RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ALLFINAZ CHALMERS TWO MILE PREMIER
<p>HER TO ETERNITY (D Johnson) shifted outward abruptly on jumping away crowding THE BIG OPAL (M du Plessis) and MISS ANA (M Dee) which lost ground.</p> <p>HER TO ETERNITY over-raced when being restrained near the 3000 metres.</p> <p>THORA BOB (C O'Beirne) commenced to weaken from its leading position near the 1200 metres eventually losing contact with the field finishing a distant last. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of THORA BOB which revealed the mare to be lame in front. Stewards advised connections a veterinary clearance will be required prior to THORA BOB racing again. When questioned regarding the performance of LETMEBY, C Grylls could offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.</p>

<p>K Smith replaced S Doyle on MASTER JACK and V Johnston replaced M Dravitzki on CARRINGTON PARK after both riders were late arriving to the course. Both S Doyle and M Dravitzki were fined \$200 each under Rule 605 (i) for failing to</p>	

present on course by the required time.

CAPER CALEB (C Johnson) was slow to begin.

IRISH CHAT (M Dee) was buffeted between **MASTER JACK (K Smith)** on the outside and **PERONI (D Johnson)** on the inside passing the 1300 metres after **MASTER JACK** shifted in when over-racing while being restrained near the 1300 metres **MASTER JACK** raced wide without cover throughout.

KING SAMBO (J Parkes) raced wide throughout.

RUNNY HONEY (K Myers) was held up in the early and middle stages of the home straight.

Apprentice **R Black** admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638 (1)(d) in that she permitted her mount **LET'S DIVORCE** to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of **TEQUILA SUNRISE (V Colgan)** which was crowded prior to being checked near the 300 metres. After considering all submissions the JCA suspended her licence to ride from the close of riding on Saturday 13 December 2014 until the close of riding on Saturday 20 December 2014 (4 days).

Over the final stages, **SPANISH GOLD (D Turner)** shifted out under pressure.

When questioned on the performance of **CAPER CALEB, C Johnson** could offer no excuses.

When questioned on the performance of **OUR KING SWAY, O Bosson** could offer no excuses. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed **OUR KING SWAY** to have a slow recovery rate.

KOLONEL KEV (M Dee) began awkwardly.

SILK BELT (C Johnson) was crowded on jumping when **BENNIES APPROVAL (N Teeluck)** shifted ground outwards.

STACCATO (B Lammas) raced wide throughout.

NYMPH MONTE (M du Plessis) and **THEE AULD FLOOZIE** both over-raced in the early stages.

PLATINUM COMMAND (D Bradley) was held up in the early stages of the home straight.

When questioned regarding the performance of **THEE AULD FLOOZIE, D Johnson** said the filly hung outwards during the running. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.

JUSTANEXCUSE (N Teeluck) was slow to begin.

Near the 1000 metres **CASINO (S Doyle)** when racing in the lead appeared to shy and ease up resulting in **MIGHTY SOLOMON (K Myers)** becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **CASINO (S Doyle)** and having to check.

The saddle shifted forward on **MAKO (M du Plessis)** in the middle stages placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

Race 5	GOLDEN HOMES WAKEFIELD CHALLENGE STAKES - GpII

BILLY MOJO (O Bosson) shifted inwards on jumping crowding **PLATINUM LOOKER (R Hannam)** which lost ground.

ARTWORK (S Doyle) began awkwardly.

SHOWBOY (J Riddell) shifted outwards on jumping forcing **FASCINATE ME (C Grylls)** wider.

STORMY RAY (M du Plessis) raced wide in the early stages.

JACQUETTA (C Johnson) when racing keenly near the 8

00 metres dipped and became momentarily unbalanced. **JACQUETTA** was then held up and unable to improve prior to being angled out near the 150 metres in order to obtain clear running.

SERENA MISS (D Johnson) was held up for some distance until near the 300 metres.

SEEKING REDEMPTION underwent a veterinary inspection at the barrier and was cleared to start.

SOUTHERN SAV (H Tinsley) was slow to begin.

SEEKING REDEMPTION (C Johnson) raced wide in the early and middle stages

COOL HAND DUKE (C Grylls) raced wide throughout.

SOUTHERN SAV was held up in the early stages of the home straight

SEEKING REDEMPTION commenced to weaken from the 500 metres placing the trailing **PICCADILLY (V Johnson)** at a disadvantage momentarily. **PICCADILLY** was then held up rounding the home turn and was unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

CORPORAL LINCOLN (K Myers) had to be steadied when **SOUTHERN SAV** shifted outwards abruptly near the 250 metres.

ATTICA (D Johnson) and **BLU MACH (K Smith)** also had to steady as a result of this movement. **H Tinsley** admitted a charge under Rule 638 (i) (d) as a result and after hearing all submissions the JCA imposed a term of suspension on **H Tinsley** from the close of racing on Saturday 13 December 2014 until the close of racing on Saturday 20 December 2014 (4 days).

O OEE (J Riddell) was placed in restricted room when **SAVARHYS (M du Plessis)** shifted ground near the 200 metres. **M du Plessis** was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

When questioned on the performance of **SEEKING REDEMPTION, C Johnson** reported that the gelding raced wide throughout and when put under pressure was unable to produce. A veterinary examination following the event was ordered by the Stewards which revealed no abnormalities.

