RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	VISIT YOUR HORSE AT RACEIMAGES.CO.NZ MAIDEN 1200M
<p>PINDY'S SECRET was slow away.</p> <p>KONOHKI shifted out on jumping away, simultaneously as MAGGIE'S SECRET shifted in resulting in tightening to KALDOREI, VON TOLL and SAM FINELL.</p> <p>POROTENE RIPPA shifted out and bumped PLATINUM EMPIRE at the start.</p> <p>PLATINUM EMPIRE when being angled out into clear running near the straight entrance became momentarily unbalanced and failed to finish the race off as expected. Rider D Bradley was of the opinion the gelding may be better suited to a longer distance.</p> <p>When questioned in to the performance of POROTENE RIPPA Rider V Johnston was of the opinion the filly may be better suited to any cut in the going.</p>	
Race 2	SPOONERS DRYCLEANERS 3YO MAIDEN 1200M
<p>ANDRONICUS and ROCKAFILLY both began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>ANDRONICUS over-raced badly throughout and near the 800 metres when attempting to run off, shifted out and bumped with ROCKAFILLY forcing that runner wider on the track. ANDRONICUS then ran off rounding the home bend placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder. Connections were advised that ANDRONICUS must perform satisfactorily at two</p>	

official trial dates prior to its next start. ROCKAFILLY raced greenly in the home straight.	
Race 3	G BRISTOL & SONS 1200M
Approaching the 800 metres LANZARA was checked when racing to the inside of HINYUEN PALADIN (H Tinsley) which shifted in when not clear. H Tinsley defended a charge of careless riding under Rule 638 (1) (d) and after deliberations the charge was found proved. H Tinsley was suspended from the close of racing on Saturday, 17 January up to and including racing on Friday, 23 January (3 days) plus a \$500 monetary penalty. When questioned into the run of FANCY NANCY , Rider N Teeluck said that despite being momentarily held up early in the home straight, in his opinion the mare may be better suited to a longer distance.	
Race 4	WANGANUI RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION MAIDEN 2040M
LADY JESSICA shifted out at the start simultaneously as DEE I CEE shifted in. This resulted in CRAFTY LADY and SURREAL LEGEND being tightened, with CRAFTY LADY losing considerable ground. KINGIESSTAR and MYSTERY GIFT over-raced in the early stages. DEE I CEE and ANNIEVEGAS both raced wide in the early and middle stages until near the 800 metres. KINGIESSTAR was obliged to improve its position wide rounding the final bend.	
Race 5	THE WHANGANUI VINTAGE WEEKEND 2040M
MISS ANA began awkwardly losing ground and settled at the rear. PEARLS had to be steadied off the heels of LOVE ME MOORE when the pace ahead steadied leaving the home straight on the first round. PIRINITETE improved on to heels near the 800 metres so was angled wide into clear running. Over the final stages MISCHIEVOUS MIS shifted in abruptly and had to be straightened near the finish. Rider S Doyle reported that MISS ANA may be better suited to any easing of the track conditions. When questioned into the disappointing performance of PEARLS , Rider V Johnston reported that in her opinion the mare would appreciate any easing of the track conditions.	
Race 6	RIVERSIDE BAR MAIDEN 1600M
SUPER SCOT was slow to begin and settled back. CRACK A TUI hung outwards going into the first turn. SUPER SCOT was held up for several strides immediately prior to entering the final straight. LAST TRUMP was inclined to shift inwards in the home straight and had to be straightened near the 200 metres. When questioned into the run of CRYSTAL SECRET which disappointed, Rider R Myers said the gelding was forced to race wide throughout and had little left at the finish after covering too much extra ground.	
Race 7	RACEWAY MOTEL 1600M
I SUGGEST was slow to begin. Shortly after the start LONGBEACH when racing to the outside of KING SAMBO and BEAUTIFUL MAN clipped the heels of KING SAMBO and blundered. After questioning riders and viewing footage it could not be accurately determined that any one rider was at fault. LONGBEACH was then obliged to race three-wide throughout. LONGBEACH shifted out on the point of the home turn and bumped WAITINO BISCUIT which became momentarily unbalanced. THE BEAMA and BEAUTIFUL MAN bumped near the finish. When questioned into the disappointing run of KING SAMBO Rider J Parkes was of the opinion that the gelding was unsuited to the firm going and would prefer any cut in the ground.
