RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CATERING SOUTH CANTERBURY & PORT FM MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>RUBY ASHLEY and ALACRIA were slow to begin.</p> <p>Shortly after the start JEAN'S WAY was hampered between runners and got back.</p> <p>Passing the 900 metres COURTSHIP which was tight between runners was steadied and lost ground.</p> <p>BARTER raced wide throughout.</p> <p>Near the 500 metres STEAL THE THUNDER was steadied off heels for some distance.</p> <p>Passing the 125 metres JEAN'S WAY lay inwards under pressure and made contact with BARTER.</p> <p>M Haruki (COURTSHIP) was reminded of his obligations in regard to his use of the whip on runners out of contention.</p>	
Race 2	PURPLE LIZARD CAFÉ & D'CASH DASH R65 (1200m)
<p>DHAULAGIRI and VITESSE ROSE were both slow to begin.</p> <p>MAHBEER blundered on jumping and was further hampered between runners shortly after the start.</p> <p>CASTEL BENITO began awkwardly.</p> <p>RIPPLE raced keenly through the middle stages.</p> <p>BRAH SPRING raced wide throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres SPRINGWATER (R Cuneen) shifted inwards under pressure when improving placing DO UNO WHOIAM, DHAULAGIRI and VITESSE ROSE in restricted room. Shortly thereafter VITESSE ROSE shifted ground inwards to obtain clear running. Apprentice R Cuneen was reminded of his obligations in relation to shifting ground.</p> <p>BRAH SPRING lay outwards in the final straight.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner KING'S VIOLET, rider T Direen felt her runner had not finished the race off due to the prevailing track conditions.</p>	

When questioned regarding the performance of RIO VENTURA rider K Williams advised that the mare had failed to travel at any stage and she would recommend to the trainer that they consider applying blinkers at its next start.	
Race 3	NOEL & SUE WALKER WITH LJ HOOKER GROUP SPRINT R75 (1200m)
<p>HALO PETE began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>GUNNADOO raced keenly in the lead.</p> <p>DOWRA got its head up passing the 1000 metres and raced ungenerously for a short distance.</p> <p>Near the 50 metres MELS EVIE shifted out under pressure and made firm contact with RIDING SHOTGUN.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner HALO PETE rider C Johnson reported that the gelding had failed to run on despite his urgings and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be showing signs of dehydration and muscle tie-up.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the improved performance of GUNNADOO co-trainer M Stokes advised that the addition of a nose band had helped the gelding see out a strong 1200 metres today.</p>	
Race 4	UNIQUE HAIR & BEAUTY MAIDEN (1600m)
<p>RED GEM, ULTRASONIC and KINGS PRIDE were all slow to begin.</p> <p>MADETHECUT raced wide through the early stages.</p> <p>SHORTY MCNORTY raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>FAIR SPOKEN made the bend near the 1400 metres awkwardly shifting out forcing LUCKY SLIPPER over extra ground. FAIR SPOKEN raced keenly for some distance thereafter.</p> <p>SHARP BLADE raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>ASHBURY JACK raced wide throughout.</p> <p>ULTRASONIC lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 5	MARTIN WAKEFIELD MILE R75 (1600m)
<p>BIDDEDO blundered on jumping and unbalanced rider J Morris momentarily.</p> <p>KEYNOTE was slow to begin.</p> <p>NEEDASTAR and THE TERMINATOR were both hampered shortly after the start and got back as a result.</p> <p>SOUTHERN POWER raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Passing the 1450 metres KEYNOTE shifted in and hampered UNRELENTING LADY which had to shift across heels and in doing so inconvenienced THE TERMINATOR. UNRELENTING LADY then raced fiercely for a short distance.</p> <p>Passing the 1100 metres UNRELENTING LADY shifted outwards and in doing so hampered SHE'S PAYBACK. UNRELENTING LADY raced wide from this point on.</p> <p>CAPO improved wide from the 1000 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 600 metres PERCY POSSUM was held up for some distance.</p> <p>PERCY POSSUM was not afforded clear running throughout the final straight and could not be fully tested by its rider.</p> <p>Passing the 250 metres G Jogoo the rider of NEEDASTAR dropped his whip momentarily.</p>	
Race 6	"THANK YOU COUPLANDS BAKERIES" TIMARU CUP (1600m)
<p>SHE'S INSATIABLE began awkwardly getting back.</p> <p>RIC O'SHEA raced wide throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 1200 metres SHE'S INSATIABLE raced keenly tending to get its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained.</p> <p>CAPTAIN TODD raced keenly through the middle stages.</p> <p>Passing the 450 metres EL CHICO was placed in restricted room for some distance having to steady. EL CHICO was further held up passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 200 metres EMERALD QUEEN lay inwards under pressure and had to be straightened inconveniencing ELUSIVE TRACY momentarily.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner MISS THREE STARS rider M Hills advised that after receiving a favourable run throughout the mare was under heavy pressure turning for home and only battled over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
Race 7	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE R65 (1600m)
<p>HI YO KO began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>COLONEL ANNE raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>TANTELLA raced wide throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 1000 metres KAAPFLEUR and TANTELLA made contact with TANTELLA being unbalanced for a short distance.</p> <p>COLONEL ANNE raced wide from the 1000 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 800 metres ARE YOU MINE which had improved into a marginal run clipped a heel and blundered when awkwardly placed to the inside of HASSLE FREE which shifted in.</p>	

PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE lay inwards throughout the home straight.
Over the concluding stages **KAAPFLEUR** lay outwards under pressure.
