L Allpress)</b> which shifted inwards near the 1100 metres when not fully clear. <b>L Allpress</b> was advised to exercise greater care. <b>COUP AY TEE</b> then commenced to over-race when left three-wide without cover and ran wide rounding the junction onto the course proper near the 500 metres. <b>COSMIC CUBE</b> also ran wide near the 500 metres taking <b>TAURUS (J Parkes)</b> over extra ground. <b>TREPIDATION (K Myers)</b> shifted outwards near the 500 metres making contact with <b>ANGELICA HALL</b>. <b>STUNNING PRINCESS (D Bradley)</b> was held up passing the 400 metres. <b>WHOSEYOURMASTER</b> was held up early in the final straight and did not obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 7	<b>HARDY TRADE WELLINGTON GUINEAS – Group II</b>
<p><b>RIDING SHOTGUN (R Myers)</b> and <b>CADUCEUS (M McNab)</b> both began awkwardly and lost ground. <b>REILLY LINCOLN</b> raced three wide without cover throughout. <b>NO TRICKS (M Cameron)</b> shifted outwards near the 200 metres hampering <b>KOLONEL KEV (J Riddell)</b>. <b>M Cameron</b> was issued with a warning. <b>KOLONEL KEV</b> then lay out away from <b>NO TRICKS</b> crowding <b>DRAMATIST (V Colgan)</b> out onto <b>SMARTS ENCOSTA (H Tinsley)</b> with those two runners becoming unbalanced near the 150 metres. <b>M McNab</b> the rider of <b>CADUCEUS</b> which preformed formed poorly advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p>	
Race 8	<b>THE PAPER SOURCE CUDDLE STAKES – Group III</b>
<p><b>IRION (D Bradley)</b> over-raced in the middle stages having to be firmly restrained after improving onto the heels of <b>OCEANIA (R Myers)</b> near the 500 metres. <b>IRION</b> was then unable to obtain clear running until shifting outwards across heels near the 150 metres when in doing so was not sufficiently clear of <b>GWYNETHANNE (J Parkes)</b> which was checked and crowded onto <b>TE HANA</b>. <b>D Bradley</b></p>	

admitted a resultant breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) and was suspended by the Judicial Committee from the close of racing today Saturday 14 March 2015 until the close of racing on Sunday 22 March 2015 (5 riding days).  
**OCEANIA** made contact with **PROCUREMENT (D Johnson)** near the 400 metres and again when laying outwards near the 300 metres bumped **PROCUREMENT**.  
 Passing the 150 metres **GWYNETHANNE** lay out crowding **TE HANA (V Colgan)** onto **SLICE OF CLASS (K Myers)**.  
 Trainer Mr D Greene reported that **DRAMATIST** was in a distressed condition post-race receiving veterinary treatment for a suspected mild bout of colic.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>WELLFIELD NEW ZEALAND OAKS – Gp 1</b>

**ANOTHER COUP (M Cameron)** was slow away.  
**PLATINUM WITNESS (D Bradley)** raced in restricted room near the winning post on the first occasion when racing keenly and bumped with **BELLE MIRAAJ (V Colgan)** going into the first turn.  
**SAAVOYA (C Grylls)** made the turn near the 1900 metres awkwardly.  
**EXQUISITE JEWEL (R Hannam)** was caught wide in the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1600 metres.  
**PLATINUM WITNESS** continued to over-race rounding the first bend and through the middle stages having to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of **MARY QUANT (L Allpress)** near the 1700 metres.  
**ANOTHER COUP** raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1100 metres.  
**PLATINUM WITNESS** had to be steadied off heels near the 600 metres.  
**SAVARIA (H Tinsley)** had to change ground near the 400 metres and again near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.  
 When questioned regarding the poor performance of **ANOTHER COUP**, rider **M Cameron** advised that the filly had not been suited by the stop-start tempo of the race. A post-race veterinary examination of **ANOTHER COUP** did not reveal any abnormality.

<b>Race 10</b>	<b>MILLS REEF WINERY PREMIER</b>

**BERG EN DAL (D Johnson)** and **ALBRECHT (O Bosson)** bumped leaving the barriers with **BERG EN DAL** losing ground.  
**JACKFROST (R Myers)** was slow away.  
**TORRICELLA (R Hutchings)** had to be steadied off heels near the 1300 metres.  
**ATTIVAREE (K Myers)** was held up entering the final straight.  
**BERG EN DAL (D Johnson)** had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.  
 When questioned regarding the performance of **ALBRECHT**, **O Bosson** advised that the gelding had travelled well until the home straight where once placed under pressure had failed to respond. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.
