RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TEAM WEALLEANS 2000
<p>NAZLANMAK (B Hutton) was slow to begin.</p> <p>SACRED TRUST (C Grylls) and EL PISTOLA (P Holmes) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>CHEQUESINTHEMAIL (L Magorrian) shifted outwards leaving the barriers inconveniencing BIT OF CRUMPET (M Du Plessis) which steadied.</p> <p>Approaching the 1800 metres CHEQUESINTHEMAIL raced ungenerously when being steadied off the heels of SACRED TRUST.</p> <p>MARQUILLA (S Collett) raced three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.</p> <p>SACRED TRUST was held up early in the final straight until obtaining clear running near the 200 metres.</p> <p>EL PISTOLA was held up for a short distance passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the improved performance of EL PISTOLA trainer Mr N Hanley advised that the mare had been a slow maturing type looking for more ground, and after winning a barrier trial at the start of this preparation he had been pleased with its fresh-up run over 1600 metres being confident of an improved showing today.</p>	
Race 2	OS SERVICES LIMITED 1400
<p>SUGGEST GOLD (R Smyth) was slow away.</p> <p>MIKIMOTO (M Coleman) knuckled shortly after leaving the barriers.</p> <p>ASTRONOMER (R Hutchings) and FREE AND BOLD (C Lammas) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>FREE AND BOLD was steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>FIONN'S KID (B R Jones) shied near the 800 metres going off stride.</p> <p>FREE AND BOLD raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>ASTRONOMER shifted away from BEAUTY MOMENT (M Du Plessis) near the 250 metres crowding the weakening WHITTAKER (S Spratt) which had to be steadied to avoid the heels of FREE AND BOLD.</p> <p>SUGGEST GOLD was briefly held up near the 250 metres having to steady away from the heels of ASTRONOMER.</p>	
Race 3	TOKOROA COSMOPOLITAN CLUB & TREES TAVERN TOKOROA 1200
<p>LET HER RIP (D Johnson) was slow away.</p>	

