## GENERAL:

Upon arriving on the Racecourse S Muniandy advised that he was feeling unwell and after being examined by the course doctor was stood down from his rides today. S Muniandy was advised that a medical clearance will be required prior to racing next.

## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE SYDENHAM HURDLES (3100m)
<b>GAGARIN</b> was slow to begin. <b>RED MAGIC</b> made a poor leap at the second fence. <b>MAHANADI</b> lost ground at the third fence. <b>GAGARIN</b> became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>RED MAGIC</b> near the 2300 metres. <b>RED MAGIC</b> raced wide from that point on. <b>COOLIBAH</b> misjudged the fence approaching the 1400 metres and landed awkwardly.	

<p><b>KINGS DEEP</b> misjudged the fence near the 800 metres and fell with <b>MAHANADI</b> then being brought down by the fallen runner. Both horses and riders were uninjured. Hampered by the fallen runners was <b>GARGAMEL</b>.</p> <p><b>ZARDETTO</b> (A Kuru) shifted outwards to obtain clear running after jumping the fence near the 800 metres, making contact with <b>GAGARIN</b> and hampering <b>SUPERTURF</b>. A Kuru was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p><b>RED MAGIC</b> made a poor leap at the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p><b>SUPER TURF</b> and <b>SHAMAL</b> both made poor jumps at the second to last fence.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>SUPERTURF</b>, rider C Studd reported that the gelding had not been suited by the tempo of the race and had been left flat footed when the field sprinted.</p> <p><b>SHAMAL</b> sustained a minor laceration to the left front heel bulb.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ECHOES OF HEAVEN AND EKRAAR @ LINWOOD PARK THREE-YEAR-OLD (1200m)</b>
<p><b>LITTLE LYLIE</b> shifted outwards on jumping dictating <b>SHADOW TOWER</b> outwards hampering <b>SNIPARINDA</b>.</p> <p><b>PADDY BOURKE</b> shifted outwards abruptly at the start. <b>PADDY BOURKE</b> continued to race ungenerously for some distance and was inclined to race greenly throughout.</p> <p><b>SNIPARINDA</b> over raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>THE CZAR</b> was held up in the early stages of the home straight for a short distance.</p> <p><b>PADDY BOURKE</b> tended to lay outwards over the concluding stages.</p> <p>T Johnson (<b>PADDY BOURKE</b>) dropped his whip passing the 150 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>AVON CITY FORD PREMIER (1200m)</b>
<p><b>INCONTROL</b> was buffeted on jumping away when <b>PINZANO</b> shifted inwards and <b>TWIST OF FAITH</b> shifted outwards.</p> <p><b>GOTTAGETMYWOOHOO</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>KEVILDO</b> shifted outwards on jumping and hampered <b>VICE MARSHALL</b>.</p> <p><b>TREAT ME</b> shifted inwards shortly after the start and hampered <b>HEEBY JEEBY</b> which had to steady as a result.</p> <p><b>INCONTROL</b> (S Wynne) became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>PINZANO</b> (D Bradley) which was laying despite the efforts of its rider near the 1050 metres with <b>INCONTROL</b> then striking a heel and blundering dislodging rider S Wynne. S Wynne was attended to by the on-course doctor and stood down from her remaining riding engagements. S Wynne was advised she must produce a medical clearance prior to racing next.</p> <p><b>PINZANO</b> continued to lay in hampering <b>TWIST OF FATE</b> near the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>TWIST OF FATE</b> was held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres.</p> <p><b>PAINTBALL</b> was held up in the early stages of the home straight.</p> <p><b>KEVILDO</b> became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>TREAT ME</b> was eased down over the final 200 metres. Apprentice B Murray advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection found the mare to be slightly uneven in its action in the left foreleg. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to the mare racing next.</p> <p><b>PAINTBALL</b> lost the right front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>CANTERBURY CLUB LUNCHEON AUGUST 7 PREMIER (1400m)</b>
<p><b>GOLD LEAF</b> was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>WEISSMULLER</b> began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p><b>PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE</b> and <b>SOMETHINGS BURNING</b> both raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>RIPPLE</b> was retired from the race passing the 600 metres after going amiss. <b>RIPPLE</b> was attended to by the Club veterinarian and humanely euthanased as it was found to have suffered a compound fracture to the left foreleg.</p> <p><b>HANDSOME DAX</b> was placed in restricted room passing the 550 metres having to be steadied.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>DOWNLOAD OUR APP NOW MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE (3200m)</b>
<p><b>INDIAN BURT</b> put in a poor jump at the first fence.</p> <p><b>IN FOR FUN</b> made a poor leap at the second fence, unbalancing rider M Cropp who was dislodged. M Cropp was uninjured.</p> <p><b>HEZANAKILAD</b> made a poor leap at the 2000 metres and continued to mix its jumping thereafter.</p> <p><b>JACHIL</b> made a poor leap at the fence near the 1800 metres with the rider losing the use of his inside iron for a short distance.</p> <p>The riderless <b>IN FOR FUN</b> made contact with a portion of the running rail near the fence by the 800 metres and fell before quickly regaining its feet. <b>IN FOR FUN</b> underwent a veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality other than the gelding bleeding from the nostril area as a result of external trauma.</p> <p><b>CECIL</b> landed awkwardly and fell after jumping the fence near the 400 metres, hampering <b>JACHIL</b> which was then retired from the race passing the 200 metres and did not jump the last fence. N Quinn, the rider of <b>CECIL</b>, was uninjured. <b>CECIL</b> returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils which upon veterinary examination was found to be a result of external trauma.</p> <p><b>I'VE GOT THIS</b> made a poor leap at the last fence.</p> <p><b>INDIAN BURT</b> lost the left front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>NZI KORAL STEEPLECHASE (4250m)</b>
<p>M Mitchell, the rider of <b>HIGH FORTY</b>, lost his whip leaving the barriers.</p>	

