Race 3 GREYMOUTH BUSINESSES SPRINT 1100

I'M MAVERIC was awkwardly placed on the heels of **BLACK BERRY PUNCH** near the 700 metres.

**DUFFERS CREEK** raced wide from the 500 metres.

**DUFFERS CREEK** lay inwards in the run home.

Rider D Walsh reported **BLACK BERRY PUNCH** lay outwards from the 700 metres.

#### Race 4 RECREATION HOTEL RATING 75 1100

No racing incidents.

#### Race 5 COLMAN CREAGH MAIDEN 1100

OUR SPICE was slow to begin.

**OUR SPICE** raced wide from the 500 metres.

Passing the 200 metres **OUR SPICE** (R Black) lay inwards slightly and had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of **VIA DOLOROSA** (L Magorrian) which was shifting ground outwards. After hearing from riders R Black and L Magorrian, Mr Magorrian was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground in future.

Over the concluding stages **MAIA'S ANGEL** lay outwards and bumped on several occasions with **HE KNOWS**. **OUR SPICE** lay inwards over the concluding stages.

## Race 6 GREG DALY REAL ESTATE MAIDEN 1100

PLACID PRINCESS was slow to begin.

**ROMAN GODDESS** raced wide racing into the first bend.

**PLACID PRINCESS** over raced in the middle stages.

**EYE ON JANIE** raced wide throughout.

**SUNFLOWER** lay outwards rounding the final bend when attempting to improve.

Near the 750 metres **BON CHERIE** shifted inwards and brushed the rail.

Rider L Callaway admitted a charge under Rule 340 in that he misconducted himself with using offensive language on return to the birdcage area. After hearing all relevant evidence the JCA imposed a \$250 fine.

## Race 7 VERNON AND VAZEY RATING 65 1100

MISS MACK was slow to begin.

**CINDERELLA** raced wide throughout.

PETER PARKER was held up from the 400 metres to the 150 metres.

**STILL WATERS** raced wide from the 400 metres.

**KAGE IS KING** was held up rounding the final bend then shifted ground outwards passing the 300 metres bumping with **CINDERELLA.** Over the concluding stages **KAGE IS KING** (C Johnson) shifted ground outwards inconveniencing **CINDERELLA** just short of the winning post. Rider C Johnson was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground in future.

When questioned regarding the performance of **MISS MACK** rider J Bates advised the filly was unable to get into the race after being slowly away.

## Race 8 MONTEITH'S BREWING COMPANY GREYMOUTH CUP 2000

**NEEDASTAR** raced wide in the early and middle stages when over-racing and then commenced to give ground passing the 1000 metres. A subsequent veterinary examination on **NEEDASTAR** failed to detect any abnormalities. Passing the 850 metres **NOBLE WARRIOR** raced in restricted room momentarily between the tiring **THE HAND OF FAITH** and the improving **OUR ALCHEMIST**.

#### Race 9 GREYMOUTH STAR RATING 65 1500

POINT PROVEN was slow to begin.

TANTELLA and WILMA RUDOLF began awkwardly.

Racing into the first bend **CARAMAC** (D Walsh), when over-racing, failed to negotiate the bend and hung outwards resulting in **ZENNO ROLLS ROYCE** (D Prastiyou) and **TANTELLA** (G Jogoo) being forced over extra ground with **ZENNO ROLLS ROYCE** being checked. **CARAMAC** continued to shift ground outwards and over-race for some distance. After hearing from riders D Prastiyou, G Jogoo, and D Walsh the Stewards were unable to apportion blame on rider D Walsh with a warning being placed on the **CARAMACS** racing manners.

Near the 1100 metres SIR JACK REMINGTON hung outwards when over-racing.

LIFE'S IN A SPIN raced wide from the 900 metres.

WILMA RUDOLF was held up near the 300 metres.

CARAMAC attempted to ease down when tried with the whip over the concluding stages.

Race 10 PARK LANE DECORATORS RATING 75 1500

**WERIO** made the crossing awkwardly near the 1050 metres.

**ALFONZE** raced wide from the 800 metres.

Passing the 300 metres **RIGHT ROYAL ROSE** (J Morris) had to be steadied momentarily when **HALEY MAREE** (R Black) shifted ground inwards. Rider R Black was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground in future.

**WERIO** lay outwards rounding the final bend forcing **CORBYN** wider.

HANDSOME DAX was held up for a short distance passing the 350 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **SIR SINGO** rider C Johnson advised that the gelding did not

appreciate the holding nature of the track. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to detect any abnormalities.