<p>ZEANI (C Grylls) lay in after jumping away crowding HASHTAGFABULOUS (S Collett) on to LUPITA (R Hutchings) with HASHTAGFABULOUS losing ground.</p> <p>EPROUVEZ (M Du Plessis) over-raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>FANATIC (M Sweeney) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>LET HER RIP had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight bumping with LUPITA near the 250 metres.</p> <p>LET HER RIP shifted outwards near the 150 metres inconveniencing LUPITA which was racing greenly.</p> <p>LADY PAINTON (C Lammas) had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.</p> <p>HASHTAGFABULOUS required veterinary attention after being galloped on to the right hind leg.</p> <p>ACRE (Z Moki) required veterinary attention suffering from heat stress post-race.</p>	
Race 4	TOKOROA CLUB (INC) 1200
<p>POINT PERCY (R Hutchings) began awkwardly.</p> <p>SWAN SONG (C Lammas) was slow to begin.</p> <p>RAAJ (D Johnson) shifted outwards leaving the barriers crowding ARTERIAL (B R Jones), JOE CARGO (M Du Plessis) and WELL RELATED (L Magorrian) with WELL RELATED losing ground.</p> <p>ELEGANT LAD (V Colgan) commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied for a distance passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>BE YOURSELF (S Collett) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>POINT PERCY made the final turn awkwardly taking BE YOURSELF over extra ground near the 350 metres.</p>	
Race 5	POCKETS Q-MASTERS TOKOROA 1200
<p>SPAWN OF ELAIA (T Thornton) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>FINAL OVER (V Colgan), HYSTERIA LANE (M Coleman) and KIRINA BELLE (M Du Plessis) all raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>JOUET CUVÉE (S Spratt) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>HYSTERIA LANE had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>Approaching the 250 metres ELUSIVE BOXERS (M Cameron) shifted outwards when placed under pressure inconveniencing BEAUTY ACE (C Grylls).</p> <p>CANCELLARA (R Hutchings) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight shifting ground on a number of occasions.</p> <p>SPAWN OF ELAIA had to be steadied away from the heels of CANCELLARA over the concluding stages.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of BEAUTY ACE rider C Grylls was unable to offer any excuses, advising that the gelding had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure, and had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>Rider M Du Plessis was unable to offer any excuses for the poor performance of KIRINA BELLE.</p>	
Race 6	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>GALVANISED (C Grylls) and TAVIS STAR (M Coleman) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>SWEET INDULGENCE (M Cameron) shifted outwards leaving the barriers inconveniencing WINDERMERE LASS (V Colgan).</p> <p>Passing the 1000 metres NOM DE LA DANSE (C Lammas) raced ungenerously for a distance when awkwardly placed on the heels of SWEET INDULGENCE which shifted in then steadied.</p> <p>IN A FRENZY (M McNab) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>PATTICAN (A Jones) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>IN A FRENZY was held up rounding the final turn passing the 400 metres, and was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight until near the 100 metres after having to shift ground outwards across heels.</p> <p>GALVANISED was held up passing the 400 metres, and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.</p> <p>GALVANISED which was then making ground was again held up near the 100 metres when KAHAROA ROSE (Z Moki) shifted inwards under pressure away from SHESGOTIT (S Spratt). Apprentice Moki was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>SWEET INDULGENCE ducked outwards away from GLADSTONE BELLE (M Du Plessis) passing the 250 metres then having to be steadied to avoid the heels of NOM DE LA DANSE.</p> <p>GLADSTONE BELLE lay out under pressure inside the final 100 metres having to be corrected by its rider.</p> <p>IN A FRENZY returned to the enclosure bleeding from a wound to the left hind leg which upon veterinary inspection was found to be a minor abrasion to the pastern.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of WINDERMERE LASS, which was not persevered with over the final 200 metres after becoming tailed off, rider V Colgan was unable to offer any excuses other than the filly being caught wide during the running. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p>	
Race 7	LALLY & SYMES SOUTH WAIKATO CUP
<p>SHE'S SAMASHING was declared a late scratching at 2.43 pm on veterinary advice after becoming cast in its box.</p> <p>QUINTASTICS (D Johnson) underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being kicked in the left shoulder in the tie-up stalls. QUINTASTICS was again inspected at the start being confirmed fit to run by the veterinarian.</p> <p>ARIZONA JAZZ (M Sweeney) shifted outwards abruptly leaving the barrier hampering NOLAWOOD (A Jones).</p> <p>LADY SAYYIDA (V Colgan) began awkwardly shifting out.</p> <p>QUINTASTICS shifted out leaving the barrier inconveniencing JIMMY HOFFA (S McKay).</p>	

QUINTASTICS raced in restricted room leaving the straight on the first occasion, and passing the 1500 metres steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of **SECONDS OUT** (M Cameron) which shifted in.
NOLAWOOD raced three wide without cover from the 1100 metres.
SHEZASTUNNA (R Hutchings) made contact with **QUINTASTICS** when attempting to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.
SHEZASTUNNA was then held up until shifting outwards across the heels of **SECONDS OUT** to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.

ZAVAMAR (C Grylls), **MRS SIN** (B R Jones), **SINGAPORE GIRL** (M Cameron) and **RUBY TUESDAY** (R Hutchings) were all slow to begin.

O'REILLY'S GOLD (M McNab) shifted outwards leaving the barriers crowding **SHARPSHOOTER** (A Jones) and **FELICITY HALL** (L Magorrian) which were steadied.

PACHENKO (T Thornton) raced keenly for a distance approaching the 800 metres when in restricted room to the inside of **NIGHTSHIFT** (S Spratt). S Spratt was advised to exercise care.

MRS SIN had to be steadied off the heels of **DEEMA** (M Du Plessis) over the concluding stages.
