Race 1	LASER PLUMBING TE PUKE 1600			
WORTHING (M Cameron) over-raced when disputing the pace through the middle stages.				
SO KEEP ME (M Wenn) was briefly held up rounding the turn near the 400 metres.				
NORTH OF SUNSET (D Johnson) lay in under pressure in the final straight.				
When questioned regarding the performance of JOEY MASSINO apprentice rider S McKay advised that his riding				
instructions had been not to restrain the horse because of the horse's history with breathing issues, and it had raced				
keenly outside tl	keenly outside the leader for the majority of the race being unable to quicken once placed under pressure.			
Race 2	TWILIGHT CARNIVAL RACEDAY – 5 FEB TGA 1300			
EMERALD LADY (M Hills) and HOLD THE PHONE (O Bosson) were crowded leaving the barriers between ASTRA (R				
Hutchings) and MIA ROSE (M Sweeney) which both shifted ground when beginning awkwardly.				
Passing the 1100 metres BACHATA (L Magorrian) had to steady off the heels of FORTUNE KEPT (B R Jones) which shifted				
in.				
BACHATA made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly inconveniencing PANELLA (A Jones) and EMERALD LADY.				
EMERALD LADY shifted outwards into the line of STRATEGICLEIGH (T Thornton) which was hampered along with EL				
HEALO (R Norvall).				
MAY (S Spratt) raced three wide without cover.				

Passing the 300 metres the weakening **MAY** lay in on to the heels of **EMERALD LADY** which was shifting out. **EMERALD LADY** was then inclined to lay out.

IN A FRENZY (K Myers) commenced to shift out under pressure passing the 300 metres and continued to do so forcing **ASTRA** wider on the track, and near the 100 metres hampering **ASTRA** which had to check to avoid the heels of **IN A FRENZY**. Inconvenienced as a result was **ELUSIVE BOXERS** (S Collett). K Myers admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with her license to ride in races being suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on 15 January up to and including racing on 23 January, 5 riding days.

PANELLA shifted out over the final 100 metres inconveniencing **HOLD THE PHONE**.

Race 3 CHANGING ROOM HAIR DESIGN TAURANGA 1300

IMPY LUIS (J Wong) began awkwardly losing ground.

ARTIFACT (M Chui) raced three wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 600 metres.

GERRY MERITO (L Magorrian) raced ungenerously when being restrained going into the bend near the 900 metres. **CHOCOLAT** (M Sweeney) was inclined to lay out rounding the bend.

CEE TEE ARE (R Hutchings) shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 250 metres making contact with **GREEN EASY** (T Thornton).

VIVE LA DIFFERENCE (M Cameron) was held up near the 250 metres being angled inwards to attempt a marginal run to the inside of CHOCOLAT, but was unable to obtain clear running when CHOCOLAT was taken in slightly by ARTIFACT resulting in VIVE LA DIFFERENCE having to be steadied. VIVE LA DIFFERENCE then shifted outwards across heels, but was again held up over the concluding stages.

Race 4 120TH TAURANGA A&P SHOW – SAT 17 JAN 2100

SIH RAH (A Jones) was crowded leaving the barriers.

BACHELOR BRAVE (D Nolan) commenced to over-race when being steadied for a distance passing the 1700 metres. **SINO HEIGHTS** (S Spratt) had to be steadied passing the 1300 metres when **BIG MEADSY** (M Hills) shifted inwards. M Hills was advised to exercise greater care.

SIH RAH raced wide throughout.

BACHELOR BRAVE was held up rounding the final turn before having to shift outwards across the heels of **PERFECT ROSE** (L Magorrian) to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

BIG MEADSY lost the off hind plate during the running.

Race 5 CROCKFORD REAL ESTATE 1300

HOT IN PINK became very fractious in the barriers rearing on a number of occasions dislodging rider V Colgan. When readying to re-mount the mare, it continued to rear being declared a late scratching at 3.07 pm. Trainer Mr R James advised that after consultation with the mare's owners **HOT IN PINK** would not be persevered with as a racing proposition.

