**KALINGA** over-raced in the early and middle stages and when being steadied in the back straight shifted in and made contact with the running rail.

**OUTOFTIME** was unable to obtain clear running throughout the home straight.

**SOUTHERN SECRET (H Tinsley)** was held up in the home straight until over the final stages.

When questioned regarding the run of **THE BEAUT, R Myers** said that after missing the start the gelding settled back and was unable to make progress from thereon.

#### **RICHARD ALGAR LTD HANDICAP**

BEL SORRISO (J Parkes) was slow to begin.

**ON THE HILL (R Goldsbury)** raced keenly in the early and middle stages and got its head up when being restrained. **ON THE HILL** then raced three-wide without cover throughout.

A post-race veterinary examination was ordered by Stewards of **NIPPIN** after rider **S Doyle** reported that he felt something may be amiss with the gelding. This revealed no abnormality.
