| <b>Race 1</b>   | <b>DOYLE &amp; ASSOCIATES R75</b> |
| <p><b>MANU</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>WRITTEN COMMAND</b> (M Hills) hung outwards from the 500 metres and over the final stages shifted ground outwards under pressure bumping <b>MANU</b> near the finish. Jockey M Hills was advised to exercise more care when in similar circumstances in future.</p>   |                                   |
| <b>Race 2</b>   | <b>QBE INSURANCE MDN</b>          |
| <p><b>VIA DOLOROSA</b> jumped inwards at the start into the line of <b>MASTER PATRICK</b> which settled back.</p> <p><b>VON TOLL</b> hung throughout.</p> <p><b>AWESOME DIVA</b> was inclined to lug out rounding the bend and home straight.</p> <p>Near the 300 metres <b>VIA DOLOROSA</b> (H Tinsley) when being angled outwards in search of a run bumped with <b>ALL IN LUCK</b> which in turn made contact with <b>TRUE SECRET</b> which was improving to it's outside. When questioned, H Tinsley advised that he was attempting to avoid the heels of the tiring <b>CRACK A TUI</b>. Stewards noted Mr Tinsley's explanation and after questioning riders issued him with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) – careless riding.</p> |                                   |

| <b>Race 3</b>   | <b>NZ BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE F&amp;M PEARL SERIES MDN</b> |
| <p><b>CARAJEAN</b> underwent a veterinary inspection at the start, was found to be lame so was late scratched. Connections were advised that a clearance is required prior to <b>CARAJEAN'S</b> next start.</p> <p>The start of the race was delayed due to <b>KATIE SPICE</b> being slow to load. Connections of <b>KATIE SPICE</b> were advised a warning is placed with regards to the filly's barrier manners.</p> <p><b>LILLY PINS</b> jumped out abruptly at the start dictating <b>SANSHIN</b> outwards onto <b>KATIE SPICE</b> resulting in both runners getting back.</p> <p><b>SANSHIN</b> raced three-wide without cover rounding the turn.</p> <p>Over the final stages <b>LILLY PINS</b> hung outwards under pressure which forced <b>IRISH WHISPER</b> over extra ground.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of <b>EFFECTAV</b> which was under pressure some distance out, Rider V Johnston could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> |   |
| <b>Race 4</b>   | <b>LOWE SCHOLLUM &amp; JONES R65</b>                    |
| <p><b>DANCER'S TALE</b> reared and lost ground at the start settling well back.</p> <p><b>LUCKY BELT</b> had to be steadied when attempting to improve near the 500 metres after <b>CAUGHT BEHIND</b> (D Turner) momentarily shifted in. Rider D Turner was advised to exercise more care in future.</p> <p>Rider H Tinsley had no excuse for the disappointing run of <b>MACFINN</b> advising the gelding had been outpaced throughout.</p>  |   |
| <b>Race 5</b>   | <b>NZI INSURANCE MDN</b>                                |
| <p><b>CLAUDE</b> and <b>SAMOGON</b> were slow away.</p> <p><b>TIDDLY</b> had to be eased off the heels of <b>INNER NINJA</b> going into the first turn when that runner steadied.</p>   |   |

| <p><b>LANZARA</b> was slow away and then had to steady off heels going into the first bend when in restricted room.</p> <p><b>LA CLAIRETTE</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>BRECON GROSV</b> was obliged to race three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>CUPCAKE</b> raced wide throughout.</p> <p>Shortly after entering the home straight <b>LA CLAIRETTE</b> when attempting to improve to the inside of <b>LANZARA</b> (C O'Beirne) had to steady for some distance when <b>LANZARA</b> shifted in. After questioning riders, Apprentice C O'Beirne was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) – careless riding.</p>  |   |
| <b>Race 7</b>   | <b>GUTHRIE BOWRON HOSPICE CUP R75</b>                   |
| <p>The start of this race was delayed after the outside four horses were loaded away incorrectly prior to the error being righted by the starter. Starter, B Clement was addressed by the stewards regarding the error.</p> <p><b>CITY CHIC</b> began awkwardly and got back then was further tightened when <b>DUCHESS OF CAMBRIDGE</b> shifted in. Also tightened in the movement was <b>THE BEAMA</b> which settled last.</p> <p><b>CITY CHIC</b> over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>L Allpress</b> the rider of <b>LOVE ME MOORE</b> was advised to exercise care when shifting in near the 1,100 metres resulting in <b>MISCHIEVOUS MIS</b> having to steady.</p> <p><b>D Bradley (CITY CHIC)</b> was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground after easing his mount off the rail when seeking to improve near the 800 metres inconveniencing <b>ZIMMZEE</b>.</p>  |   |

| <p><b>I CANDY</b> was slow away.</p> <p><b>DECORUM</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>ALAGHERA</b> over-raced in the early stages and had to be steadied off heels for some distance near the post on the first round.</p> <p><b>I CANDY</b> raced wide over the final 1,200 metres.</p> <p><b>EPINEAUX</b> was obliged to improve its position three-wide rounding the turn.</p>   |   |
