RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 3YO

IN A FRENZY (M McNab) and FIRST HONOUR (O Bosson) both began awkwardly, making contact.

Shortly after jumping away **REDEEM CODE** (M Cameron) had to steady when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **TORBA** (C Grylls) which shifted in, with Rider C Grylls taking immediate remedial action.

Passing the 300 metres **REDEEM CODE** shifted in slightly inconveniencing the weakening **FIRST HONOUR**.

IN A FRENZY which had commenced to hang out when making the final turn then lay in under pressure passing the 150 metres placing **TORBA** in restricted room.

When questioned regarding the performance of **FIRST HONOUR** rider O Bosson advised the gelding had travelled fairly through the early and middle stages, and had failed to respond when placed under pressure passing the 400 metres. A subsequent veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 2 YOUNG READ WOUDBERG, CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1200

OLLIE EAGLE (R Hutchings) began awkwardly, losing ground.

SILVER ROD (C Grylls) began awkwardly, shifting out, making contact with LA NOVICE (U Holmquist).

Approaching the 1100 metres **SABER** (O Bosson) shifted in crowding **LA NOVICE** which had to steady.

SILVER ROD raced ungenerously passing the 1100 metres when being steadied, and then made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly, running wide.

LA NOVICE raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Approaching the 400 metres **OLLIE EAGLE** shifted out with **MARKWOOD** (M Cameron) then being obliged to race three wide

Apprentice R Hutchings (**OLLIE EAGLE**) was advised by Stewards that he must ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

Race 3 HOLLAND BECKETT 1400

WHITTAKER (S Spratt) was hampered leaving the barrier.

ASTRONOMER (M Chui) began awkwardly making solid contact with **STAGE DOOR** (R Hutchings) simultaneously as **JESDEMONA** (P Holmes) shifted outwards resulting in **STAGE DOOR** and **ASTRONOMER** losing ground.

CAPTAIN CAVALIER (C Grylls) began awkwardly shifting in making contact with **FORT STREET DANCER** (M Cameron) which was further hampered when forced onto **ASTRONOMER**.

WHITTAKER made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly and then hung out for a distance.

SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS was held up until near the 150 metres.

JESDEMONA was inclined to lay out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

Z Moki (KAHAROA ROSE) was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 200 metres.

Race 4 CBC CONSTRUCTION – WINNING FROM THE GROUND UP 2150

TOY STORY (Z Moki) and LORD GRANGELEA (C Grylls) both began awkwardly, losing ground.

STRATEGICLEIGH (B R Jones) raced wide without cover until being allowed to improve forward and sit outside the leader near the 1000 metres.

TOY STORY commenced to hang out soon after leaving the barrier, and when making the bend near the 1700 metres shifted out despite the efforts of its rider forcing **CHENILLE** (R Hutchings) and **LORD GRANGELEA** wide on the track. **TOY STORY** then raced wide for a distance.

Passing the 600 metres **CHENILLE** lay in, crowding **CONTESTANT** (S Spratt) on to **BIG MEADSY** (V Gatu) which was hampered. **BIG MEADSY** then shifted out approaching the 400 metres to obtain clear running, and was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 5 BNZ PARTNERS TAURANGA 1200

CELTIC BOY (R Smyth) was slow away.

RUNNING SCARED (A Jones) shifted out leaving the barriers.

BACHATA (S Collett) made the bend awkwardly passing the 1000 metres.

DONNIE BRASCO (S McKay) raced wide without cover throughout.

CELTIC BOY had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight, and had to change ground near the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

RUNNING SCARED shifted out abruptly under pressure passing the 200 metres.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1200

BELLTAAT (B R Jones) was slow away.

JUSTTHEANSWER (S McKay) began awkwardly, losing ground.

ELUSIVE BOXERS (S Collett) over-raced in the early stages.

Near the 1000 metres CRAFTYCHARD (T Thornton) raced ungenerously, making the bend awkwardly.

JUSTTHEANSWER and **BLISS STREET** (S Spratt) both raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 800 metres.

IFFITEL (A Jones) raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 7 PACIFIC PROPERTY 1600

SUFFIRE (C Grylls) and **BAGSAGOLD** (M Hills) both began awkwardly.

Approaching the 1000 metres **SARAH POUR** (B R Jones) steadied and shifted back on to **LUCKY ORPHAN** (M Coleman) which became awkwardly placed, shifting out and forcing **TORRICELLA** (T Abel) wider on the track. **SARAH POUR** then lay in passing the 900 metres crowding **SUFFIRE** which was steadied.

TORRICELLA raced wide without cover throughout.

SUFFIRE was held up rounding the final turn behind O'REILLY'S GOLD which then lay out.

Passing the 250 metres **TORRICELLA** lay in, inconveniencing **BLUE WAGON** (O Bosson).

Race 8 FARMER AUTOVILLAGE 1600

GIN SWING (M McNab) was slow away.

UNVEILING (O Bosson) began awkwardly, shifting out, hampering **ETONETT** (M Coleman). Contributing was inward movement from **MAY** (A Jones) which had also began awkwardly.

Approaching the 1500 metres **MINGINUI** (R Smyth) shifted in and away from **UNVEILING** making contact with **DANNY THE IMP** (P Holmes) with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced.

SILVER SERVICE (R Norvall) commenced to lay out soon after leaving the barriers, becoming awkwardly placed when approaching the 1400 metres, having to be steadied, losing ground.

MAY raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages.

SILVER SERVICE lay out when making the bend near the 900 metres making contact with **EYES OF LOVE** (M Cameron). **SIR FRANCIS** (T Thornton) raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 800 metres **GIN SWING** shifted out slightly with **SILVER SERVICE** shifting away from that runner and losing ground.

DANNY THE IMP commenced to give ground approaching the 600 metres, shifting back on to **MINGINUI** which had to steady abruptly which then in turn shifted back on to **THE BEST MAN** (R Hutchings) which was hampered.

SIR FRANCIS shifted out under pressure approaching the 200 metres inconveniencing UNVEILING.

SILVER SERVICE received veterinary attention following the race for a laceration to the near hind leg, after being galloped on.
