RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WILD BUCK NZ ALE MAIDEN 2000

CUPCAKE raced ungenerously in the early stages and got its head up on a number of occasions.

TYCOON CLASS raced wide in the earlier stages.

Passing the 1500m FAIR SPOKEN raced fiercely for some distance when being restrained.

Near the 1400 metres TYCOON CLASS and CUPCAKE over-raced.

PERFECTLY RED raced wide from the 900 metres.

SHORTY MCNORTY gave ground from the 1100 metres eventually finished in a distant last position. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.

CUPCAKE improved wide from the 500 metres.

Race 2 TASMAN AGRICULTURE/GREG DALY REAL ESTATE RATING 75 2000

POINT PROVEN was slow to begin.

SEALED BY A DANCE tended to get its head up when being restrained in the early stages and raced fiercely for some distance.

MISS CITRON raced wide in the early and middle stages.

SIR AMRON made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly.

STORM HOME improved wide from the 1000 metres

Passing the 800 meters **SIR AMRON** raced ungenerously and got its head up when making the bend awkwardly. **SIR AMRON** continued to race ungenerously laying outwards.

Race 3

VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS MAIDEN 1020

DAME WYNNIE, HERE'S TO IT and **THE MAN** were all slow to begin.

ASH was restrained to the rear on jumping.

I JUST ROCKED UP raced wide in the early stages.

Passing the 150 metres **THE MAN** had to steady and shift outwards to obtain clear running. **THE MAN** raced greenly thereafter.

Race 4

REEFTON CRANE & CONSTRUCTION RATING 65 1020

MILK IT began awkwardly and got back.

MANUIA blundered on jumping, shifting inwards, making contact with **DO UNO WHOIAM** which got back as a result. **SIR LUIS** lost contact with the body of the field passing the 600 metres. Rider, J Morris reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.

MILK IT shifted outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

Passing the 150 metres MILK IT and DO UNO WHOIAM came together and made contact for a short distance.

Race 5

FAHEY CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1400

BOYSWAY and ALLEZ ALLIE were both slow to begin.

VIA DOLOROSA over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.

Near the bend by the 1050 metres **DANN DOONAYR** made the bend awkwardly, shifting outwards forcing **OUR SPICE** and **VIA DOLOROSA** over extra ground.

VIA DOLOROSA improved wide from the 600 metres.

Near the 200 metres **OUR SPICE** blundered, shifting outwards, making firm contact with **VIA DOLOROSA** resulting in both runners and riders becoming unbalanced momentarily.

Race 6

BIRCHFIELD COAL MINES REEFTON CUP 1400

DUFFERS CREEK blundered on jumping.

PINSGOLD raced keenly in the early stages and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained.

DUFFERS CREEK and **PINSGOLD** both made the 1000 metres bend awkwardly.

DUFFERS CREEK lay out rounding the final bend.

When questioned about the improved performance of winner **ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA**, co-trainer K Rae reported that the gelding appreciated the change of rider and the smaller field size. He further added the gelding has a very good record at this course.

Race 7

BILL O'MALLEY MEMORIAL RATING 65 1400

SNOWDEN was a late scratching at 1.00pm on veterinary advice.

CARAMAC and **MAEVE DAVONE** were both slow to begin.

FILLE DU ROI raced keenly in the early stages.

RAPT made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly, shifting outwards.

RAPT improved wide from the 600 metres.

Passing the 300 metres **GOOGLE ME** was steadied when placed in restricted room.

Race 8

CONGRATULATIONS CWJ & PITTY RATING 75 1400

DUNOON blundered on jumping.

BARBERRY ROZE was slow over the early stages.

SPRINGWATER raced keenly in the early stages.

OVERTHERIVER raced wide for a short distance rounding the bend near the 1000 metres

DUNOON made the bend awkwardly near the 500 metres.

Passing the 300 metres **DUNOON** shifted outwards when making the bend awkwardly and hampered **SPRINGWATER** momentarily.
