RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	THE MARQUIS OF NORMANDY CARTERTON
<p>CAUGHT BEHIND had a near hind plate removed at the barrier prior to the start and lost the off hind plate during the running.</p> <p>STORMY HABIT was a late scratching on veterinary advice after rearing and becoming entangled in the barrier at 1.15pm. Trainer F Stammers was advised that STORMY HABIT must barrier trial before next starting.</p> <p>PLACID (T Johnson) began awkwardly.</p> <p>MICHELIN (J Parkes) was slow to begin.</p>	

<p>PLACID (T Johnson) had to steady shortly after leaving the barriers when positioned awkwardly near the heels of SUPER SCOT (S Doyle) which was shifting in to obtain a position more adjacent to the rail. Stewards questioned riders S Doyle and apprentice T Johnson with respect to this matter and advised S Doyle to exercise care when shifting ground. Apprentice T Johnson was spoken to with regard to the tactics he adopted in the early stages.</p> <p>MICHELIN raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 2	WAIRARAPA TIMES AGE
<p>ALL IN LUCK (J Parkes) and JUDI ANNE (R Goldsbury) were slow away.</p> <p>PINDY'S SECRET (R Stam) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ALL IN LUCK was placed in restricted room passing the 50 metres between PINDY'S SECRET and KEEN TEMPO (R Hannam) which was dictated marginally wider by PLATINUM EMPIRE (J Riddell) which lay out under hard riding.</p> <p>PLATINUM EMPIRE then shied at the winning post and ducked out abruptly taking KEEN TEMPO out onto ALL IN LUCK which clipped the heel of KEEN TEMPO and blundered dislodging rider J Parkes. J Parkes was attended to by St John's Ambulance personnel and cleared to continue riding.</p>	
Race 3	MORE FM
<p>LADY ZAFIRA (S Doyle) hung out when joining the course proper passing the 800 metres and blundered after contacting the heels of HINYUEN PALADIN (H Tinsley).</p> <p>LADY ZAFIRA was held up rounding the turn and near the 250 metres, after attempting a marginal run between WHAT'S UP CHARLIE (R Myers) and FLORAL SCENT (R Hannam), was placed in restricted room when WHAT'S UP CHARLIE and FLORAL SCENT shifted ground marginally.</p> <p>WHAT'S UP CHARLIE was attended to by the veterinary post-race surgeon after showing signs of lameness in the near hind leg. Trainer N Hurdle advised that WHAT'S UP CHARLIE would now be spelled.</p> <p>Trainer C Hearn reported that HINYUEN PALADIN had been galloped on during the running and required post-race veterinary attention.</p>	
Race 4	POPE & GRAY CONTRACTORS
<p>BENNIES APPROVAL (N Teeluck) scrambled at the start, beginning very awkwardly and losing ground.</p> <p>PLATINUM SONG (J Riddell) and BOUDICA (R Hannam) were slow to begin.</p> <p>SATIN RIDGE (S Doyle) raced four-wide without cover for the majority of the event.</p> <p>WAIZ ONE (R Myers) was placed in restricted room to the inside of MAYARI (K Myers) passing the 150 metres and had to shift ground outward.</p> <p>BOUDICA commenced to give ground quickly from the turn and finished last. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality. Trainer J Bary advised that he would have BOUDICA examined upon return to his stables with any adverse outcome to be reported to Stewards.</p> <p>J Parkes found himself in physical difficulty over the final stages as a consequences of his fall in race 2 and this resulted in him being unable to fully ride POROTENE DIVA to the line. Stewards were satisfied that notwithstanding the disability, POROTENE DIVA'S chances to finishing in a higher placing had not been compromised.</p> <p>J Parkes stood down from his remaining rides for the day.</p>	
Race 5	WCM LEGAL
<p>MAE WEST (S Doyle) and DAL TE EN TEE (M Dee) were crowded leaving the barriers between NO ENEMY (H Tinsley) which shifted out and RIPE (D Bradley) which shifted in.</p> <p>DAL TE EN TEE was obliged to race wide without cover throughout and yielded on the fast past.</p> <p>CURRY UP (R Myers) was held up rounding the turn and had to be angled wider passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 6	B & B CONTRACTING
<p>KINGIESSTAR was a late scratching at 4.10pm after becoming very fractious in the barriers.</p> <p>JIBRIL (N Teeluck) and NO ESCAPE (R Hannam) both began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>JIBRIL (N Teeluck) shifted ground in under hard riding over the final 200 metres. Apprentice N Teeluck was told to make greater effort to keep his mounts straight.</p> <p>When questioned on the performance of OBRAHMA, K Myers could offer no excuses.</p> <p>When questioned on the performance of MR CHEVALIER which finished last, J Riddell could offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding revealed no abnormality.</p>	
Race 7	LIFE MEMBERS 150TH JUBILEE HANDICAP
<p>BLAME DE ANGELS (K Smith), PERFECT MIX (K Myers) and LADY PLATINUM (M Dee) were all slow away.</p> <p>ZIMMZEE (N Teeluck) was inclined to over-race in the lead.</p> <p>ZIMMZEE (N Teeluck) balked and dropped its head when leading near the 700 metres resulting in the trailing KOHI ROAD (R Hannam) having to steady and take evasive action. Trainer K Zimmerman was shown footage of this section of the race and undertook to take remedial action in an attempt to correct this unsatisfactory characteristic of ZIMMZEE'S racing manners.</p> <p>BLAME DE ANGELS raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p>	

PERFECT MIX was held up passing the 600 metres.

PERFECT SYMBOL (R Myers) had to steady near the 250 metres when on the heels of **PADDY OWEN (D Bradley)**

When questioned on the performance of **PERFECT MIX**, **K Myers** reported that the mare was better suited to a more rain affected going.

Race 8

MCKENZIES ELECTRICAL

CARRINGTON PARK (V Johnston) shifted out on jumping crowding **SPARX (H Tinsley)**

ANNIEVEGAS (B Lammas) began awkwardly and lost ground.

TROUP ROAD (R Myers) was slow to begin.

LYKABETTUS (N Teeluck) commenced to over-race passing the 1400 metres and near the 1300 metres was dictated wider when **BARTHEZ (K Smith)** shifted out from a position adjacent to the rail. **K Smith** was issued with a warning in relation to this incident and told that in future he must not ride in a manner similar to what he did on this occasion.

ANNIEVEGAS was held up for a short distance passing the 250 metres.

LYKABETTUS hung in rounding the final turn directing **REVOLUTION (J Riddell)** in onto the heels of **RETRIBUTION (M Dee)**.
