### **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 DOYLE & ASSOCIATES R75

MANU began awkwardly.

**WRITTEN COMMAND** (M Hills) hung outwards from the 500 metres and over the final stages shifted ground outwards under pressure bumping **MANU** near the finish. Jockey M Hills was advised to exercise more care when in similar circumstances in future.

Race 2 QBE INSURANCE MDN

VIA DOLOROSA jumped inwards at the start into the line of MASTER PATRICK which settled back.

VON TOLL hung throughout.

**AWESOME DIVA** was inclined to lug out rounding the bend and home straight.

Near the 300 metres **VIA DOLOROSA** (H Tinsley) when being angled outwards in search of a run bumped with **ALL IN LUCK** which in turn made contact with **TRUE SECRET** which was improving to it's outside. When questioned, H Tinsley advised that he was attempting to avoid the heels of the tiring **CRACK A TUI.** Stewards noted Mr Tinsley's explanation and after questioning riders issued him with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) – careless riding.

#### Race 3

### NZ BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE F&M PEARL SERIES MDN

**CARAJEAN** underwent a veterinary inspection at the start, was found to be lame so was late scratched. Connections were advised that a clearance is required prior to **CARAJEAN'S** next start.

The start of the race was delayed due to **KATIE SPICE** being slow to load. Connections of **KATIE SPICE** were advised a warning is placed with regards to the filly's barrier manners.

**LILLY PINS** jumped out abruptly at the start dictating **SANSHIN** outwards onto **KATIE SPICE** resulting in both runners getting back.

**SANSHIN** raced three-wide without cover rounding the turn.

Over the final stages LILLY PINS hung outwards under pressure which forced IRISH WHISPER over extra ground.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **EFFECTAV** which was under pressure some distance out, Rider V Johnston could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

## Race 4 LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES R65

**DANCER'S TALE** reared and lost ground at the start settling well back.

**LUCKY BELT** had to be steadied when attempting to improve near the 500 metres after **CAUGHT BEHIND** (D Turner) momentarily shifted in. Rider D Turner was advised to exercise more care in future.

Rider H Tinsley had no excuse for the disappointing run of MACFINN advising the gelding had been outpaced throughout.

### Race 5 NZI INSURANCE MDN

**CLAUDE** and **SAMOGON** were slow away.

TIDDLY had to be eased off the heels of INNER NINJA going into the first turn when that runner steadied.

### Race 6 RUAPEHU LIONS CLUB MEMORIAL R65

LANZARA was slow away and then had to steady off heels going into the first bend when in restricted room.

LA CLAIRETTE was slow away.

BRECON GROSVE was obliged to race three-wide without cover throughout.

**CUPCAKE** raced wide throughout.

Shortly after entering the home straight **LA CLAIRETTE** when attempting to improve to the inside of **LANZARA** (C O'Beirne) had to steady for some distance when **LANZARA** shifted in. After questioning riders, Apprentice C O'Beirne was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) – careless riding.

### Race 7 GUTHRIE BOWRON HOSPICE CUP R75

The start of this race was delayed after the outside four horses were loaded away incorrectly prior to the error being righted by the starter. Starter, B Clement was addressed by the stewards regarding the error.

**CITY CHIC** began awkwardly and got back then was further tightened when **DUCHESSOFCAMBRIDGE** shifted in. Also tightened in the movement was **THE BEAMA** which settled last.

**CITY CHIC** over-raced in the early stages.

L Allpress the rider of LOVE ME MOORE was advised to exercise care when shifting in near the 1,100 metres resulting in MISCHIEVOUS MIS having to steady.

**D** Bradley (CITY CHIC) was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground after easing his mount off the rail when seeking to improve near the 800 metres inconveniencing **ZIMMZEE**.

### Race 8 WANGANUI STEELFORMERS MDN

I CANDY was slow away.

**DECORUM** began awkwardly.

**ALAGHERA** over-raced in the early stages and had to be steadied off heels for some distance near the post on the first round

I CANDY raced wide over the final 1,200 metres.

**EPINEAUX** was obliged to improve its position three-wide rounding the turn.
