RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MCKEOWN PETROLEUM 1400m

MAL D'MOUR was slow to begin.

DRAGONS DEN began awkwardly and was further hampered between runners shortly after the start and got back as a result. **WILMA RUDOLF** raced wide throughout.

Passing the 900 metres **DRAGONS DEN** made contact with the running rail for some distance. Apprentice P Shaikh in the presence of his employer Mr M Pitman was shown replays and instructed he must show greater control of his mount and use better judgement in similar circumstances.

Passing the 500 metres **DRAGONS DEN** (P Shaikh) shifted ground outwards and in doing so caused **MAL D'MOUR** to be steadied for some distance. P Shaikh was warned under Rule 638(1)(d) that he should take greater care when shifting ground.

Near the 400 metres **CHINA TEA** commenced to give ground and finished a distance last. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities other than a slower than normal recovery rate.

Near the 200 metres rider R Black (FANTAMO) dropped her whip.

METRO LOVER lay inwards throughout the final straight.

Passing the 150 metres METRO LOVER shifted in and made contact with FANTAMO.

Race 2 BENMORE MERINOS/KUROW HARNESS RACING CLUB SPEC MAIDEN 1800m

PROPITIOUS began awkwardly and got back.

TYCOON CLASS which was over racing made the bend by the 1500 metres awkwardly shifting wider on the track forcing **MAWENZI** over extra ground.

Near the 1500 metres **TYCOON CLASS** which had continued to over race became awkwardly placed on the heels of **MAWENZI** and had to be steadied.

TYCOON CLASS improved wide from the 500 metres.

PROPITIOUS lay inwards in the final straight.

Near the 100 metres **PROPITIOUS** which had lay inwards became awkwardly placed on the heels of **DOMINATOR** and had to be straightened.

Race 3 COCHRANES FARM MACHINERY 1800m

NEWS FLASH was late scratched at 12.55pm on vet's advice. **NATKINGCOLE** raced fiercely in the early stages making the bend near the 1500 metres awkwardly.

SIR SINGO raced wide from the 1000 metres.

Near the 200 metres **NO EMOTION** was denied clear running and had to shift outwards across heels. **NO EMOTION** was then further held up passing the 150 metres before shifting outwards to obtain clear running.

Race 4 RURAL TRANSPORT/MCKENZIE & CO CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS/BUSINESS ADVISORS 1400m

GALLANT DAN began awkwardly and was buffeted between runners shortly after the start.

Passing the 1250 metres **KIRKIE** (K Williams) shifted inwards when not clear dictating **GOLD ROCK** inwards onto **DOUBLE BLUE** which was badly buffeted. Also affected was **GALLANT DAN** which lost ground. Rider K Williams admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) and after hearing submissions the JCA suspended her licence from the end of racing of 3 January up to and including 7 January (2 days).

RIVERTAINE COUP raced fiercely for a short distance.

Passing the 1100 metres GOLD ROCK and DOUBLE BLUE made further contact.

DOUBLE BLUE raced wide from the 800 metres.

In the early stages of the home straight **GALLANT DAN** shifted outwards and forced **EL BEE DEE** wider on two occasions. Trainer M Pitman reported that it was his intention to withdraw **RIVERTAINE COUP** from all upcoming engagements and spell the mare. A post race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

Race 5 COUPLAND'S BAKERIES 1800m

LA MUSIQUE was slow to begin.

WESTERN WARRIOR began awkwardly.

FOUR SEAS was restrained to the rear on jumping.

WESTERN WARRIOR raced keenly in the early stages.

PRINCE RANSOM and FLORENCE HILTON raced wide in the early stages.

Passing the 1500 metres **OTTO THE GREAT** (J Bates) shifted inwards resulting in **CARNIVA BOY** having to steady. Rider J Bates was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

WESTERN WARRIOR got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 1200 metres when being restrained.

AFRICAN STAR was forced to race wide for a short distance passing the 1000 metres when shifted wider on the track by **CURTAIN CALL** (S Muniandy). Rider S Muniandy was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

Passing the 800 metres **FLORENCE HILTON** steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of **AFRICAN STAR** resulting in the trailing **SHASPIC** having to be steadied.

Passing the 400 metres **FLORENCE HILTON** was held up for a short distance. **CARNIVA BOY** lay inwards in the early part of the home straight having to be straightened at the 200 metres.

SHASPIC lay inwards passing the 200 metres having to be straightened.

When questioned about the performance of **PRINCE RANSOM** rider D Walsh reported that the gelding had failed to see out the extra distance of today's race coupled with the increase in weight.

Following the running of this race rider C Barnes advised that **AFRICAN STAR** made respiratory noises during the running. A post race veterinary inspection revealed **AFRICAN STAR** to be distressed and displaying a poor recovery rate. Connections were advised that a veterinarian clearance will be required prior to racing next.

COUPLAND'S WORKING DOG BISCUIT 1200m

Shortly after the start **TELL THE WORLD** and **ROYALE ROUTINE** made firm contact, with **ROYALE ROUTINE** being unbalanced momentarily and racing fiercely for a short distance. **BEN'S LASS** raced wide from the 800 metres. When questioned about the performance of favoured runner **PINSAKE** rider C Johnson reported that after being outpaced early the gelding had battled fairly when placed under pressure and in his opinion would take benefit from today's race.

Race 7 PGG WRIGHTSON KUROW CUP 1400m

KING MONTROSE shifted out as the start was effected dictating **KEEPA TRAMP** onto **GHOSTINTHEMACHINE**. Also affected was **ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA** which got back.

KING MONTROSE raced keenly throughout.

Passing the 500 metres **COUP DARCI BE** (P Shaikh) which had been allowed to travel up onto the heels of **KEEPA TRAMP**, which steadied momentarily, shifted outwards abruptly and made firm contact with **GHOSTINTHEMACHINE** which blundered badly unbalancing rider R Black. P Shaikh defended a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) and after hearing submissions the JCA reserved its decision.

Race 8 FINLAY BOATS 3&4YO 1800m

Rider R Cuneen was dislodged from **MISS MIA** on the way to the barrier. Both horse and rider were checked and cleared to start.

YOUNG JIM over raced in the early stages.

Passing the 1000 metres **ZHANIM** which was racing keenly shifted outwards due to the tempo of the race easing.

TOETWOTOE raced fiercely passing the 1000 metres when the pace of the race eased.

Passing the 800 metres TIMY TYLER was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of MISS MIA.

Passing the 700 metres **ZHANIM** failed to negotiate the bend shifting wider on the track forcing **LUKANDER** over extra distance.

ZHANIM continued to race untractably passing the 500 metres proving difficult to ride.

Early in the home straight **SOUTHERLY CHANGE** shifted ground outwards when under pressure making firm contact with **AVOW** .**SOUTHERLY CHANGE** and **AVOW** jostled for a distance shortly thereafter.