THE BEAUT returned to the scale with a laceration to a hind leg which was treated by the on-course vet.

<p>ETERNITY; ITSA TRU STORY and CATWOMANDU all underwent pre-race veterinary examinations at the barrier and were cleared to run.</p> <p>DR PAUL (V Colgan) raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>WILD ROCK (M Dee) raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>ETERNITY raced three-wide without cover with rider O Bosson reporting that ETERNITY hung out throughout.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of RED KING, C Johnson said the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages but when placed under pressure turning for home, failed to respond.</p>	
Race 8	CHANEY'S PANASONIC LEVIN STAKES - Listed
<p>After meeting with trainer Mr M Hodgkinson SIR HIKO was declared a late scratching at 12.40pm. Stewards will be following up on the matter with Mr Hodgkinson regarding the future racing for SIR HIKO.</p> <p>IAMISHWARA (D Bradley) and TOUCHE (M Dee) bumped on jumping away with IAMISHWARA then shifting inwards and crowding MCLAREN (C Johnson) which lost ground.</p> <p>TOUCHE which was racing keenly, was buffeted near the 700 metres when racing between BARBARIC (D Johnson) and IAMISHWARA and as a result was awkwardly placed to the heels of IAMISHWARA shortly after.</p> <p>SPECIAL DRAW (K Myers) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>FLOWER BOMB (M du Plessis) lay outwards when negotiating the junction to the course proper.</p> <p>GINNER HART (N Harris) raced in restricted quarters near the 200 metres</p> <p>DESIGNATED DRIVER (R Hannam) had to steady and come out off the heels of ADVENTADOR (V Johnston) near the 100 metres.</p> <p>When questioned on the performance of BARBARIC, D Johnson could offer no excuses other than being obliged to travel wide throughout. A post-race veterinary examination of BARBARIC revealed</p>	
Race 9	TUI – BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 PREMIER
<p>D Turner was dislodged from MINT in the chute on the way to the start and was cleared by medical staff.</p> <p>LADY PLATINUM (M Dravitzki) was slow to begin.</p> <p>ANTONIO (C Johnson) was bumped at the start.</p> <p>DIAMANTINE (J Parkes) was trapped five wide early so was taken forward near the 800 metres to sit outside the leader.</p> <p>MINT (D Turner) raced wide throughout.</p> <p>SIR SINGO (H Tinsley) was obliged to make its run wide without cover around the turn.</p> <p>ANTONIO shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres dictating PERFECT MIX (M du Plessis) over extra ground.</p> <p>TEDDYTWINKLETOES (R Hannam) was held up in the home straight for some distance before gaining clear running near the 200 metres.</p> <p>CENTRE ATTENTION (Te Baker) had to be angled wide near the 200 metres to continue to improve after racing in restricted room early in the home straight.</p>	
Race 10	WELLINGTON RYDGES CAPTAIN COOK STAKES – Gp1
<p>NASHVILLE (J Riddell) was slow to begin.</p> <p>SURVIVED (C Johnson) began awkwardly and shifted into the line of NASHVILLE further hampering that runner.</p> <p>SURVIVED over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>PURE CHAMPION (C Grylls) over-raced in the lead in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SURVIVED, SHUKA (D Johnson) and JULINSKY PRINCE (J Parkes) all raced keenly in the back straight when the pace ahead eased towards the 1000 metres.</p> <p>PUCCINI (V Colgan) was held up in the initial stages of the home straight.</p> <p>WEREGOINGTOGETCHA (M du Plessis) raced in restricted room early in the home straight.</p> <p>NASHVILLE and SHUKA bumped inside the final 100 metres when NASHVILLE shifted in.</p>	
Race 11	HUTT NEWS PREMIER
<p>TE HANA underwent a veterinary inspection behind the barrier after making contact with the birdcage fence.</p> <p>CHOPPER (B Murray) and FANCY NANCY (R Hannam) bumped at the start.</p> <p>TE HANA (J Parkes) and SARABI (N Harris) were slow away from a wide draw.</p> <p>MENDOZA (B Lammas) was slow away.</p> <p>WILLS ROAD (O Bosson) lay in shortly after the start and bumped SHOWSTOPPER (J Riddell)</p> <p>AMETHYST (D Bradley) over raced in the early stages</p> <p>BLAME DE ANGELS (D Turner) raced keenly early so was eased out to be three-wide from the 1000 metres.</p> <p>ITSAGEM (N Teeluck) became awkwardly placed on the heels of AMETHYST near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>Near the 600 metres AMETHYST lay in and away from FANCY NANCY when continuing to race keenly and as a result crowded TWILIGHT DOLL (R Black) which went back onto CHOPPER.</p> <p>WILLS ROAD was unable to obtain clear running in the home straight and went to the line untested.</p> <p>SHOWSTOPPER hung outwards and had to be straightened near the 200 metres.</p>	

CHOPPER had to be steadied off the heels of the tiring **WERRIBEE (K Myers)** near the 200 metres.
