Race 1	WILD BUCK NZ ALE MAIDEN 2000
<p>CUPCAKE raced ungenerously in the early stages and got its head up on a number of occasions.</p> <p>TYCOON CLASS raced wide in the earlier stages.</p> <p>Passing the 1500m FAIR SPOKEN raced fiercely for some distance when being restrained.</p> <p>Near the 1400 metres TYCOON CLASS and CUPCAKE over-raced.</p> <p>PERFECTLY RED raced wide from the 900 metres.</p> <p>SHORTY MCNORTY gave ground from the 1100 metres eventually finished in a distant last position. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>CUPCAKE improved wide from the 500 metres.</p>	
Race 2	TASMAN AGRICULTURE/GREG DALY REAL ESTATE RATING 75 2000
<p>POINT PROVEN was slow to begin.</p> <p>SEALED BY A DANCE tended to get its head up when being restrained in the early stages and raced fiercely for some distance.</p> <p>MISS CITRON raced wide in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SIR AMRON made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly.</p> <p>STORM HOME improved wide from the 1000 metres</p> <p>Passing the 800 meters SIR AMRON raced ungenerously and got its head up when making the bend awkwardly. SIR AMRON continued to race ungenerously laying outwards.</p>	

Race 3	VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS MAIDEN 1020
<p>DAME WYNNIE, HERE'S TO IT and THE MAN were all slow to begin.</p> <p>ASH was restrained to the rear on jumping.</p> <p>I JUST ROCKED UP raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>Passing the 150 metres THE MAN had to steady and shift outwards to obtain clear running. THE MAN raced greenly thereafter.</p>	
Race 4	REEFTON CRANE & CONSTRUCTION RATING 65 1020
<p>MILK IT began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>MANUIA blundered on jumping, shifting inwards, making contact with DO UNO WHOIAM which got back as a result.</p> <p>SIR LUIS lost contact with the body of the field passing the 600 metres. Rider, J Morris reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>MILK IT shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 150 metres MILK IT and DO UNO WHOIAM came together and made contact for a short distance.</p>	
Race 5	FAHEY CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1400
<p>BOYSWAY and ALLEZ ALLIE were both slow to begin.</p> <p>VIA DOLOROSA over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.</p> <p>Near the bend by the 1050 metres DANN DOONAYR made the bend awkwardly, shifting outwards forcing OUR SPICE and VIA DOLOROSA over extra ground.</p> <p>VIA DOLOROSA improved wide from the 600 metres.</p> <p>Near the 200 metres OUR SPICE blundered, shifting outwards, making firm contact with VIA DOLOROSA resulting in both runners and riders becoming unbalanced momentarily.</p>	
Race 6	BIRCHFIELD COAL MINES REEFTON CUP 1400
<p>DUFFERS CREEK blundered on jumping.</p> <p>PINS GOLD raced keenly in the early stages and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained.</p> <p>DUFFERS CREEK and PINS GOLD both made the 1000 metres bend awkwardly.</p> <p>DUFFERS CREEK lay out rounding the final bend.</p> <p>When questioned about the improved performance of winner ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA, co-trainer K Rae reported that the gelding appreciated the change of rider and the smaller field size. He further added the gelding has a very good record at this course.</p>	
Race 7	BILL O'MALLEY MEMORIAL RATING 65 1400
<p>SNOWDEN was a late scratching at 1.00pm on veterinary advice.</p> <p>CARAMAC and MAEVE DAVONE were both slow to begin.</p> <p>FILLE DU ROI raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>RAPT made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly, shifting outwards.</p> <p>RAPT improved wide from the 600 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres GOOGLE ME was steadied when placed in restricted room.</p>	
Race 8	CONGRATULATIONS CWJ & PITY RATING 75 1400
<p>DUNOON blundered on jumping.</p> <p>BARBERRY ROZE was slow over the early stages.</p> <p>SPRINGWATER raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>OVERTHERIVER raced wide for a short distance rounding the bend near the 1000 metres</p> <p>DUNOON made the bend awkwardly near the 500 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres DUNOON shifted outwards when making the bend awkwardly and hampered SPRINGWATER momentarily.</p>