**SNODROPTWINKLETOES** was restrained to the rear on jumping.  
**GET FLASH** made a slow leap at the fence near the 2800 metres.  
**KEEP IT TIGHT** was crowded between **FAITES VOS JEUX** and **WOTABUZZ** near the 800 metres. When landing after jumping the fence **KEEP IT TIGHT** made contact with the hindquarters of **WOTABUZZ**, turning that runner inwards causing further crowding to **KEEP IT TIGHT** which then clipped a heel of **WOTABUZZ** and blundered, dislodging rider N Quinn who was uninjured.  
**GET FLASH** landed awkwardly after jumping the final fence.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>GIANT'S STEPS @ LINWOOD PARK PREMIER SPRINT (1200m)</b>

**HOMELAND** was slow to begin.  
**SUPER TROUPER** (M Haruki) shifted outwards near the 900 metres when not fully clear of **PARAKETO** which had to steady to avoid that runner's heels. **SUPER TROUPER** continued to shift outwards into the line of **JACK'S RUN** which had to be steadied and shifted outwards across the heels of **PINSGOLD**. Apprentice M Haruki was issued with a warning and advised that he must ensure he is sufficiently clear when shifting ground in future.  
**PINSGOLD** was crowded onto the hind quarters of **JACK'S RUN** near the 450 metres when **SUPER TROUPER** shifted outwards. M Haruki was advised to exercise greater care.  
**SHE'S SLINKY** was held up rounding the bend near the 450 metres.  
**SCAPOLO** was held up in the early and middle stages of the home straight.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>GOLD CLUB PREMIER (1600m)</b>

**MISS MIA** was crowded on jumping between **POPP 'N LINDAUER** and **CLAREVILLE FLIGHT** and lost ground.  
**CARMEN SANDIEGO** and **CROYDON** raced keenly in the early and middle stages.  
**MAEVE DAVONE** raced wide throughout.  
**CLAREVILLE FLIGHT** and **ROMELO** bumped passing the 500 metres.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>eStar 118<sup>th</sup> WINTER CUP (1600m)</b>

**IRISH EXCUSE** and **NORTH AND SOUTH** began awkwardly.  
**IRISH EXCUSE** raced keenly in the early stages.  
**BIOLOGIST** raced wide throughout.  
**NORTH AND SOUND** raced in restricted room near the 1000 metres.  
R Hannam the rider of **NORTH AND SOUTH**, advised that the mare would be better suited by more rain affected footing.  
**MAROTIRI MISS** required veterinary treatment following the race after pulling up sore in the right foreleg (fetlock). Trainer Mr R French was advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to the mare racing next.  
**HEXIE HAO** required veterinary attention following the race as it was displaying signs of a slow recovery and was found to be suffering from the Thumps.

<b>Race 10</b>	<b>NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK PREMIER (1600m)</b>

**PLACID PRINCESS**, **BOYSWAY** and **BARBERRY ROZE** were slow to begin.  
**SUPERIOR COURT** began awkwardly before being further hampered by **SLICK NICKEL** which shifted in.  
**SUPERIOR COURT**, **HI YO KO**, **PLACID PRINCESS** and **BOYSWAY** all over raced in the middle stages on a moderate pace.  
**EL BEE DEE** raced wide without cover throughout.  
**AFRICAN STAR** over raced when being steadied near the 1000 metres, having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of **SHE'S PAYBACK**.  
**BOYSWAY** was held up passing the 400 metres before shifting ground to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.  
**BOYSWAY** again had to shift ground passing the 200 metres.  
**CHOPPER** was inclined to shift outwards under pressure in the final straight.

<b>Race 11</b>	<b>SPEIGHT'S PREMIER (1800m)</b>

**SIR AMRON** and **CAVATINO** raced wide throughout.  
**ACUTELYGOLD** raced keenly in the lead through the middle stages.  
J Lowry (**SIR AMRON**) dropped his whip near the 450 metres.  
Apprentice J Lowry advised that **SIR AMRON** had failed to handle today's holding track conditions.
