RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SUPER LIQUOR TE AROHA 1000
<p>SUPREME ADDITION (V Colgan) jumped away awkwardly from the outside barrier stall, shifting outwards abruptly over the early stages and losing ground. SUPREME ADDITION then became tailed off for some distance despite the urgings of its rider before running on strongly in the final straight.</p> <p>CASING THE JOINT (T Thornton) was crowded leaving the barriers.</p> <p>SHADES OF PEARL (M McNab) lay inwards, away from PLAY IT FOR ME (B R Jones) in the early stages, crowding TOPARTS (S Spratt) which was checked near the 900 metres.</p> <p>TOPARTS and CASING THE JOINT both had to be firmly restrained off heels of runners ahead approaching the 600 metres.</p> <p>ROYAL POWER (M Du Plessis) hung outwards rounding the bend and continued to hang out when placed under pressure in the final straight, and as a result was unable to be fully ridden out by its rider.</p> <p>SHADES OF PEARL lay in early in the final straight, hampering CASING THE JOINT near the 400 metres.</p>	
Race 2	PETER LOCK RACING 1400
<p>BEE TEE JUNIOR (O Bosson) was slow away.</p> <p>KAY'S LEGACY (S McKay) raced wide when contesting the lead.</p>	

Race 3	SCOTT WENN RACING 2200
<p>When being led up to the barriers SINO HEIGHTS (K Myers) lunged forward, striking the starting stalls and was declared a late scratching at 1.59 pm on veterinary advice.</p> <p>SHE'S A SCREAMER (M McNab) which had been fractious in the barriers prior to the start jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>SACRED TRUST (C Grylls) was inclined to over-race in the early stages getting its head up when being restrained on a number of occasions.</p> <p>Passing the 450 metres SINGLE SHOT (M Hills) and CENTRE STAGE (D Johnson) made contact, both becoming briefly unbalanced. CENTRE STAGE then lay in dictating SINGLE SHOT in slightly inconveniencing SIH RAH (T Thornton).</p> <p>C Grylls the rider of SACRED TRUST dropped his whip near the 150 metres.</p> <p>BEAUTY GIANT (M Du Plessis) improved into a marginal run between CENTRE STAGE and SINGLE SHOT near the 100 metres with CENTRE STAGE then shifting in slightly resulting in SINGLE SHOT being crowded and steadied over the concluding stages.</p> <p>CENTRE STAGE lost the off fore plate during the running.</p>	
Race 4	STEPHEN MARSH RACING STABLES 1200
<p>KING'S CROSS (D Johnson) blundered jumping away, badly hampering LICAVOLI (M Hills) with both those runners losing several lengths.</p> <p>ROGER (M Coleman) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Approaching the 900 metres ROGER was steadied off heels shifting back on to LICAVOLI which had to steady.</p> <p>CLASSIC EMPEROR (K Myers) lay out under pressure in the final straight and inconvenienced ROGER passing the 200 metres, and again passing the 100 metres where ROGER had to briefly steady.</p>	
Race 5	SUNLINE LODGE 1000
<p>LADDIE OF OAKVIEW (M Sweeney) was slow away.</p> <p>FULLY FUNDED (T Thornton) began awkwardly, hampering FINAL OVER (C Lammas). FINAL OVER then had to be steadied to avoid the heels of FULLY FUNDED which shifted inwards near the 900 metres. Rider T Thornton was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>BEAUTY ACE (C Grylls) had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of DAYTIME ROBBERY (D Nolan) which shifted inwards near the 800 metres. D Nolan was advised to exercise far greater care when shifting ground, and further advised that a warning would be placed on his record.</p> <p>FINAL OVER raced keenly at the rear in the middle stages and had a tendency to lay out.</p> <p>FULLY FUNDED lay in, inconveniencing BEAUTY ACE near the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 6	PIKE RACING 1400
<p>INGENIOUS HONOUR (M McNab) began awkwardly.</p> <p>TWILIGHT OFFER (M Cameron) and TICKLE ME (S Spratt) came together leaving the barriers, making solid contact.</p> <p>WRAITHORTH (R Smyth) had a tendency to lay inwards in the early stages.</p> <p>WRAITHORTH was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 300 metres, having to be straightened by its rider, and then again lay in becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of INGENIOUS HONOUR rider M McNab was unable to offer any excuse.</p>	
Race 7	BAKER RACING STABLES 1600
<p>MATAATUA (C Lammas) jumped in the air at the start.</p> <p>RANSOMS GOLD (S Collett) was slow away.</p> <p>PINK DIAMOND (S Spratt) and HE'S A BIGDEEL (D Nolan) both began awkwardly.</p> <p>HE'S A BIGDEEL became awkwardly placed and had to steady approaching the 1000 metres.</p> <p>LUCKY ORPHAN (M Coleman) raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>HIGH VIZ (L Innes) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>DALEZINGA (J Wong) was unable to find clear running throughout the final straight.</p> <p>OUR SERAFINA (R Smyth) was inconvenienced near the 250 metres, and again approaching the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 8	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>COVERED 'N BAY (M Hills) began awkwardly making contact with PANELLA (A Jones).</p> <p>MARQUILLA (M McNab) was slow to begin.</p> <p>ILOVEYOUJUST (M Du Plessis) jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>Jockey O Bosson reported that WORKS WONDERS was feeling the effects of the firmer nature of the footing.</p>