GIARDINI (M Coleman) was slow away.

CRACKER (L Magorrian) raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages, and then commenced to hang out rounding the final bend.

GIARDINI shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres inconveniencing **ESTELLE** (R Hutchings), with **GIARDINI** shortly after then making contact with **ELYSIUM** (M Cameron) which had lay in.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1400

MINTED BLACK (R Norvall) was slow to begin before being further hampered between **SOMETHINGVAIN** (S Spratt) and **ODIN'S CHOICE** (A Jones) which both began awkwardly and came together with **SOMETHINGVAIN** becoming unbalanced losing ground.

SAUCY MARY (K Myers) lay out when making the final bend hampering ODIN'S CHOICE near the 350 metres.

REDSKIN (O Bosson) was reluctant to improve into a marginal run to the inside of **SAUCY MARY** passing the 200 metres. **ENDEAN ROSE** (B Hutton) became awkwardly placed on the heels of **DIAMOND DUCHESS** (R Hutchings) and then shifted in approaching the 100 metres inconveniencing **ODIN'S CHOICE**.

EMMUSKA (L Magorrian) had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight, and was briefly held up passing the 75 metres.

Race 7 GEAR WELDING SERVICES 1600

VICTOR HUGO (O Bosson) was crowded at the start between **BIG BOUNTY** (V Colgan) and **INTUITIVE** (M Du Plessis) which both began awkwardly with all three runners losing ground.

SIR LANCELOT (L Magorrian) had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages, and when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **SUPER THUNDER** (R Norvall) going into the bend near the 900 metres was bumped by **KENTUCKY SON** (T Thornton).

BIG BOUNTY was held up rounding the final turn and when attempting to obtain clear running near the 400 metres shifted out placing **VICTOR HUGO** and **INTUITIVE** in restricted room with **INTUITIVE** having to be briefly steadied. **BIG BOUNTY** continued to be held up early in the final straight.

KENTUCKY SON was held up entering the final straight.

TORRICELLA (T Abel) raced wide without cover throughout.

Approaching the 400 metres **QUEVADO** (L Satherley) which was laying out, raced in restricted room between **STORM BRO** (D Johnson) which also had a tendency to lay out and **LUCKY ORPHAN** (M Coleman) with **LUCKY ORPHAN** then shifting in slightly hampering **QUEVADO** which had to steady. Rider M Coleman was reprimanded and advised he must ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground, and further advised that a warning would be placed on his record. **VICTOR HUGO** had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

Race 8 C U @ THE PHOENIX TAURANGA 1600

ETONETT (B Hutton) began awkwardly hampering HALONG BAY (S Spratt) which lost ground.

MIRAGE (D Nolan) began awkwardly.

SORORIA (M Du Plessis) was slow away.

CASTLE BEE (M Cameron) blundered leaving the barriers.

Approaching the 1200 metres **SHINKO SHIBATA** commenced to over-race then becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of **DESTERRO** (V Colgan) which was steadying, with **SHINKO SHIBATA** then having to further steady, shifting back on to **SORORIA** which raced in restricted room and became unbalanced. **ETONETT** which was following was hampered as a result. **SHINKO SHIBATA** (L Magorrian), **CHAOS** and **MIRAGE** all then raced ungenerously for a distance with **CHAOS** shifting out and forcing **ASHWINI** (D Johnson) on to the heels of **SIR FRANCIS** (T Thornton).

MIRAGE raced ungenerously throughout.

SINGLE SHOT (M Hills) raced three wide without cover.

LORD GRANGELEA (M Sweeney) raced wide throughout.

Passing the 175 metres, **DESTERRO** lay in across the heels of **CHAOS** which had shifted out to obtain clear running. **CHAOS** was held up over the concluding stages.
