starting barriers required remedial work which delayed the start by approximately 4 minutes.		
REILLY LINCOLN was slow away.		
MARE MIA raced three wide without cover for the majority.		
MAGGIE'S SECRET was held up rounding the turn and only obtained clear running passing the 150 metres.		
REILLY LINCOLN was held up passing the 400 metres and had to be angled out near the 150 metres to obtain clear running.		
SHE KNOWS was crowded over the final stages when inside MARE MIA, which shifted in and away from REILLY LINCOLN.
