Race 2 Hospice North Shore 1200

LIME STREET (M Cameron) jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

GREEN EASY (C Grylls) which had been fractious in the barriers was slow to begin.

PINZANO (S Spratt) was steadied when placed in restricted room going into the bend near the 1100 metres, getting its head up and racing ungenerously for a short distance.

LIME STREET raced three wide without cover.

NIGHEAN (R Smyth) was steadied when improving onto heels near the 700 metres.

NIGHEAN was held up for a short distance entering the final straight passing the 400 metres.

Race 3 Mayfair Village 2YO

SAFETY PIN (M Cameron) was slow away.

OKAGBARE (D Johnson) began awkwardly losing ground.

OUTLAW KATE (J Wong) was badly checked near the 900 metres losing several lengths. After viewing film footage, which was of poor quality, and taking evidence from rider J Wong, along with M Hills (RIO CLARO), L Innes (MARKY MARK), A Collett (UNTAMED DIAMOND) and M Coleman (PEACH BELLINI) the matter was adjourned for further consideration.

OKAGBARE got its head up when being steadied near the 900 metres before being further hampered when **OUTLAW KATE** was checked going back on to **PEACH BELLINI** (M Coleman) and **OKAGBARE**. Also hampered and forced wider on the track as a result was **SAFETY PIN**.

RIO CLARO (M Hills) had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.

OUTLAW KATE raced ungenerously through the middle stages, getting its head up on several occasions and continued to race greenly in the final straight.

Race 4 Places & Graces 1400

REVELATOR (M Du Plessis) was held up rounding the final turn.

HIGH ROLLER was eased down in the final straight with rider V Colgan advising that he felt there was something amiss with the gelding. A post race veterinary examination found **HIGH ROLLER** to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia with trainer Mr R Manning advised that the gelding is now required to trial with a veterinary certificate of fitness to be provided prior to racing again.

ELUSIVE GOLD (O Bosson) had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the final 200 metres.

Race 5 Sistema 1200

SNOW EXCUSE (B Hutton) and **ZABERTO** (V Colgan) were slow to begin.

OCEANIA (D Johnson) jumped away awkwardly.

CLOSE UP (M Du Plessis) was steadied to avoid the heels of **CUSTER** (L Satherley) going into the bend near the 1100 metres. **MIHAIA** (M McNab) which had commenced to over-race then had to be restrained off the heels of **CLOSE UP** for a distance. **SNOW EXCUSE** was steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of **GOLD 'N MAC** (M Coleman) near the 800 metres.

CUSTER lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 6 Jesters Pies 3YO Salver

THE AUSTRIAN OAK (V Colgan) and FLAVIGNY (D Johnson) were both slow to begin.

MONGOLIAN STORM (M Cameron) raced keenly in the early stages.

N Harris (MIDNITEMAGICMAN) dropped his whip passing the 250 metres.

Race 7 Dunstan Feeds Championship Qualifier

STAND YOUR GROUND (M Cameron) and DIAMOND THORN (J Robinson) were both slow to begin.

WHATZ OCCURRING (A Collett) raced three wide without cover.

SEVENTEEN SEVENTY (S Spratt) lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

DIAMOND THORN was steadied near the 50 metres when disappointed for a run between **SMEDLEY** (M Du Plessis) and **BUSINESSMAN** (T Thornton) which both shifted ground under pressure. When being steadied **DIAMOND THORN** lay in striking a heel of **SMEDLEY** and blundering just short of the finish. Following the race **DIAMOND THORN** required veterinary attention for a laceration to the right fore leg.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **STAND YOUR GROUND** rider M Cameron advised that the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions but had nevertheless been disappointing. A post race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 8 Lindsay Racing Mile

Approaching the 1000 metres **ZAH OFF** (A Collett) had to be firmly restrained, getting its head up when awkwardly placed on the heels of **TUKAWA** (V Colgan). **ZAH OFF** continued to over-race into the middle stages.

 $\ensuremath{\text{BUFFALO ROSE}}$ (M Hills) raced three wide without cover throughout.

FREEWHEELER (R Smyth) hung outwards rounding the final turn and in the straight.

BOLD BACHELOR (S Spratt) was inclined to lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

When questioned, O Bosson could offer no excuse for the disappointing performance of OPERA KNIGHT.
