RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	VISTA MOTOR LODGE STAYERS
Rider S McKay was kicked when attempting to mount ALI in the birdcage. S McKay was found to be uninjured after being examined by St Johns medical personnel. ALI jumped away awkwardly making contact with the hindquarters of APACHE MOON (D Johnson). MIO KIWI (S Doyle) shifted outwards leaving the barriers forcing CLE D'OR (R Myers) into the line of DUKEBOX (S Collett) further hampering that runner which had been slow to begin. ALI raced ungenerously when being restrained leaving the straight on the first occasion near the 1600 metres. DUKEBOX raced three wide without cover when improving forward from the 1100 metres. SELINE (M Cameron) was held up behind the weakening MIO KIWI rounding the bend until near the 400 metres. BAHRELLA (A Jones) was inconvenienced when DUKEBOX lay in approaching the 100 metres. S McKay was dislodged from his mount when pulling up. ALI was quickly re-captured and S McKay uninjured.	
Race 2	FRASERTOWN TAVERN JUVENILE
PRAIRIE CREEK (S Collett) began awkwardly.	
Race 3	WAIROA STUD BREEDERS DASH
EYESONYOU (M Cameron) began awkwardly making contact with TIEBREAKER (K Myers). CANDID MAN (S Collett) over-raced when being steadied off the heels of AGOSTINI (D Johnson) near the 1000 metres. BORN HAPPY (A Jones) raced three wide without cover. When questioned regarding the performance of EYESONYOU rider M Cameron advised that after beginning awkwardly the filly raced further back today than intended and had been unable to recover.	
Race 4	K9 PETFOODS DASH
CORNWALL (R Myers) jumped away awkwardly. CORNWALL was forced wider on the track rounding the bend near the 650 metres before making the final turn awkwardly near the 250 metres. SABER (D Johnson) was inclined to lay inwards in the final straight.	

Race 5	SUNSET POINT BAR AND BISTRO SPRINT
<p>The start of this race was officially put back 2 minutes at the request of TAB raceday control. MALROSE (J Parkes) knuckled leaving the barriers. BABILLONI (M Dravitzki) was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination of PARISIENNE JEWEL found the filly to be showing some signs of a possible respiratory infection with trainer Mr J Price advising that he would have further veterinary tests done on return to his stable. The track was upgraded to Good(3) following the running of this race.</p>	
Race 6	WAIROA BUSINESS SUPPORTERS STAYERS
<p>GRENADE (J Parkes) began awkwardly losing ground. DON GALLARDO (K Myers) jumped inwards at the start making contact with SONTANA (R Myers) which had been slow to begin with SONTANA then crowding SKYLLA (A Jones) with both SONTANA and SKYLLA losing ground. SONTANA over-raced in the early stages making the bend near the 1600 metres awkwardly. ONE O EIGHT (M Chui) raced ungenerously when being restrained off the heels of ROCK EXPRESS (M Cameron) approaching the 1200 metres. PIT A PAT (S Collett) raced wide without cover from the 900 metres. NOTIONANNAGINS was held up rounding the final turn near the 300 metres having to shift outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres making contact with DON GALLARDO. DON GALLARDO shifted inwards under pressure near the 100 metres crowding NOTIONANNAGINS (R Hannam) which then shifted away from DON GALLARDO crowding SONTANA onto GRENADE which were both steadied over the concluding stages. K Myers was issued with a warning.</p>

<p>BROADWALK (D Johnson) began awkwardly. SECOND HOPE (M Cameron) and PALEMO (C O'Beirne) were crowded leaving the barriers between SEA KING (R Myers) and EVEN BETTER (R Hannam) which both shifted ground.</p>	
Race 8	KENILWORTH PLUMBING SPRINT
<p>GOODSPEED was declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 1:00pm. STAGE DOOR (D Johnson) was slow to begin. ROC'S ARE DIAMONDS (R Myers) was crowded leaving the barriers. KEEP US HAPPY (J Parkes) began awkwardly. CHADSDALE (M Dravitzki) raced three wide without cover. K Myers was unable to offer any excuses for the disappointing performance of EVADIR LA BALA.</p>
